2. A certain amount of American equipment as listed below is held in the store at this Depot. This has been received from time to time from ex US-ITI P.O.Ws who have since been discharged. Will you please tell us how to dispose of these articles or whether they are to be issued.

III REASONS FOR THE PROPOSAL

(a) 802 Base Reinforcement Depot is to be converted into a Reorganisation Depot at which BR-ITI units will form, convert and disband.

(b) With the organisation of the Interim Italian Army, the RTC at CESANO will cease to deal with BR-ITI reinforcements. It is therefore anticipated that, during the period of organisation of this new army, the Italian Reorganisation Depot may be required to act also as a Reinforcement Depot for BR-ITI units.

No accurate forecast of the numbers to be administered by this unit can be given at this moment.

III. REASONS FOR THE PROPOSAL (cont)

(b) (cont)

It is considered that a flexible organisation is therefore required until the changeover is completed, when the policy for Reinforcement Depots etc. will be reviewed.

The Italian Establishment (Appendix 'B') has been produced to provide the maximum flexibility. The Depot Staff (Adm and Trg) which is divisible by three, can be employed either as a pool for allocation where necessary, or as three Depot Bn Staffs.

The Service Staffs, however, have been centralised as this is considered more economic.

(c) The British Cadre (Appendix 'A') has been reduced by one officer in view of the reduction of the Italian permanent staff, but has been increased by one clerk who has been found essential in the past. It is considered, however, that, in the main, the responsibilities will be the same, since the duties previously carried out by the permanent staff will not diminish but will in certain cases be carried out instead by the personnel of the units in the Depot.

No other reduction in the establishment can therefore be offered.

(d) For similar reasons no decrease in the scale of transport, now allowed on CM/71/1, is recommended.

(e) No comparative table is included as the new Italian establishment differs in form too completely from the establishment to be superseded.

(f) It is recommended that both these establishments should be subject to review in three months time, when the organisation of the Interim Italian Army should have been completed.

On unloading and checking into my stores a bale pertaining to contain drawers woollen was opened and found to contain, grass and weeds (which were definitely very fresh and wet) and one large stone, I immediately ordered a check of every individual item which consequently showed that other bales contained weeds etc. and some bales were found to be short of the prescribed number. I immediately placed the Officer and all his staff in open arrest pending instructions from you, upon which I acted immediately and released said Officer and party and ordered him to proceed back to his depot. 2986
- (2) I append herewith a list of articles missing, also attached please find statements by Officer I/C convoy and the two Sgt.Maj. in charge of material, together with names of all drivers, escorts and lorry Nos. 2987
- (3) Will you please forward necessary authority for me to strike these items off my ledger charge.

The underwriter, lieutenant Biancotti Ferdinando, of 10°Rgt. Drivers commanded for the transport of material from Naples to Orvieto declare the following.

- (1) The material transported has been charged to the store of Frattamaggiere (Naples) by⁷ truck and to store of Carmine (Naples city) by 2 truck.
- (2) This material was consigned with receipt to the single soldiers that was escorting the truck, in service with H.Q. Commissariate of Naples and, under the order of Sergt. Tarantino Carmine and Sgt. Major Quadrale Donato that were detailed to consign the material to the store of Orvieto.
- (3) During the voyage and the stop at Rome for receiving the orders to MMIA for the assignation of the material and truck coming from Sardegna, the "Escort Party" has never ~~been~~ abandoned his post.
- (4) Therefore the underwriter officer , technic responsible of the transport is not in a condition to specify whether to blame the Escort Party for the material missing or, if same was already missing at Naples (Stores);

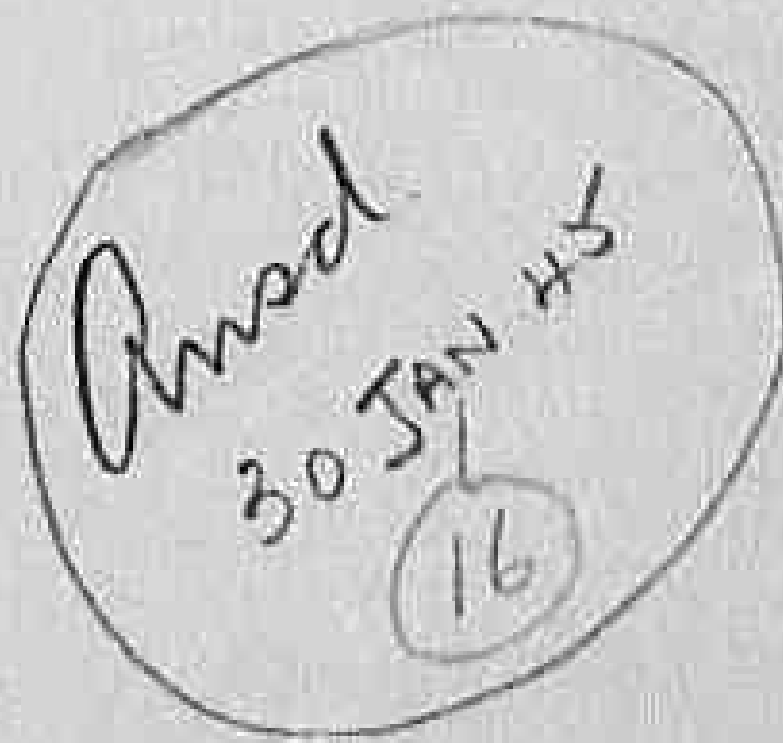

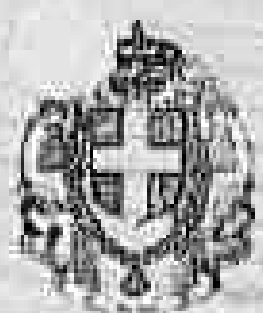
