SUBJECT: Thermal Station at Ischia.

TO : President of the Council of Ministers.

1. Your letter of 13 April 1945 requesting the intervention of this Headquarters in securing the release of a thermal station for the use of the Italian Land Forces resulted in the following action:

2. The statement made under the authority of your Council that all thermal stations in Central and Southern Italy had been requisitioned by the Allies, and that Italian Forces were thereby prevented from obtaining the use of these medical facilities was forwarded to the Director of Medical Services, Allied Forces Headquarters, with an endorsement of your request for the release of the Ischia station.

3. This request resulted in replies from both the British and American Medical Directorates that not one of the 40-50 spas in Central and Southern Italy had been requisitioned by the British or American medical services with the one exception of the station at Ischia which cannot be released.

4. This matter is brought to your notice as this Headquarters must naturally accept the statements of a body such as the Council of Ministers and pass this on to the Allied High Command.

5. This incident emphasizes the necessity of canalizing all requests for de-requisitioning of industrial establishments or other essential services through the Ministry of Industry, Commerce and Labour. This channel has been successfully in operation for several months.

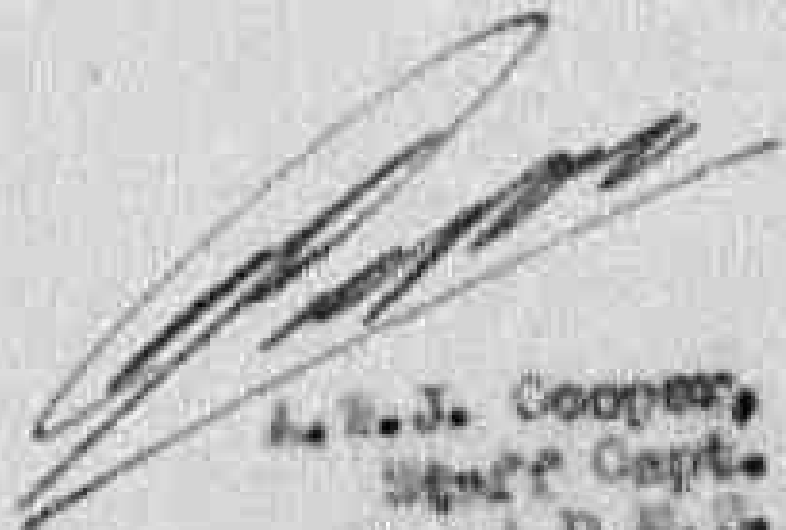

1. Reference your 1/2106/SAN 11th May 45. It is noted that of the only two Military Thermal Establishments in Italy the one at ACQUI is not requisitioned.
2. As the result of representations made to the Industry Sub Commission of Allied Commission by the Inter-Ministerial Council, application was made for the release of the Thermal Station at ISCHIA. It was stated by the Inter-Ministerial Council that all Thermal Stations in Central and Southern Italy had been requisitioned by the Allied Forces. The War Ministry was alleged to have corroborated this statement and to have endorsed the request for the release of such stations. Accepting the facts as stated, this H.C. endorsed the action taken by Industry Sub Commission.
3. A reply has now been received to the effect that the Thermal establishment at ISCHIA is the only establishment of this kind requisitioned by the Allies and that it cannot at present be released. You are requested to explain why it was alleged no Thermal Station remained at the disposal of the Italian Government and to furnish details of such stations, if any, which are occupied by the Allies.

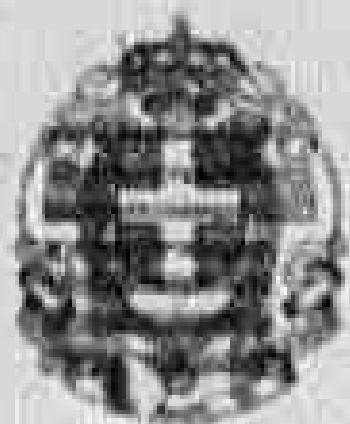
