With reference to conversation Archer - Triffitt today.

1. It is confirmed that the Territorial H.Q. of the Regio Esercito Naples are unaware that D.M.R.S. Italy has been granted Exempting powers so far as Italian State Railway personnel are concerned.

2. These powers were conferred on D.M.R.S. in A.F.H.Q. Administrative Memorandum No 10 dated 20 February '45 as amended by A.F.H.Q. Administrative Memorandum No 15 dated 13 March 1945. A copy of this amendment is attached for your information.

3. Exemption forms for I.S.R. personnel due for call to Military Service were forwarded by this Directorate to the Territorial H.Q. at Naples and Bari on 24 Mar 45 in accordance with the a/n Admin Memos. It is vital that the individual certificates should be signed and returned to this H.Q. as early as possible as the provisional exemption granted to railwaymen expires on 15 April 45.

The loss of these personnel, about 1000 in all, would have a most adverse effect on the efficiency of the Railway.

4. Will you take up the matter strongly with the Italian Ministry of War and request that the Territorial H.Q. concerned, are informed, in no uncertain terms, that D.M.R.S. is a fully authorised exempting authority?

1. CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH ITALIANS WILL BE EXEMPTED FROM THE
MILITARY SERVICE.

A.F.E.Q. Administrative Memorandum No 10, 1945, is amended
as follows :-

1. Delete the last sentence of paragraph 2a and substitute
the following :-

"Forms will be submitted in quadruplicate to the local
British or United States Labour representative, except in
the case of personnel employed by the Italian State Rail-
ways, forms for whom will be submitted direct to the Director
Military, Railway Service, Italy."

2. Paragraph 3a (16) is added as follows :-

"(16) Director Military Railway Service, Italy".

Further to our letter GR/3717/G-1(Br) dated 7 Mar 45.

1. It is intended that the next call-up of Italians in the POGGIA area shall commence 1 May.

This call-up will apply to all Italian civilians liable for military duty including personnel who may be working for the British or US forces.

2. Applications for obtaining exemption from call-up for personnel working for British or US forces will be submitted in accordance with AFHQ Adm Memo No 10.

3. It is requested, however, that in order to assist the Italian Ministry of War, you will submit now, to Land Forces Sub Commission, AG (MCLA) a nominal roll in duplicate of civilian employees of the classes 1915 - 1925 in the employment of your units in the POGGIA area for whom exemption is desired.

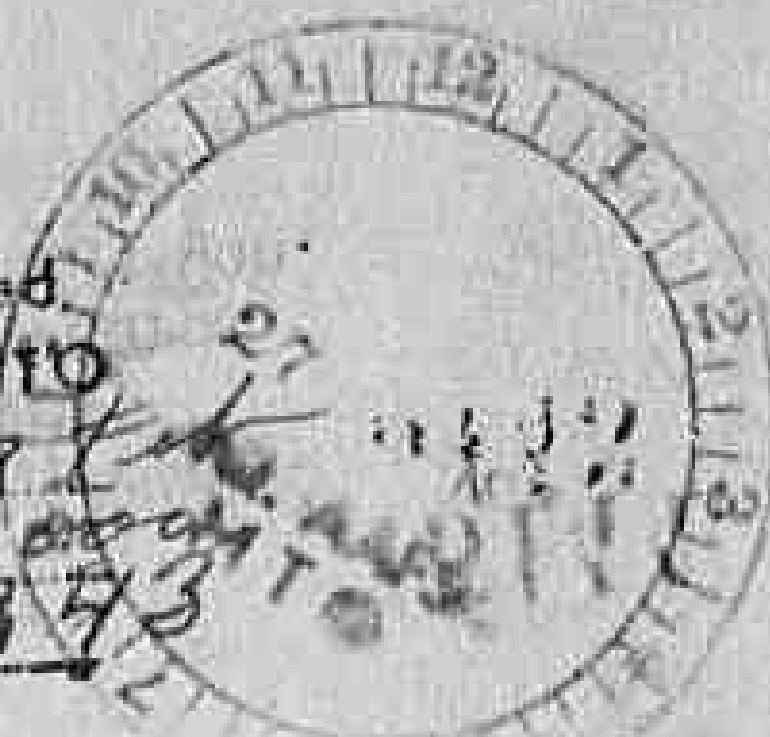

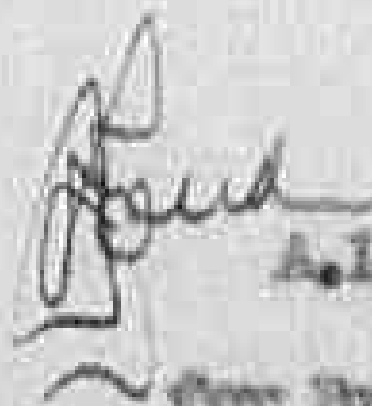

1. It is pointed out that AMI Administrative Instruction dated 22 Aug 44, limiting exemptions to a period of three months, is now inoperative and superseded by AFHQ Administrative Memorandum No 10 dated 24 Feb 45, whereby the period of exemption is extended to 6 months.
2. Certificates in respect of the ten civilians employed by RACED are accordingly returned herewith and it is requested that you will amend the period of exemption shown thereon to cover six months.
3. Full investigations are being made into the circumstances in which these men originally failed to respond to call-up.
