1. Reference telephone conversation on 7 April between Major SHAE, Patriots Branch, and Major OMS, Land Forces Sub-Commission.
2. It is appreciated that normally M.B.I.A. can issue battle dress uniforms only to Italian Officers and men whose units appear in the current order of battle.
3. The nature of the work of Italian Military Patriot Representatives which involves close contact with Patriots of every political shade makes it advisable that the dress which they wear should be more democratic than the old uniforms of the Italian Army.
4. In addition these uniforms are entirely out of place at the front. It is requested, therefore, that green battle dress uniforms be made available to these officers. About 50 uniforms would be required.
5. As the matter is urgent a quick reply will be appreciated.
