1. Reference this HQ No. ST/102/10 dated 9 and 14 June 45, in which instructions relative for the movement of supplies to and from SARDINIA were given.
2. In future, all maintenance items will be shipped in the vessels SS "CAMPIDOGGIO" and SS "ABBAZIA", under arrangements to be made between this HQ and Transportation Sub Commission (AC) office at NAPLES thus dispensing with the requirement to submit bids for movement through AFHQ, 35 days in advance of anticipated time of the ship's sailing date.
3. Bids for movement will continue to be submitted by you as in the past, but will reach this HQ 14 days in advance instead of 35, as shown in attached schedule, (Appendix 'A').
4. Under this revised system your next bid should reach this office by noon on 31 August 45 for period 13 Sept - 22 Sept.
5. This refers only to dates on which bids for movement are to be submitted to this HQ. Your calculations for amounts of supplies to be shipped remain unaltered, i.e. a sixty (60) day working stock on the Island based on a ration strength of the Island including Army, OC.HR., Air Force and Navy, as pointed out in this HQ letters under reference.
6. For your information sailing programme of the two vessels up to 1 Oct 45, are given at Appendix 'B'.

SUBJECT: Conservation of Electric Power

TO: All Concerned

1. The following letters, this headquarters, containing previous instructions on this subject, are hereby rescinded:

a. File AG 675/171 GDS-O, dated 31 October 1944, Subject: "Conservation of Electric Power Facilities of Italian Utilities."

b. File AG 675/047 GDS-O, dated 18 January 1945, Subject: "Conservation of Electric Power Facilities of Italian Utilities."

2. Although the electric power situation generally has improved over the past few months, there is still a serious shortage in central and southern Italy. In order to conserve the limited supply of electric power available and to meet the military and essential civilian requirements, it is necessary to reduce to a minimum non-essential electricity consumption from supply undertakings by both military and civilian users in Italy south of the northern boundaries of the provinces of Lucca, Pistoia, Firenze and Ravenna.

3. South of the boundary referred to the following steps will be taken to reduce loads on commercial electric systems.

a. LIGHTING

(1) Offices - No lights will be burned during daylight hours except in cases where natural lighting is insufficient for proper working conditions. Wattage of lamps will be limited to a minimum requirement, and fixtures will be located for most economical utilization of light source.

(2) Halls and Stairways - Lamps in halls, corridors and stairways will be of the smallest wattage commensurate with safety, and a minimum number will be illuminated.

(3) Hotel Rooms and Private Living Quarters - No more than two (2) lamps per private living room and one (1) lamp per bath room will be connected. No more than one (1) lamp per private living room will be illuminated at the same time. The lamp bulb will not exceed sixty (60) watt rating. Lighting, when permitted in living tents of military personnel, will be limited to one (1) lamp of sixty (60) watt rating in pyramidal or small wall tent.

- (4) Public Space in Hotels, Cafes, Clubs and Public Buildings - Wattage will be reduced to a bare essential commensurate with area, use and occupancy. All electric signs or display lighting will be discontinued.
- (5) Other Military Facilities - Lighting of mess halls, kitchens, work shops, etc., will not exceed the following scale:

<u>Type of Accommodation</u>	<u>Watts per sq ft.</u>
Store Room, Latrine	0.2
Mess hall, Post Exchange)	
Hospital Ward, Bath House)	0.3
Kitchen, Recreation Building	0.5

- (6) Outdoor Areas - Guarded areas, POW enclosures, storage areas, streets, etc., will be lighted only in accordance with necessity.
- (7) Lights Not In Use - All lights not being used will be turned off. Post signs conspicuously and make every individual economy-minded in use of electricity.

b. HEATING AND COOKING

- (1) Electric heating will be permitted only in essential industrial processes engaged in production for the military effort, and in hospitals for the treatment of patients.
- (2) No electric cooking will be permitted.

c. POWER

- (1) The use of electric power will be limited to:
- Those industries contributing directly to the military effort or essential to the civilian economy.
 - Installations necessary to safeguard public health.
- (2) Elevators will be operated by electric power only for movement of hospital patients or for heavy freight.
- (3) Electric motors will not be allowed to idle for extended periods.

d. ELECTRIC RAILWAY POWER will be utilized only on approval by the Electric Power Committee of the AFIR (Italian) Board.

e. ELECTROLYTIC PROCESSES AND ELECTRIC ARC FURNACES will be utilized only on approval by the Electric Power Committee of the AFIR (Italian) Board.

Distribution plans for consumer goods must not be delayed pending submission and approval of more elaborate and time consuming production plans.

12. In those cases where necessary interim action has caused the creation of regional industrial committees or organizations which now become in conflict with this overall plan, every effort will be expended to effect the harmonious transition of the local organization into the appropriate industrial committee created by this order. Failing this, local conflicting groups must be disbanded in furtherance of the subject plan.

13. General Order No. 41, Allied Military Government, is modified insofar as it is in conflict with the provisions of this order.

b. There will be established a North Italy Industrial Council. The President of the council will be designated by the Italian Government. In addition there will be six members, one designated by the National Commissioner of each of the five regions of Allied Military Government and one appointed by Allied Military Government on the recommendation of the labor organizations to represent labor. This Industrial Council will have its office in Milan.

The functions of this Council will be:

- (1) To coordinate, direct and expedite the work of the Industrial Committees and to take final action on their recommendations.
- (2) To determine what goods of North Italy industry are available for distribution to the consuming public of all of Italy.

- (6) To ascertain the amounts of the finished products within the industry available for distribution and to recommend the distribution of same.
- (7) To recommend which products of the industry, if any, should be subject to regulation and control in their manufacture and sale.

- (1) Upon recommendations of the Industrial Committees, to fix, where it is deemed necessary, the manufacturers' purchase and sale prices of raw materials and semi-fabricated goods and finished products.
 - (2) To establish, if deemed necessary, advisory committees, either on a regional or other basis.
- d. The North Italy Industrial Council will determine what goods are available for distribution to the consuming public (1) for the provinces under the jurisdiction of the Italian Government, and (2) for the provinces in Northern Italy under the jurisdiction of the Allied military government.

The distribution of the consumer goods which are to be regulated will be made in Northern Italy as follows:

I. As soon as Florence was liberated a special platoon of the topo-cartographic group of this S.M. was authorized by the H.Q. Allied Armies in Italy, through the intermediary of your Mission and the Survey Service, to enter the city immediately in order to protect the material and equipment of the Army Geographical Institute. The timeliness of this measure proved extremely effective with regard to the material found although the same did not, unfortunately, amount to much, since immediately after September 8, 1943 the Germans started to carry away instruments and machinery which were concentrated at Dobbiaco, Bergamo and Riale.

The loss of this scientific material, and especially of the zinc plates and original maps, would constitute a serious loss for the Institute and would represent the destruction of almost a century of work.

II. The Italian Military Liaison Mission with the 15TH Army Group was approached in order to obtain an authorization to send to Riale (Bologna), Bergamo and Dobbiaco platoons of officers and specialized personnel of the Army Geographical Institute for the purpose of locating and recovering the material as per attached list.

The platoons would be made up as follows:

Report on Visit to TERNI
Small Arms Factory - 19 Apr. 45

1. Object of visit. To investigate present posn at factory, to discover exact extent of recent complaints and to discuss with War Ministry and local representatives whether present posn was to be changed.
2. Visited. Regional Commissioner AMG. He has just taken over the appointment but knows of the recent complaints and correspondence (Lt. Van Erde, etc.) He is quite clear on the procedure to be used to inspect the factory or to obtain material from it. Apart from a desire that the civilian firms already established there remain (mentioned in correspondence) he has no designs on buildings or equipment.
3. Visited 80 EBW SAEC ref. most recent letter (War Ministry 207440 of 3 Apr. 45) Present OC (Capt Cane SAEC) has just taken over from Capt. Harris who was responsible for action mentioned in M of W letter. I explained the position of the factory to the OC, and he was already aware that he has no power to requisition etc., but that any requests for machinery or material should pass through this H.Q.

The requirements of the TERNI Society (the subject of the M of W letter) have in fact been reduced to 3 items of material for which amicable negotiations are taking place with factory & M of W.

MEETING WITH M of W. Rep.

4. Discussed the whole subject with Maj. Davidson MMIA and:-

Magg. IUZZOLINO M of W rep.
T/Col. SCOZZDRI OC factory.

plus a number of civilian employees who seem to run the place.

5. Present Posn of Factory.

a. Only 8 small machines in one shop are working in the whole factory. A number of other machines are being overhauled, but at present most of the shops are unused and unusable. The work being carried out is on 10,000 saw teeth for the Allies by arrangement with 80 EBW.

b. The following civilian manufacturing activities are going on in certain buildings (supervised by AMG)

Sack manufacturing.
Wool factory
Engineering & reconstruction work.
Electrical work.

c. The following allied units occupy certain buildings (billets and stores)

These have been there some months.

6. Confirmed with M of W and OC factory that instructions as contained in our Q/24 of 17 Apr. 45 were clearly understood and that any Allied demands for material, equipment, buildings or entry into the factory would only be allowed on authority from MMIA. Any demands should be made by Allies on us who would give authority after consultation with M of W. OC factory produced a demand for 10,000 bricks (from 281 Wks Section R.E.). I confirmed this fell under the same rules.
7. M of W and OC factory stated that they were quite happy about the present AMG and Allied unit occupiers (para. 5(b) & (c)) and that they required no action on these; but were apprehensive that additional units would try to move in. Told them that the present instructions would protect them against that (I consider present occupiers should be left).
8. M of W and OC stated that they required no action to be taken to recover material or plant removed in the past.
9. M of W were completely in the picture on the TERNI Society requests and any agreement reached would be as the M of W wished. M of W said no action was required on this.
10. M of W rep. said they were trying to open up the factory slowly mainly to undertake work for Allies - the same story as given in 207440
220-10-6 of 30 April. The main difficulty was certain equipment (belts, etc.) and raw material. They seemed to have no clear idea of what was required. I told them that any particular requirements they had for particular work should be submitted by M of W to us giving full details of what and why, when they would no doubt be considered on their merits by us.
11. M of W Rep. and OC factory stated they were quite clear and happy about the present posn. and had no further points for discussion. I told them that in emergency the OC could call on Maj. Davidson.
12. The OC then complained that certain of the Allied units (315 Q Mech. Eqpt and 734 REME) in the factory were tearing up the wooden blocks from the floors for firewood. While going round the buildings I discovered a member of 315 Mech. Eqpt. at this task. I called on both the units concerned and immediate instructions were being issued for the practice to cease.
13. Generally no action seems necessary in connection with the factory.

SUBJECT: Removal of materials belonging to the

The Allied Supervisory Office 80 E.B.W. of the S.A.E.C. gave the "Terni" Soc. the task of ascertaining whether there existed, in the Italian Army Weapons Factory of Terni, machinery suitable for the execution of work entrusted to the aforementioned Society by the Allies.

On the 23rd. January 1945, representatives of the "Terni" Soc., in possession of an order of which we enclose a copy (Enc. 1), visited the Italian Army Weapons Factory and discovered that the machines shown on the enclosed list (Enc. 2) would be needed for the work noted.

The "Terni" Society was then instructed by the 80th. E.B.W. to make direct agreements with the aforementioned Weapons Factory for obtaining the handing over of the required machines on some security or through the drawing up of a lease or on sale, declaring that, in the event of an agreement not being reached on the aforementioned terms, the 80th. E.B.W. would have to requisition the said machinery.

The question, submitted in these terms, induced the Directorate General of Artillery and Motorisation of this Ministry to decide upon the temporary handing over of the machinery requested, with the obligation that the "Terni" Society seek to the putting of the machinery back into a serviceable condition, considering the expenses incurred for the repairs as deductible from the cost of the lease which the Society will have to pay to the military administration.

I submit that the procedure followed by the 80th. E.B.W. does not correspond with that laid down by M.M.I.A., in view of the fact that I consider that the case indicated does not come under operational necessities, for which the Allied operational H.Q.s can issue instructions without the authorisation of M.M.I.A.

I shall therefore be grateful if M.M.I.A. would be so kind as to take the necessary action in order that in the future the area Allied Authorities adhere to the instructions in force.

I take the opportunity to submit the advisability of the Allied departments applying directly to the military establishments for the works which they require and not imposing ~~an~~ the handing over of machines to private firms, justifying such handing over by the fact that the machines are inoperative.

Already some military establishments are carrying out work of various descriptions for the Allies and I consider that such activities could be advantageously extended to other establishments, opening up the possibility of employing the craftsmen of those establishments.

In the event that afterwards such handing over might be rendered necessary because of particular reasons of work, I submit the convenience of transferring, together with the machines, also the workmen employed on them, this above all in order to safeguard, against all eventualities, the national inheritance of the State, which, on the handing over, would be kept under the control of the military administration. Said condition has already been inserted in the draft of undertaking submitted for acceptance to the "Terni" Society in respect of the loan of the machines requested by them.

1. Reference is made to basic communication, and attached letter from the Ministry of War, dated 6 March 1945, subject: "Allied Occupation of the Optical Glass Factory in Cecchignola".

2. The articles as follows, alleged to have been taken from the Optical Glass Factory, were not in the buildings when taken over by American military personnel:

11 wooden closets
6 tables
8 chairs

With reference to the 11 radiators, when the steam heating system was filled with water to test it with the view to activating the unit, it was discovered then that many of the radiators were either broken through sabotage, shell fire, or vandalism, prior to occupation by the American personnel. Many of the radiators leaked beyond repair, but by using the good parts and assembling them, it was possible to reconstruct usable radiators. These are now in the same area, although some of them are not in the original buildings, and will be available to the Ministry of War if and when we evacuate the area at some future date.

3. The construction work in the Cecchignola area was done by the 345th Engineers. They used available building materials on the site, and have kept a complete record of all materials used. It is recommended that all inquiries regarding this and future claims of this type be forwarded to them.

The British Unit 395 th. R.A. which replaced the 232 nd R.A. in the occupation of the Optical Glass Factory at CECCHIGNOLA and which moved out on Feb. 3rd destroyed the following : 15 pipes for the drainage of water from the roofs, 14 doors, 9 crucibles, 6 clay moulds for crucibles, 40 bases and 18 wooden cradles for the manufacture of crucibles, 5 wooden cases for refractory mixtures, and damaged one Porta (extension) ladder, the total damage being about 126.500 Lire.

Furthermore, American Military Personnel from the Engineers School carried away the following material on the 6th and 7th of Feb. last :-

II wooden closets
6 tables
8 chairs
II radiators for steam-heating system.

for a total value of 109.800 Lire.

Stores have occurred in the past, particularly at the Procurement Depot, Cairo, where Italian Army stores have been removed without prior authority being obtained from HQA.

HQA state that requests from Allied authorities for Italian property are always promptly met.

HQA ensure that in future all requests for Italian Army stores or material are submitted through the proper channels to HQA, and that no further unauthorized appropriation takes place.
