As explained, figures given are derived from several sources which, in many cases, do not agree, and have not as yet been reconciled. Those judged to be most accurate are given.
3. In the figures of B.D., those for SICILY are included both as regards Receipts and issues. Total figures are given i.e. the 10,000 Suits issued to the SARAUHA Div. (to be accounted for by No. 1 District) are reflected in both the ~~XXXX~~ Receipt & Issue columns. No further information is available as regards SICILY and none whatever for SARDINIA.
4. Major CHOWN reports that Stocks of Socks, Mackinaws, Drawers and Shirts are now arriving into the NAPLES Depot.

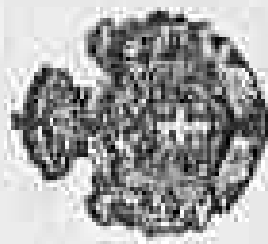

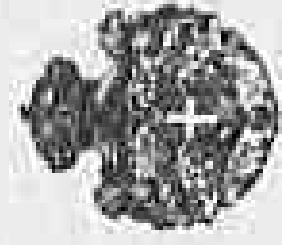

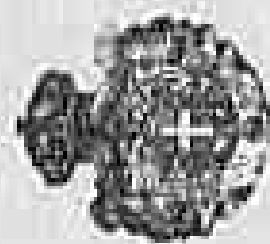

1. In order to implement the items of fresh fruit in the ration scale it is essential that you make arrangements to dispatch the following substitutes to Corsica forthwith.

2. Dried fruit pulp from Italian sources should be shipped for issue in lieu of fresh fruit on the basis of 1 ounce dried fruit pulp for 4 ounces of fresh fruit. Dried vegetables from Italian sources should be shipped for issue in lieu of fresh vegetables on basis of 2 ounces dried vegetables for 8 ounces fresh vegetables.

3. Sufficient quantities will be dispatched to cover a 30 day supply, and you are requested to ship by Cruiser to Sardinia when arrangements for trans-shipment to Corsica can be made.

1. Sardinia.

(i) He stated fresh fruit and vegetables are available in Sardinia in quantities adequate for the troop strengths to be fed.

(ii) Until the nut season is here Sardinia have asked if they may issue 2 ozs extra fresh fruit in lieu of nuts. This applies also to the mainland from May to September and it is recommended we give approval.

(iii) He stated there is ample salt in Sardinia.

(iv) Only pipe and cigar tobacco is grown in Sardinia and due to lack of coal for drying, the tobacco produced has a moisture content of about 16%, which is high and renders the tobacco injurious to health.

Note (a) Sardinia produces fairly considerable quantities of an inferior coal. It is known that some is being exported for Allied use, but if suitable allocation were made to take care of the tobacco crop, it might be possible for the Ministry of War to carry some of the tobacco to the mainland and thus relieve the shortage here.

(b) A critical shortage appears to exist in the supply of cigarette paper. The main source of production in Italy is in Trieste and is not now available.

In view of the high morale factor attaching to a regular issue of cigarettes it is for consideration whether supplies of paper should not be imported as a charge against the Italian Government. Shipping space needed is very small.

(c) The Ministry of Finance have in effect said 'Sardinia must look after itself itself as regards tobacco and cigarettes' and have allowed no provision for the island.

(d) The tobacco factory in Lecce is operating at a very considerably reduced capacity due to shortage of coal and cigarette paper. The tobacco stocks there are going rotten.

(e) Sardinia coal and imported paper would help to relieve the situation.

I have instructed them to search for 8 suitable motor powered schooners to operate between Gallipoli and Cagliari. Most of the wine comes from Apulia and oil from Calabria. Consequently shipment from Gallipoli will reduce requirements for rail transport on the mainland.

8 Schooners will be needed to carry the tonnage, cover the turn round and allow for maintenance and periodical shipping of vessels.

If the Ministry of War can find these vessels we should strongly support their request to operate them as Italian Army water transport, on lines similar to those adopted in British Army water transport companies.

Corsica.

(i) On the bases of strengths the Ministry consider that there should be adequate supplies of fresh fruit and vegetables on the island to maintain Italian troops there.

That there are difficulties in the island is probably due to the attitude adopted by the local inhabitants.

Fruit will travel from Sardinia to Corsica and arrive, for the most part, in fit condition for consumption.

Vegetables present more difficulty but transshipment from Sardinia to Corsica seems the only possibility.

(ii) Wine oil and salt should be transhipped from Sardinia to Corsica at present, under arrangements by A.C. Sardinia. Direct shipment can be made if Italian Army secures the schooners proposed above.
