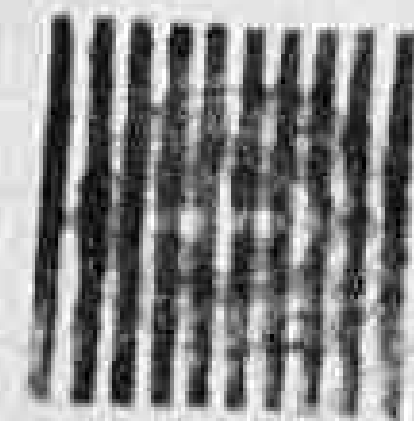

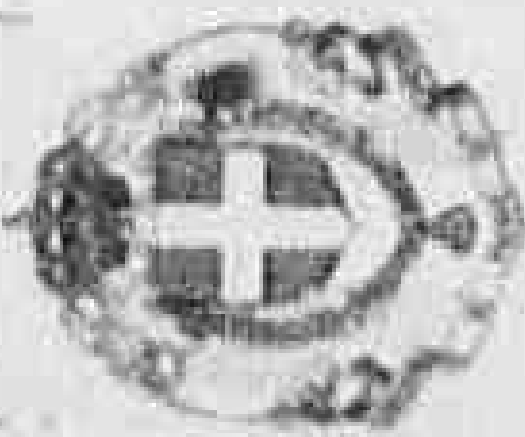

1. On 26 July Hq MMIA placed demands on Commerce Sub-Commission, AGC for items of leather, thread and nails required for the repair of Boots and Shoes by the Italian Army. The availability of all needed items was coordinated with Local Resources Board, Hq AAI, 3-4, and Commerce Sub-Commission, AGC prior to placing demands. It was understood that the amount of each item as requested could be made available from local resources.

2. Items of leather and thread have been released to the Italian Army but no release of shoe nails has as yet been made.

3. It is understood that two Italian nail factories in the vicinity of Naples are now operated under AGC control and that a third small nail factory will shortly be controlled. It is also understood that some difficulties have arisen with respect to a shortage of raw material and production. The Italian Army has found it possible to purchase a limited quantity on the Italian market.

4. A supply of shoe nails from local resources is essential for the shoe repair program of the Italian Army and any further assistance in obtaining the quantities already requested will greatly be appreciated.
