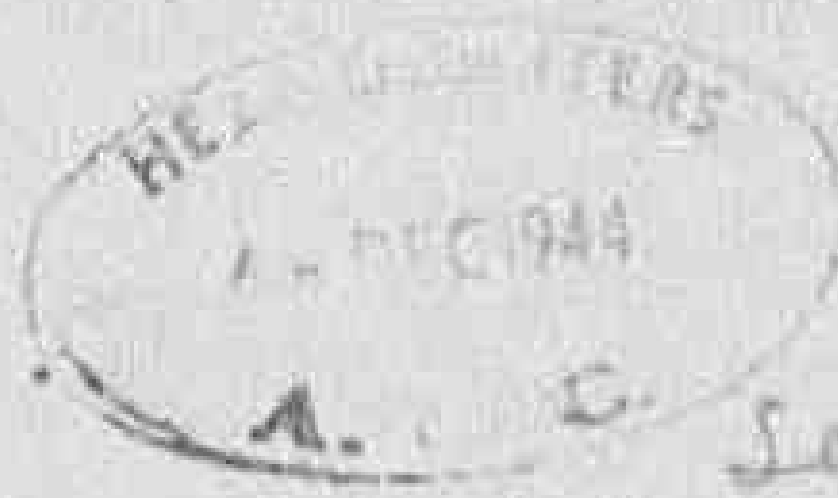

TO : Ministry of War.

1. It has been decided to post experienced British and U.S. personnel to Italian Army depots, where they will be able to assist the Italian personnel of the depots in identifying and sorting the various Allied materials placed at the disposal of the Italian Army. They will form also close liaison between the Italian Depot Commanders and AMIA Liaison Officers, and generally co-operate in the smooth working of the depot.

2. The British and American personnel will be non-commissioned officers or soldiers. They will be based on the depots, and will live in the depots, where such accommodation is available and suitable.

3. It is desired that the Ministry of War inform all Italian Officers concerned, to afford every facility and assistance to these men, as accredited Allied representatives, and to co-operate with them to the fullest extent.

SUBJECT: Depot Personnel.

TO : ASIA Liaison Officers, Sardinia, Sicily, Naples
and Bari.

1. British and U.S. Alliated Personnel are being assigned to your offices to assist you in the supervision of Italian Depots.

2. This is a new departure. The Minister for War is being informed that these Alliated Men are representatives of the Allies and are being sent into the Depots to assist in the operation of the Depot and to supervise the work from the viewpoint of ASIA; and that they must be accorded every courtesy and facility as Allied Representatives.

3. In order to gain the most benefit from the service of these men in the depots, it will be necessary that they be thoroughly instructed by you on the ground in the various duties you desire them to perform. They should be based on the depot; and if accommodations are suitable, should live in the depot.

4. This Allied Personnel will be able:

a. To see that all receipts and issues from the Depot are properly recorded and reported to you.

b. To see that the operation of the Depot is in accordance with the instructions you have issued.

c. To see that the supplies in the Depot are safeguarded properly by the Italian Personnel.

d. To act as a Liaison Officer between the Italian Depot Commander, and your office.

e. To assist the Italian Depot Commander in identification of allied supplies and equipment.

f. To render such reports to your office as you decide necessary to efficiently control the operation of the Depot.

5. The value of these men can only be realized if you instruct them thoroughly in their duties and supervise their work to see that their conduct is such as befits an Allied Representative in the Depot. You will ensure that their relations with the Italian Officers and men are on a friendly operating basis, but at the same time that they issue instructions with firmness but not rudeness.
