SUBJECT: Convalescence home at TAORMINA receiving civilian rations.

1. With telegram 2469/03 dated Feb. 11, 1945 the PALERMO Mil. Territorial Command reports that the 204 Sub Area has insistently requested the immediate evacuation of the Convalescence Home at TAORMINO which receives civilian rations.

2. In regard to the above, said HQ. has ordered the transfer of the patients to another location while awaiting orders from this Ministry.

It is necessary to keep in mind the fact that the a/m establishment was formed with Ital. Mil. Administration materials, and loaned temporarily for the billeting of the ex POW's and those who have been patients for more than 60 days.

3. We would like to know whether or NOT the 204 Sub Area may request the evacuation and eventually occupy the establishment without authorization from the Allied Authorities concerned.

4. If the establishment must be evacuated, we believe it to be necessary that the materials be entirely recovered by the Med. Warehouses on the island for further use.

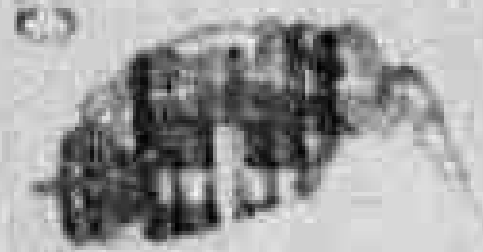

PERUGIA Military District H.Q. inform us that they have not been officially recognised by the local Allied H.Q. because the latter have not received any information from superior H.Q's, concerning the matter.

On account of this a/m Allied H.Q. avail themselves of military buildings and materials at PERUGIA, without bearing in mind reports submitted by District H.Q. As a matter of fact Allied H.Q. wish to provide accommodation for 209th Div. H.Q. at PORTENHACCI Barracks.

A/m barracks - where actually District H.Q. is located - must give accommodation to military of 1914 - 1924 classes that will report to PERUGIA for the call-up planned for UMBRIA.

Bearing in mind that in PERUGIA there are no other buildings available, the use of a/m barracks would not allow call-up operations to be carried out. I therefore inform M.M.I.A. for whatever action may be deemed advisable.

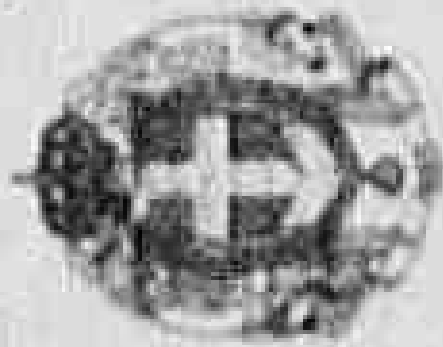

1. Further to the visit made by a British Staff Officer of this Headquarters to Il Sindaco on 20 Jan. subject - Safety Precautions at the Artillery Calibration Ranges, MATTUO, trace of which is held by your office.
2. It is confirmed that firing will take place at intervals by British personnel and that at least four days notice will be given prior to the date/s of commencement.

3. The periods for which the Range will be required are not yet known but it is of the utmost importance that due warning by means of a general proclamation be given to the civil population as quickly as possible. This was arranged at the time of the visit of the above-mentioned officer on 20 Jan.

4. The proclamation will definitely include the important point that when red flags are flying the civil population and all other persons will keep clear of the area and that entry will be made at their OWN RISK.

5. Notice boards in Italian and English are being prepared and will be mounted at salient points of the Range area; a copy of these notices are attached herewith.

6. It is the responsibility of Il Sindaco to ensure that full publicity and notice of the use of this area is given to the civil population immediately in the form of a proclamation. Normal safety precautions will be taken by the formation who will use the Ranges.

7. Liaison will be made with Il Sindaco by Headquarters Rome Area Allied Command prior to the dates of firing to ensure that the periods of shooting have been notified to the civil population and that all possible warnings have been given.

8. A copy of the general proclamation referred to in paragraph 3 is requested by this Headquarters within the next seven days.

9. Your co-operation and assistance would be appreciated in this matter and to the interest of the civil population.

1. I must again draw your attention most strongly to the fact that displaced persons are still occupying the Ministry of War barracks at CESSANO.
2. As you know, these barracks are required in toto forthwith for the establishment of the new "Combat Reinforcement Centre (PICENO)". You have placed a large contract so that the centre can be put forthwith into proper shape to receive reinforcements for training now for the Combat Groups. Without proper training these reinforcements can be of no use in battle; without proper amenities, morale, particularly of recruits who have never served in the army, can not be high; without full control of CESSANO barracks it is not possible to achieve either training or morale.
3. I must insist that the displaced persons be removed forthwith. I can have NO delay in this. ITALY is expecting much of her Combat Groups. You must give them the facilities to obtain the best possible reinforcements. Failure to do this is a definite hindrance to, even sabotage of the war effort. Therefore, the displaced persons must be removed at once.
4. I rely on you to see that this is done and will expect to hear from you very shortly that CESSANO barracks are at the complete disposal of the Ministry of War. You can rely on my fullest support (and that of A.F.H.Q.) in overcoming every obstacle.

1. The site of 68 (Br) General Hospital was promised to the Italian Army Medical Services by HQ AAI in June 44 at a time when repatriated P.O.s were an Italian Army responsibility. It is no longer required by the Italian Army, whose present hospital accommodation of 875 beds is more than ample for the troops on the island.

2. Probably the Military Command wish to have this hospital for P.O.s etc. and have acted on behalf of the Italian Government (civil). It is therefore not an MMIA problem and it is recommended that you straighten the situation out with the local A.C. and Public Health Sub-Commission and other Italian Authorities, according to existing conditions which are no longer known by MMIA.

3. Neither this hospital nor No. 33 site are required or will be authorized as Italian Military installations.

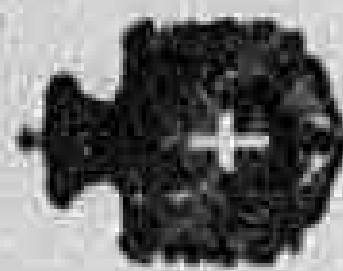

1. On 12 Jan 45, accompanied by Major SAMMILLI, your Engineer Officer, I visited TRANI Camp. The state of the Camp is far from satisfactory, and energetic and immediate action is required firstly to make the camp hygienic, secondly to improve the living conditions of the soldiers while stationed there.
2. Major SAMMILLI will have given you a full report on the engineering work required, but I wish to stress one point of vital importance which has already been reported several times before by Col. SALVOMI, O.C. TRANI Camp.
The lavatory system of one wing of the barracks has completely broken down. The resulting overflow, has soaked down through two storeys, and is in itself disgusting to sight and smell, renders the lavatories completely unusable, forms a considerable danger to health, and is depressing to the morale of the troops.
3. The following immediate action will therefore be taken.
(a) Deep trench latrines, not less than 12 feet, will be dug, sufficient for 1000 men. The latrines will be made fly-proof, and covered from the weather.
(b) The repair of the indoor lavatories will be undertaken, in order to provide night latrines.
4. Further recommendations for the improvement of the Camp will be the subject of a further letter, but meanwhile please give your personnel attention to the matters referred to above.

Thank you for the information on your medical policy.

I appreciate that the hospitals and convalescent camps are absolutely necessary, but I would point out that the Caserma Funzionale, Catania was a British Army requisitioned building, and after several thousand pounds had been expended to put the place in order, including new kitchen, huts etc, it was occupied by (60) British General Hospital.

It was de-requisitioned on the clear understanding that, if required as a hospital, it would be re-requisitioned, but without any reference to this HQ the Italian Army have taken the building over.

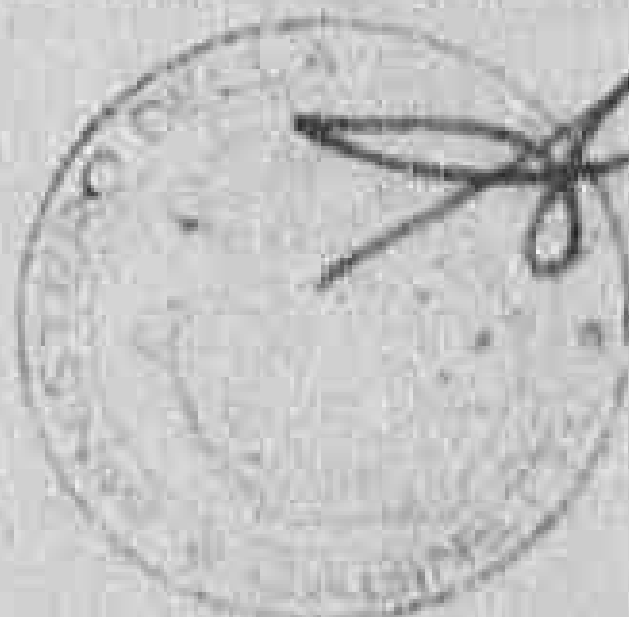

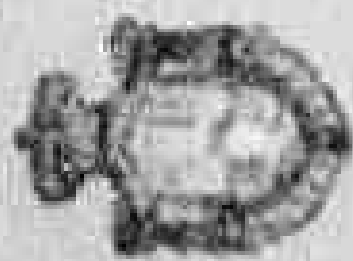
