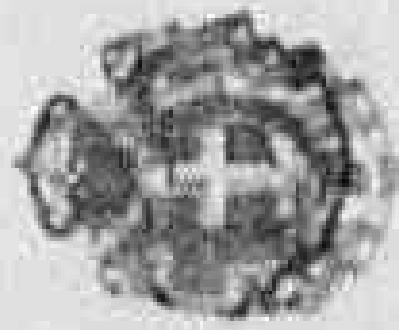

SUBJECT: Unserviceable Clothing Released to AC.

The Terr Comm. Dir. of Palermo has informed us that it will not be possible to use the unserviceable clothing released to the local A.C. for the purposes originally intended, since it concerns waste material obtained from salvage and reduced to rags and cuttings.

Therefore, the a/m Directorate has suggested to sell this material on the spot, instead of bearing the expenses of packing and transporting to then be sold at destination since from the material in question only fiber (tissue) can be obtained or raw materials suitable for repairs (boots).

The above is forwarded for whatever decision MMIA will deem appropriate to take.

In accordance with the instructions recently issued by A.C. concerning the sale of unserviceable materials stored at Bari, Palermo, Naples Depot (Ref. letter WMD/71/199 dated 1st May 1945, addressed to MMIA) and in view of the fact that a/m materials cause considerable hindrance to the smooth running of the service, this Ministry suggests that ~~same~~ be released to salvage shops in order to obtain fresh cloth for the military Administration or sold to private firms, at the best possible conditions, by auction supervised by the Comm. Dir of Rome.

Will you please forward your decisions on the matter.

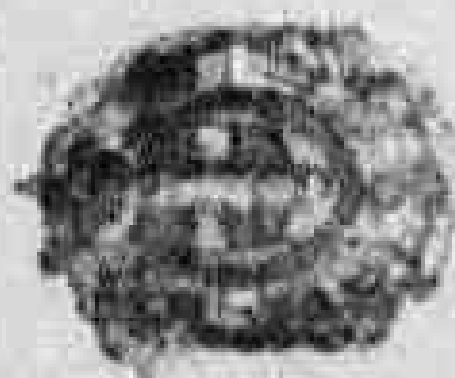

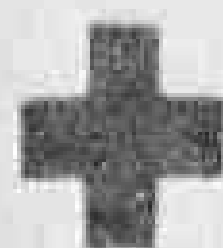

1. On 11 April 1945 a meeting was held at A.F. H.Q. attended by the Director of this Sub-Commission at which the question of supplying battledress for demobilized Italian Army soldiers was discussed. The following arrangements were made:

A. It would be the responsibility of this Sub-Commission to supply MIA with battledress for demobilized Italian soldiers and such garments would be dyed black.

B. It was stated that to meet this commitment Commerce Sub-Commission would receive increased quantities of salvaged garments for repair and dyeing.

2. On 21 May this Sub-Commission released to M. E. I. A. 10,000 dyed battledress and M. E. I. A. further requested that 5,000 battledress be made available on 1 June and the same quantity on the first of each month thereafter.

3. In the month of April this Sub-Commission had approximately 3,500 repaired battledress for allocation, the largest part of which were consigned to military units employing civilian labor. It is apparent that if 5,000 battledress must be consigned to M. E. I. A. every month in the future heavy workers, patriots, and displaced persons will suffer an appreciable loss in the quantity of clothing which they have been accustomed to receiving.

- 2 -

4. At this time therefore this Sub-Commission requests from A.P.E.C. a ruling on the priority that this demand for garments for demobilized soldiers has in relation to that for the heavy outdoor workers who in recent months have been receiving the largest part of the reprocessed clothing. Further, information is requested as to when this Sub-Commission may expect to receive increased quantities of salvaged garments, for if this office is to maintain its commitments and also to meet this relatively new demand from WHIA an augmented supply must be forthcoming in the future.

The matter has again been referred to Land Forces Sub-Commission (M.M.I.A.) and it is understood that the original contribution from the U.S. and British armies for the clothing of the Italian Armed Forces is in no way affected by returns by Italian Depots of articles to either U.S. or British Depots.
4. The movements of British articles between Italian and U.S. Depots only represent an intermediary stage in the operations and records are maintained by this office of the quantities of British items of clothing returned by Italian Depots but at present held by U.S. Depots. If at the cut-off date, the articles in question have not been reissued to the Italian Forces and reported by M.M.I.A. the records maintained here are sufficiently detailed to establish the basis for any adjustment between the U.S. and British armies.

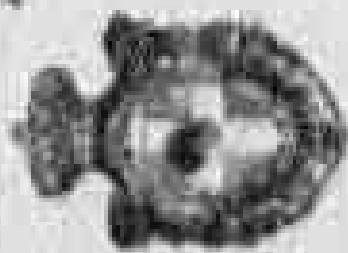

Clothing issue to wounded evacuated to Territorial Hospitals.

"FRIGLI" Combat group HQ have informed this ministry that the wounded of the group evacuated to Territorial hospitals (mainly BARI - ALCANTARA - FANO) are meeting, at the time of discharge, with difficulties in obtaining clothing to leave the place of treatment.

This is due to:

1) The wounded are struck off strength of their unit which, therefore, cannot supply the required clothing.

2) The clothing in possession of the wounded whom we send to hospital, is nearly always in unserviceable condition in that it is dirty with blood and very often cut by the medical officer who had to operate or render first aid.

3) and that even the eventual sending of clothing would not be advisable or possible owing to the distance between the front and these hospitals.

4) and that, often, the unit does not know the actual location of their own wounded.

These Commands suggest to place at the disposal of said hospitals, the required clothing articles for the clothing of the convalescents, the uniform, from a moral point of view, should be white as it is the colour of the uniform of the

uniform of the combat group instead of the usual green
uniform.

This above is communicated to MACV for any
action they may deem advisable to take.

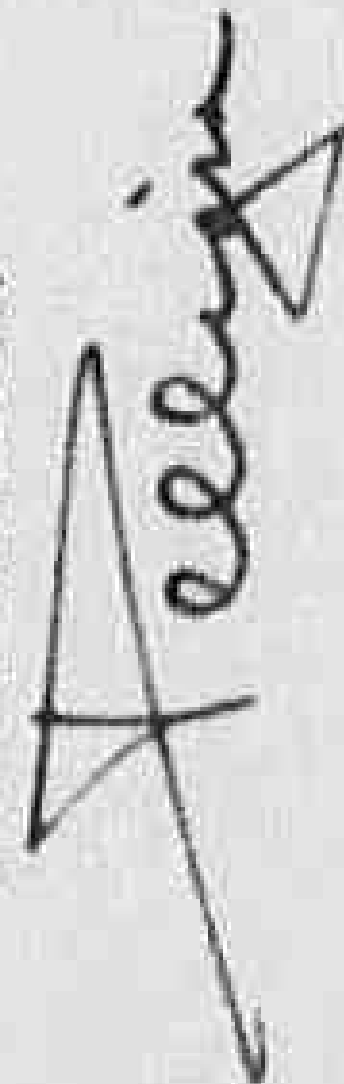
