1. Reference your No. 1254 (1st Ind) dated 12 Jan. 1945.
2. Enclosed are copies of Authorization Notices AQ/ITI-ITI/71 and AQ 45/ITI/48 dated 28 Jan. authorizing part of the items requested by Comando Territoriale Palermo in their Indent 71/111 dated 5 Jan. and Indent 74/111 dated 5 Jan.
3. The indents as submitted did not take into account the shipment which left Naples on 2-3 Jan. against old Authorizations AQ/61/455 and AQ/61/530. In other instances, the amounts requested appeared excessive or were, according to last inventory, already on hand in Italian Depots in Sicily. For example, the inventory shows 7,000 towels on hand which should be sufficient for some time.
4. A review of situation indicates that the operation of a Sub Depot in Sicily as provided under our letter AQ/15 of 22 October 44 is not working satisfactory. The principle difficulties appear to be:
 - a. Indents to bring stocks up to authorized levels have not been regularly rendered as required.
 - b. Movement of items from Mainland to Sicily has not been handled properly. Neither the War Ministry or Comando Territoriale Palermo have taken proper steps to arrange transportation and prompt movement. Items released AQ/61/530 on 24 Nov. 44 did not move until 2 Jan. 45 and probably required another two or three weeks for delivery.
5. It is felt that the plan is sound. The War Ministry has been advised that items released to Sicily must move promptly in the future. Will you please instruct the Italians at Palermo that they must also do their part. Will you see that indents are placed for needed items at least once every 30 days, and that a copy, after screening by you, is forwarded to HQ MMIA without delay.
6. The principle that the Sicilian garrison will be maintained to the fullest possible extent from local Italian stocks

must be strictly followed. They should find it possible to repair both clothing and boots to a sufficient extent to meet normal wastage (maintenance). Col. Albert made a survey of the stocks available for repair shortly before his departure, and with a few exceptions agreed that this is possible.

7. A more definite repair program is needed for Sicily, and the situation is under study at present. The matter will be taken up with you shortly. In the meantime, any recommendations or additional data on the situation will be appreciated.

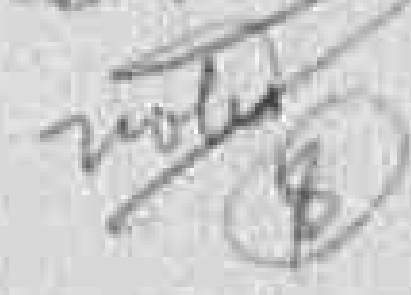

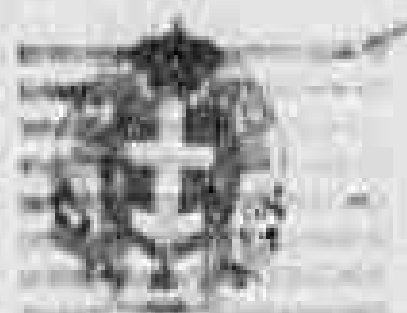

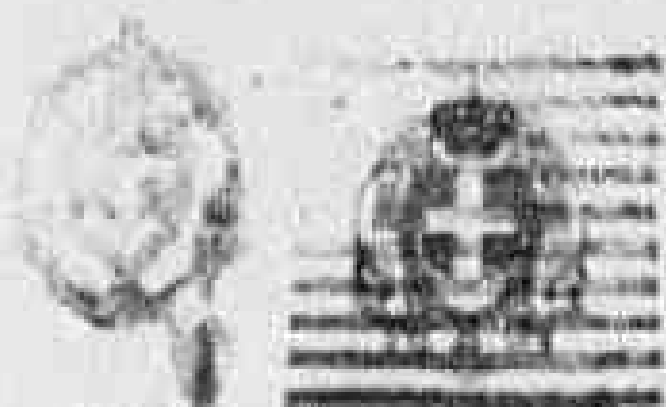

2. It appears from facts reported to this HQ that this Company did not arrive from Sardinia, but has been formed in Campania by the Campania Military Command, taking the men partly from the Afragola battalions of workers and partly from the 31st Infantry Rgt. of Naples. The men were forwarded to the Company with only one field blanket each, and they now still have only this one blanket.

3. In the circumstances will you please instruct the issue of a second blanket to each man of this Company. In view of the exceptional cold weather and the fact that the men are living in quarters lacking doors and practically windowless may a third blanket be issued temporarily for say three months when they would be withdrawn.
