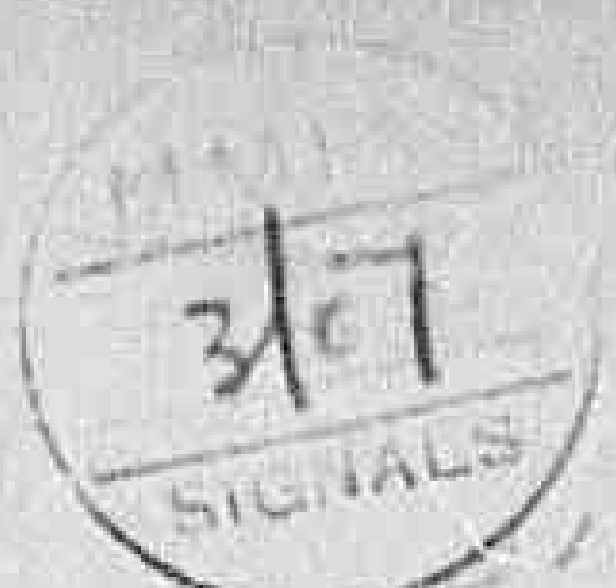

1. The need for an increased supply of shelter tents is immediate and urgent. It is estimated that 200,000 will be required in the near future.
2. According to information obtained 10 April approximately 25,000 partially completed shelter halves are now distributed in five plants, their delivery delayed due to lack of buttons. It was reported that the manufacture of buttons had been stopped by the inability of contractor to obtain coal.
3. Request for 150,000 meters of canvas has been submitted to AFLRB for consideration at April meeting. However, the manufacture of shelter halves should proceed with a minimum of interruption, using any materials made available by the commissariate. An increase of production to the rate of 10,000 per week is required if the present need is to be met promptly.
4. Weekly production report will be continued together with periodic transmittal of information regarding details of this project.
