1. Ref your letter AGC/3187/IC dated 3 July.

2. Forwarded herewith are Form AGC-HAT No.10 in triplicate for items named in pages 2 and 3 of my reference letter. The materials, especially lining cloth, are critically needed for repairs of uniforms and release at earliest date possible will be greatly appreciated.

3. This IC is not in a position to either confirm or disprove the statement that some of the materials named in the original list are in fact not the property of the Italian Army Administration. Our information on that point consists of a statement made in a letter from the Italian Ministry of War. It could appear, however, that material of the specific colour and texture used for Italian Army uniforms would have been produced with the distinct purpose of selling them to the Italian Army. There is a probability that my agreed price between the manufacturer and the Italian Army is less than the price that can now realize from other interested purchasers, and it might be equitable to raise the price to the Italian Army. The important factor is that cloth for repair and material for uniforms is urgently required if the Allies are going to continue to supply Italian Army forces as the important work on which they are at present engaged.

4. In view of the serious need for cloth, additional AGC-HAT No.10 for all remaining items on the original list are also herewith enclosed. It is requested that my portion of the materials which may still be available be released to the Italian Army at whatever price appears fair for anything that is not already Italian Army property.

1. Reference your H.Q./15/1 dated 17 June received at this H.Q. 2 July, and enclosing list of materials stated to be the property of the Italian Army Administration frozen at the Fratte branch of the Man. Coniere Meridionali.
2. This firm have been communicated with to confirm availability, and they state that the only materials in their possession which can be considered as being the property of the Italian Army Administration, through not yet paid for but having been inspected and accepted, are:-
58,854 metres Camouflage Cloth
95,000 " (approx) Grey Green lining (62 m)
3. There is also a quantity (323,829 metres) of Camouflage Cloth which has however not been inspected or accepted by the Italian Army Administration.
4. Of all other materials in the list, the M.C.M. state that they are not the property of the Italian Army Administration, have not been inspected nor accepted, and were not in most cases made for them against orders, but made for stock.
5. The M.C.M. under date 17 June communicated the full facts to the Direzione del Commissariato Militare delle FF.AA, but have received no reply.
6. In view of the above will you please say what action should be taken regarding release. The quantities shown in para 2 can be released at once, also that in para 3. As regards the remaining items, justification by the Italian Army Administration should be made out when release of such amounts as are still available could be made.

1. I have carefully considered the relevant points raised by Rear Eighth Army in their letter R/2011/2 Q of 29 Jun 44.
2. (a) It is apparent that the correct situation with regard to the clothing and equipment available and the method of supply has NOT been made clear at all times to Rear Eighth Army.

(b) For instance AFHQ ruled that it was NOT the policy to equip ITALIAN troops with K.D. as such from Allied sources. It has therefore been necessary to collect every possible Italian summer garment including captured stocks from U.S. and BRITISH. This has been done and the stock position changes daily as new stocks are received from abroad or brought in from isolated Italian country unit depots.

(c) The ordinary shirts provided by the Allies from U.S. sources and issued to Italian troops are of the cotton type. No issue of "shirts K.D." as such should have been contemplated. Priority of issue of cotton type shorts and long trousers is rightly given to combat units and NOT troops employed on ordinary labour duties.

3. In order to settle these complicated matters and so that the maximum maintenance may be given to the Italian troops under command of Eighth Army, I am sending forward a Grade 1 Staff Officer as Liaison Officer in place of the Grade 11 S.O. now there.

4. This officer, Lt. Col. VONHARTY, is fully in the picture concerning the available supplies, the most efficient method of procurement and the general policy concerning the maintenance of the Italian Army.

2. (a) It is apparent that the correct situation with regard to the clothing and equipment available and the method of supply has NOT been made clear at all times to Rear Eighth Army.

(b) For instance AFHQ ruled that it was NOT the policy to equip ITALIAN troops with K.D. as such from Allied sources. This has been done and the stock position changes daily as new stocks are received from abroad or brought in from isolated Italian country unit depots.

(c) The ordinary shirts provided by the Allies from U.739! sources and issued to Italian troops are of the cotton type. No issue of "shirts K.D." as such should have been contemplated. Priority of issue of cotton type shorts and long trousers is rightly given to combat units and NOT troops employed on ordinary labour duties.

3. In order to settle these complicated matters and so that the maximum maintenance may be given to the Italian troops under command of Eighth Army, I am sending forward a Grade 1 Staff Officer as Liaison Officer in place of the Grade 11 S.O. now there.

4. This officer, Lt.Col. MORIARTY, is fully in the picture concerning the available supplies, the most efficient method of procurement and the general policy concerning the maintenance of the Italian Army. This has changed considerably over the last few months. I have ordered him to explain the complete picture and, after consultation with Rear Eighth Army, make such immediate recommendations as may be necessary to improve the Italian method of food maintenance, bearing in mind the present limitations of Italian manpower, transport, etc.

5. In order that no unnecessary delay may take place, I am immediately despatching Lt.Col. Moriarty.

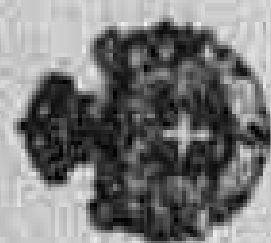

2. The supply of leather from Allied sources at present available to the Italian Army consist of a small quantity of soles now held in the Naples Depot. These are critically needed for boot repair work in your Boot Repair Shops, and it appears unadvisable to release any to the Finance Guards at this time. It is also impracticable to make small demands upon AGC or Allied Authorities for needs of individual formations or Departments of the Italian Armed Forces. Instead, one request for the need of the Italian Army as a whole should be made.

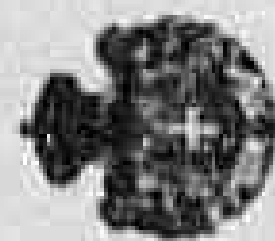
3. Another reason why approval cannot be granted in response to your letter is that no specific quantity is demanded.

4. Major Perrone may find it advisable to employ the repair facilities of the Finance Guard as part of the enlarged boot repair program and thereby avoid the necessity of considering their requirements of leather as a separate matter.

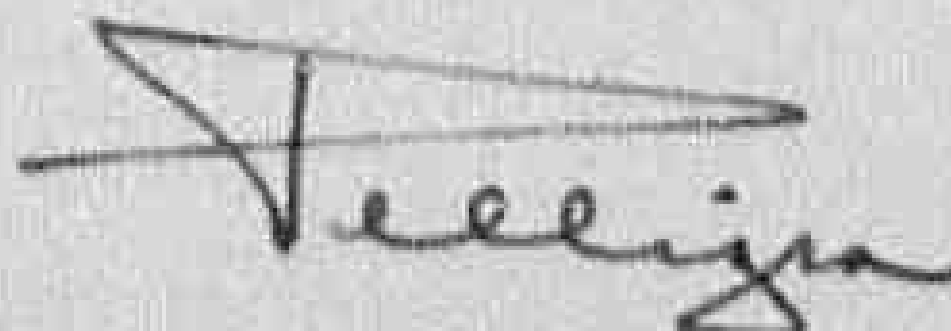

2. Information has now been received from Army Subcommission that the a/s firm of nail manufacturers have stated their inability to supply the nails required on account of the lack of raw materials.

3. Will you please investigate the circumstances, and if as alleged, cause action to be initiated as detailed in par. 4 of this HQ a/q letter of 2 June in order to obtain suitable materials.

4. It is understood that the deficiency consists of 30 Qli. (minimum) of 5 a/s iron rods or iron wire.

5. The attention of Gerosa should, if necessary, be directed to the terms of par. 7 of this HQ letter under reference, namely, that lack of cooperation will result in the plant's being taken over and operated by AGC.

6. As this demand is of high priority and the whole repair program is being held up for lack of nails, appropriate action should be taken as soon as possible.
