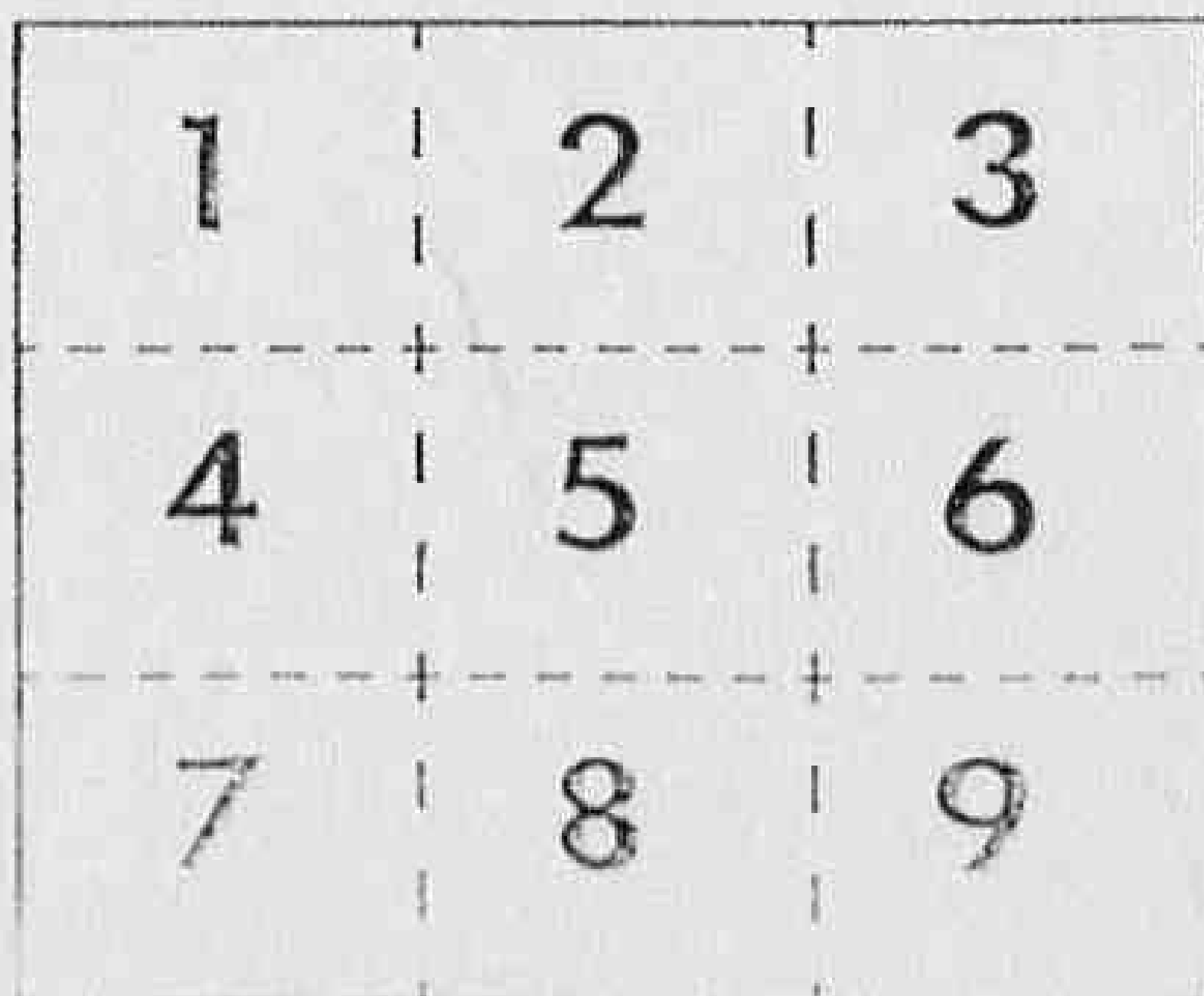
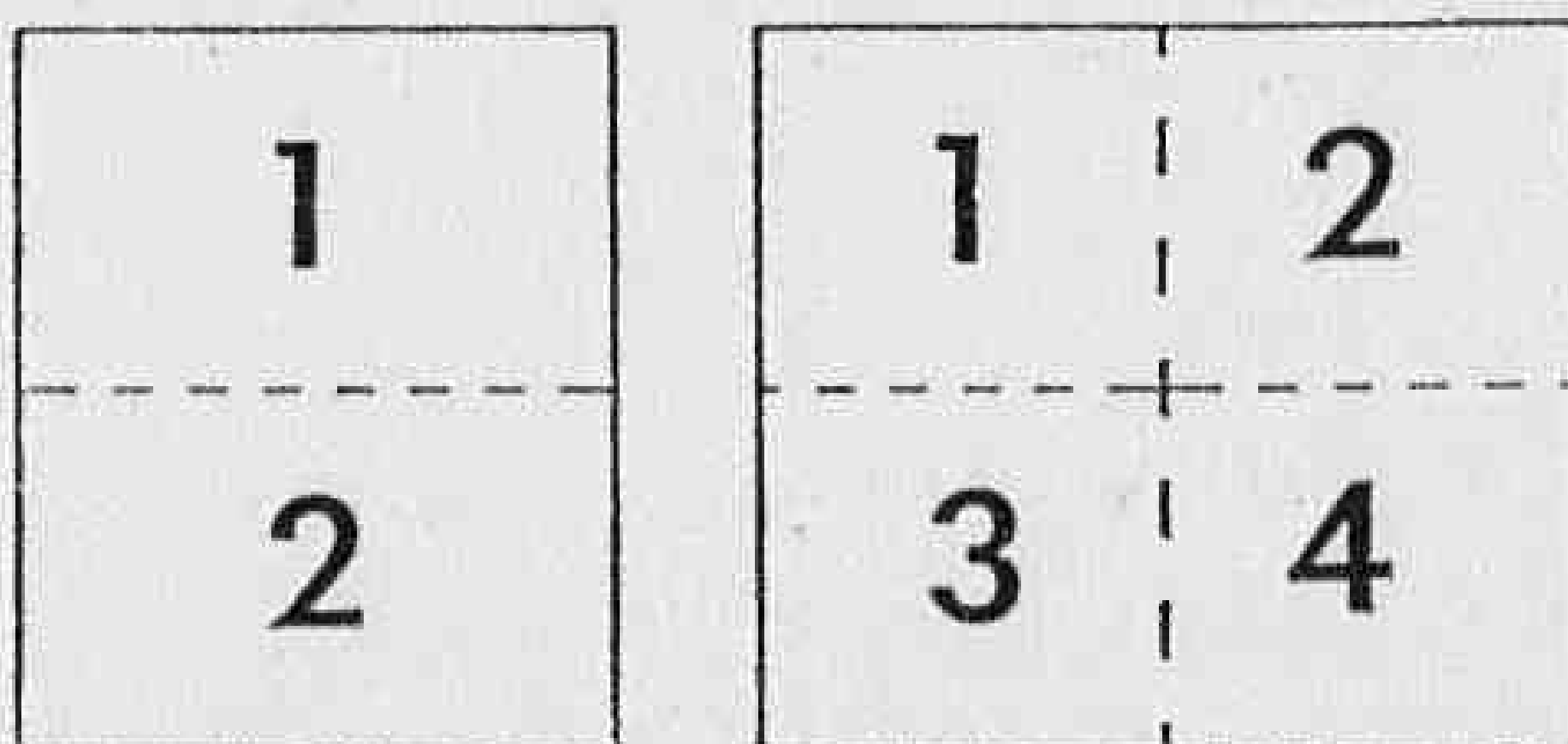

COMMITTEE OF THE LIAISON

1. The object of the Liaison was to liaison the formation of additional pack up boys for future operations.

EXISTING UNITS

2. The following units exist at present :-

In addition two Italian boys are now being formed by Fifth Army.

REQUIREMENT

3. A recent appreciation showed that a total of 40 boys would be required for future operations, leaving a balance of 16 boys to be formed including the two new Italian boys being formed by Fifth Army, or a net balance of 14 boys. We have stated that, in their opinion, it should be possible to form and maintain a total of 14 boys including the two new Italian boys for Fifth Army.

LIMITING FACTORS-ANALYSIS

4. (a) An examination of resources in animals, personnel and equipment showed that the number of animals available and personnel available would be the limiting factor in the formation of new units. Attached is attached to these minutes is a statement showing the number of animals calculated to be available at 1 for 45.

- 2 -

(b) In arriving at the total of 4900 animals available by 1 Mar, the following assumptions were made:

- (1) that a reduction in the Theatre reserve from 30% to 20% is a fair risk,
- (11) that the wastage in existing units during Nov and Dec would not exceed an overall figure of 10% per month and for Jan and Feb 5% per month.

It was realized that if either or both of the above estimates proved too optimistic, the number of animals available would be reduced.

(c) The number of animals required including adequate reserves, was estimated at 440 and 350 for British and US a/c's respectively. This estimate given an approximate yield of 2 British a/c's or 3 US a/c's per 1000 animals.

(3) A target of 14 new a/c's (6 British and 8 US) to be formed by 1 Apr 15 in addition to the 2 Italian a/c's mentioned in para 2 above, was agreed by the meeting.

5. The monthly intake of males estimated for 1945 from Middle East, Italy and Sicily is 1350. For the following reasons it is most desirable that every effort should be made to obtain additional males from other sources:

- (1) Reserve at 10% per month on units which will exist in March will be approximately 1500, i.e. 150 more than the anticipated intake.
- (2) Wastage during Jan and Feb may well exceed 5% and as a result less than 14 a/c's will be formed.
- (3) Theatre reserve should be reduced to 30% as soon as possible.
- (4) Three a/c's additional to the 14 above will be required by the British for use in the Spring, i.e. a total of 1200 males approximately. It was agreed that this should be asked to explore the possibility of obtaining males from Spain and Algeria.

PERSONNEL

6. (a) The numbers of personnel were estimated. For US a/c's, personnel must be Italian.

(b) Personnel for no a/c is required and no a/c if personnel may be available, but in view of the length of time required to train this personnel and the desirability of keeping the number of

estimated at 400 and 350 for British and US boys respectively. This estimate given in approximate yield of 2 British boys or 3 US boys per 1000 attacks.

- (3) A target of 15 new boys (8 British and 7 US) to be formed by 1 Mar 45 in addition to the 2 Italian boys mentioned in para 2 above, was agreed by the Meeting.

The monthly intake of males promised for 1945 from Middle East, Italy and Sicily in 1945. For the following reasons it is most desirable that every effort should be made to obtain additional males from other sources:

- (a) Replacements at 10% per month in units which will exist in March will be approximately 1500, i.e. 150 more than the anticipated intake.
- (b) Losses during Jan and Feb may well exceed 5% and as a result less than 11 boys will be formed.
- (c) Theatre resources should be restricted to 500 as soon as possible.
- (d) Three boys additional to the 11 above will be required by the British for use in the theatre, i.e. a total of 1250 males approximately. It was agreed that AFHQ should be asked to explore the possibility of obtaining males from ITALY and AMERICA.

PERSONNEL

6. (a) The purposes of personnel were examined. For US boys, personnel must be Italian.
- (b) Personnel for no boy of American and one boy of American may be available, but in view of the length of time required to train this personnel and the desirability of having the number of nationalities involved at a minimum, British and American boys should not be formed on a direct requirement.
- (c) One Italian boy from ITALY might be made available. AFHQ should be asked to investigate this.
- (d) The required number of Italians can be obtained but the personnel will be greatly restricted. A trial of two months for training was considered recommended. The Meeting agreed that the 11 new boys should be formed from ITALY with, in the case of the British boys, British trained to be formed from 75% and 75% from US boys from UK, represented by a number of officers and specialist personnel already requested. The two British boys will arrive in ITALY about mid Jan 45. AFHQ have been asked to arrange for a 100000 ration to arrive during Dec 44.
- (e) Existing resources of British personnel supported by the two pack left boys from UK reinforced as in 6 (a) above will be no more than sufficient to form cadres for 8 British boys. Additional British officers and NCOs will be required for my other boys.

3/.....

(c) in view of recent satisfactory results in Italian submarine reinforcements, the testing noted that the personnel provided should come from the 1914/1926 age group. Careful screening is necessary prior to arrival if personnel in units in order to send out men also for early mobilization and specially units.

9. After discussion it was agreed, subject to confirmation, that P-3 would form the core for Fifth Army and that the British core should be formed under orders at the liaison wing of the Base Artillery Depot. If, however, personnel are available before the Depot is set up, they may be despatched direct to existing units provided they have been medically inspected, processed, clothed and equipped.

(b) The meeting considered the question of accommodating and training the remaining personnel for British boys. The following was agreed:

- (i) Immediate and urgent action should be taken to set up a new Reinforcement Training Depot for Italian recruits in the Operational Area.
- (ii) A wing for officers, subalterns and soldiers should be added to the Depot to train the recruits as they become available.

REQUIREMENT

7. In order to maintain the continuity of British boys for the Operational Area, the availability of equipment for the boys is subject to confirmation by Fifth Army.

OTHER UNITS

8. Two British Poles are required for the new British boys. The units are not at Appendix 'C' to these minutes will be needed additional to existing units.

STATUS OF EQUIPMENT

9. After discussion it was agreed, subject to confirmation, that Poles would form the boys for Fifth Army and that the British boys should be formed under cadres at the subaltern wing of the new Fifth Army Depot. If, however, personnel are available before the Depot is set up, they may be detached direct to existing units provided they have been medically inspected, processed, clothed and equipped.

COMMITTEES

10. The Committee will be set up at Hq. and to deal with any further problems which may arise out of the formation of the boys. The following branches and services will be represented on this Committee:
