M.M.I.A. ADMINISTRATIVE INSTRUCTION NO. 22

1. OBJECT.

The object of this instruction is to clarify the scales, sources of provision and method of distribution for certain supplies to the ITALIAN Army.

2. AUTHORITY.

This instruction is issued consequent to AFHQ orders contained in Signal FX29488 of 18 Feb 45 and in conjunction with the Instruction Number 3630/SI of 20 Feb issued by the ITALIAN Ministry of War.

3. APPLICATION.

Except where specifically otherwise indicated, this instruction applies to ER-ITIS (Combat and Service tps) and any tps of other categories which may be temporarily maintained through ER-ITIS channels. The scales given are applicable to all categories of tps.

4. ADM DIVS.

In order that Combat tps may not be worried in unnecessary adm details in the rear and to enable ER-ITIS to be self supporting with the minimum ER assistance, it has been decided that the ER-ITIS Adm Divs shall take adm responsibility as far as possible for all ER-ITIS tps (Combat and Service tps).

5. RATIONS.

(a) The standard ration scale for the Italian Army (all categories) is:-

Allied provided items.

Dried vegetables	2 oz.
Meat, canned, or fish preserved	3 oz.
Cheese	1 oz.
Sugar	1 oz.
Macaroni	3 oz.
Rice	1 oz.

2. AUTHORITY.

This instruction is issued consequent to AFHQ orders contained in Signal PX29488 of 18 Feb 45 and in conjunction with the Instruction Number 3630/SI of 20 Feb issued by the Italian Ministry of War.

3. APPLICATION.

Except where specifically otherwise indicated, this instruction applies to BR-III (Combat and Service tps) and any tps of other categories which may be temporarily maintained through BR-III channels. The scales given are applicable to all categories of tps.

4. ADM DIVS.

In order that Combat tps may not be worried in unnecessary adm details in the rear and to enable BR-III to be self supporting with the minimum Br assistance, it has been decided that the BR-III Adm Divs shall take adm responsibility as far as possible for all BR-III tps (Combat and Service Tps).

5. RATIONS.

- (a) The standard ration scale for the Italian Army (all categories) is:-

The special allotment of salt for use in bakeries set out in MIAA letters AQ/2-50 of 3 Jan 45 and AQ/2-55 of 20 Feb 45 remains unchanged. The provision of this extra salt is an ITALIAN provided item.

(b) Indent, provision and issue of the Allied portion to BR-ITIS.

- (i) In Fifth Army, Eight Army and One District.

Indent, provision and issue is through normal ST channels to Unit.

- (ii) In remainder of ITALY - SICILY - SARDINIA.

MIAA indent on ST for issue into Italian Main Depots. Issue from Italian Main Depots to Units is through Italian channels.

(c) Indent, provision and issue of the ITALIAN provided portion to BR-ITIS.

- (i) In Fifth Army, Eight Army and One District.

ST indents on MIAA who will instruct the Italian Government to make available to ST Base Depots (normally 14 CRASC). Delivery from ST Base Depots to unit is through ST channels.

When considered desirable by ST, local purchase is made under ST arrangements and necessary vouchers sent to MIAA for a cash claim to be made against the Italian Government.

- (ii) In remainder of ITALY - SICILY - SARDINIA.

The provision and issue is an ITALIAN responsibility through ITALIAN channels.

6. CIGARETTES.

- (a) (i) FREE ISSUE: Scale is 5 cigarettes per man per day for all tps of all categories.

- (ii) ADDITIONAL FREE ISSUE: An additional free issue has now been authorized for certain tps on a scale of 5 per man per day. At the time this new scale was announced the Italian Government had NOT taken any provision action and did NOT have stocks available. It is estimated that supplies will have been distributed to meet this new commitment by 7 Mar 45. Any issue made prior to that date will correspondingly prejudice the March issues. This issue is authorized for

(c) Indent, provision and issue of the ITALIAN provided portion to BR-ATIS.

(i) In Fifth Army, Ninth Army and One District.

ST indents on MIA who will instruct the Italian Government to make available to ST Base Depots (normally 14 CRASO). Delivery from ST Base Depots to unit is through ST channels.

When considered desirable by ST, local purchase is made under ST arrangements and necessary vouchers sent to MIA for a cash claim to be made against the Italian Government.

(ii) In remainder of ITALY - SICILY - SARDINIA.

The provision and issue is an ITALIAN responsibility through ITALIAN channels.

6. CIGARETTES.

(a) (1) FREE ISSUE: Scale is 5 cigarettes per man per day for ALL tps of all categories.

(ii) ADDITIONAL FREE ISSUE: An additional free issue has now been authorized for certain tps on a scale of 5 per man per day. At the time this new scale was announced the Italian Government had NOT taken any provision action and did NOT have stocks available. It is estimated that supplies will have been distributed to meet this new commitment by 7 Mar 45. Any issue made prior to that date will correspondingly prejudice the March issues. This issue is authorized for

(a) ALL tps fwd of Fifth and Eighth Army Rear Boundaries.

(b) FRIULI, CREMONA, LEGNANO, FOLIGNO AND MILITOVA Combat Groups, wherever located.

(c) CASSANO Combat Group Rpts Centre.

(iii) REPAYMENT CIGARETTES.

(a) The ITALIAN Government supply certain quantities of cigarettes for issue by the Italian Authorities upon repayment. The scale of provision is 5 per day per man as far as supplies will permit. These cigarettes are normally of the "MILIT" brand. The responsibility of obtaining payment from the tps is that of the Italian Military authorities.

(b) Indent, provision and issue of FREE ISSUE cigarettes to RR-ITIS.

(i) In Fifth Army, Eight Army and One District.

ST indents on MOLA for the required quantity. MOLA will instruct the ITALIAN Government to hand over to ST at 14 CRASC or such other place as may be agreed. Delivery from ST Depots to Units is through ST channels.

(ii) In remainder of ITALY - SICILY - SARDINIA the provision and issue is an ITALIAN responsibility through ITALIAN channels.

(c) Indent, provision and issue of REPAYMENT CIGARETTES to RR-ITIS.

(i) In Fifth Army, Eight Army and One District the Adm Div (254 Div, 228 Div and 209 Div) will demand on War Ministry the requisite quantity for ALL RR-ITIS in the Div Area and any other tps for whom the Div has Adm responsibility. MOLA LO will inform HQ MOLA of the quantities demanded. HQ MOLA will instruct the Italian Government to hand the quantity to ST Base Depots or direct to Adm Div if from a local factory. ST will deliver and to Adm Divs such quantities as have been handed to ST Depots. The responsibility of distribution and collection of payments is that of the Adm Div. MOLA is responsible for informing the D.S.C. of any quantities handed direct to Adm Divs in order that ST Depots may consign their supply accordingly.

(ii) In remainder of ITALY - SICILY - SARDINIA the provision, issue and sale is an ITALIAN responsibility through Italian channels.

7. SCALE.

(a) Scale upon which the Italian Government bases provision action is:-

(i) 300 grammes per man per month for all tps fwd of Fifth and Eight Army Rear Boundaries.

(ii) 250 grammes per man per month for all tps behind Fifth and Eight Army Rear Boundaries.

(iii) 200 grammes per mule or horse per month.

(c) Indent, provision and issue of ESSENTIAL CIGARETTES to BR-ITIS.

- (i) In Fifth Army, Eight Army and One District the Adm Div (234 Div, 228 Div and 209 Div) will demand on War Ministry the requisite quantity for all BR-ITIS tps in the Div area and any other tps for whom the Div has Adm responsibility. MIA LO will inform HQ MIA of the quantities demanded. HQ MIA will instruct the Italian Government to hand the quantity to ST Base Depots or direct to Adm Div if from a local factory. ST will deliver and to Adm Divs such quantities as have been handed to ST Depots. The responsibility of distribution and collection of payments is that of the Adm Div. MIA is responsible for informing the D.S.F. of any quantities handed direct to Adm Divs in order that ST Depots may assign their supply accordingly.

- (ii) In remainder of ITALY - SICILY - SARDINIA the provision, issue and sale is an ITALIAN responsibility through Italian channels.

7. SOAP.

- (a) Scale upon which the Italian Government bases provision action is:-

- (i) 300 grammes per man per month for all tps fwd of Fifth and Eight Army Rear Boundaries.
 (ii) 250 grammes per man per month for all tps behind Fifth and Eight Army Rear Boundaries.
 (iii) 200 grammes per mile or horse per month.

This scale varies with the fat acid content of the soap, the above scale is based on the present content of 62%.

- (b) Indent, provision and issue to BR-ITIS.

- (i) In Fifth Army, Eight Army and One District.

ST indents on MIA who will instruct the Italian Government to make available to ST Base Depots. Delivery from ST Base Depots to Unit is through ST channels.

- (ii) In remainder of ITALY - SICILY - SARDINIA the provision and issue is an ITALIAN responsibility through Italian channels.

- (iii) Special issues of soap from ST sources for special purposes is covered by 2/OS/1 of 14 Feb 45.

6. COGNAC.

(a) A quantity of cognac is being provided by the Italian Government. The total requirement has to be found by local requisition and considerable difficulty is anticipated. The official scale up to which issues can be made is:-

(i) 5 centilitres for 15 days each month (normally on alternate days) for Combat Groups actually engaged in the line.

(ii) 5 centilitres twice per week to

(b) Issue ceases on 15 April 45.

(c) Indent, provision and issue to BR-ITIS.

9. STORES AND EQUIPMENT ORDINANCE.

(a) BRITISH PROVIDED ITEMS.

(i) Stores and equipment which are to be supplied to Combat Groups from Br sources are supplied through Br Ord channels. The Hqs of each Combat Gp has a D.A.S.O.S. on the V.S.

(ii) For BR-ITI Service Units, where entitlement and necessity exists for Br supplied items, issue is made through the Br Unit or Formation under whose command the BR-ITI Unit has been placed.

(b) ITALIAN PROVIDED ITEMS.

All requirements for BR-ITI Units (Combat and Service) will be demanded from the appropriate Adm Div. It is the responsibility of the appropriate Adm Div to hold such stocks and obtain required items as will enable them

- (b) Issue ceases on 15 April 45.
- (c) Indent, provision and issue to BR-III.
As 7 (b) (i) and (ii) above.

9. STORES AND EQUIPMENT ORDNANCE.

(a) BRITISH PROVIDED ITEMS.

- (i) Stores and equipment which are to be supplied to Combat Groups from Br sources are supplied through Br Ord channels. The RLU of each Combat Gp has a D.A.D.O.S. on the W.L.
- (ii) For BR-III Service Units, where entitlement and necessity exists for Br supplied items, issue is made through the Br Unit or Formation under whose command the BR-III Unit has been placed.

(b) ITALIAN PROVIDED ITEMS.

ALL requirements for BR-III Units (Combat and Service) will be demanded from the appropriate Adm Div. It is the responsibility of the appropriate Adm Div to hold such stocks and obtain required items as will enable them adequately to support the troops under their adm command.

10. ENGINEER STORES.

Same procedure as para 9 above.

11. GENERAL ADM FOR COMBAT GP TAIL UNITS.

Fifth and Eight Army are asked to instruct the Adm Divs and WMA LO which Combat Gp Tail Units they require to be the general adm responsibility of the Adm Div.

12. Nothing in this instruction alters the present arrangements by which units of one category if located in territory mainly administered by another category (e.g. BR-III Ca Bn in a 1st Army Area) is maintained under the local arrangements when operationally necessary, the resultant accounts being adjusted by WMA in accordance with national responsibility.

13. PREVIOUS INSTRUCTIONS.

Where previous instructions either 12/L or Italian Government conflict, this instruction will rule.

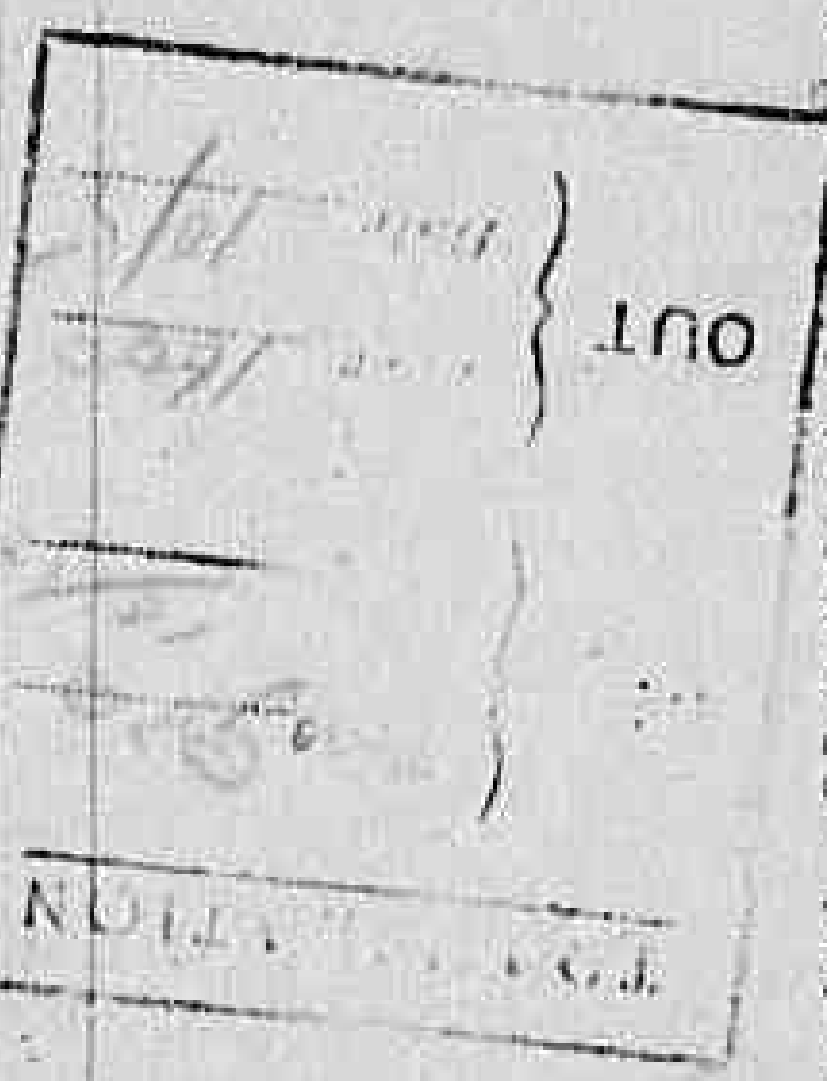

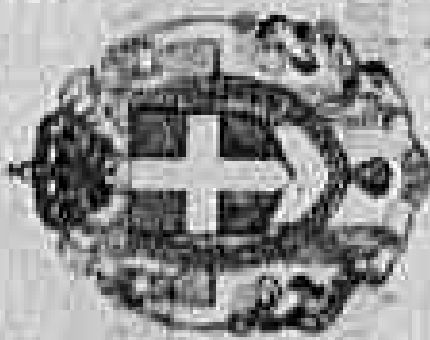

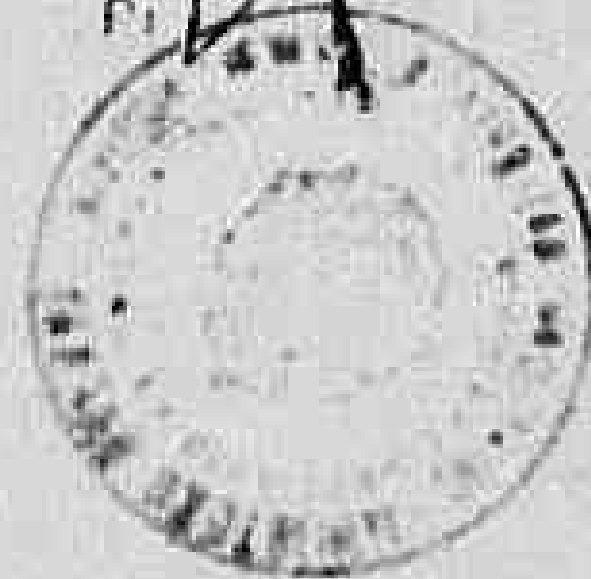

d) Separate "Acceptance Notes" will be executed for items of British ownership as opposed to U.S. ownership, and vice versa, but two or more shipments from the same Country or Origin and received on the same day may be entered on one "Acceptance Note".

e) All "Acceptance Notes" will be numbered serially. A distinctive series of numbers will be assigned to each Depot or other acceptance points, and the number will be preceded by the first 3 letters of the town in which the Depot is situated, thus for NAPLES the first number will be NAP/1.

2. TRANSFERS OF STOCKS BETWEEN ITALIAN DEPOTS.

Information in regard to all transfers of stocks from Allied

sources will be furnished as follows :-

- a) When instructions are issued by Ministry of War or SMRE for the transfer of stock from one Depot to another, a copy of ALL such orders will be sent to HQ MMIA.
- b) When transferred items are received at the Depot or destination, a receipt will be issued by the Italian Officer in Command, and countersigned by an Allied Officer in the same manner as "Acceptance Notes". Complete information as to the Consignor, description of items, and quantity of each item will be entered upon the receipt. In addition the receipt will be clearly marked to indicate that all items were transferred from another Italian Depot.

a) Once authority to issue has been given by MMIA, the Ministry of War or SMRE will notify the Italian Unit or Formation concerned, and include in all such "Release Notices" information as to the Depot from which items are to be withdrawn, or the supply point at which items will be delivered.

b) All "Release Notices" will be assigned a serial number which will be noted against the record of the relevant issues in the books of the depot. (NOTE. The Italian Authorities will adopt their own standard form for this purpose).

c) A copy of all such "Release Notices" by Italian Authorities will be forwarded to HQ MMIA.

5. BASIC ACCOUNTING RECORD.

a) Each Italian Depot, Sub Depot or other supply installations will keep a stock ledger or similar record of all items of Allied clothing and equipment which it receives. This record will debit the quantity of each item received, including transfers, and will credit the quantity of each item released. A separate entry will be made for each debit and each credit transaction.

All debit entries in addition to date and quantity will give consignor or sources and give reference to the serial number of the relevant "Acceptance Note" whenever executed. All credit entries will give in addition to date and quantity, the name of the Unit or Formation to which issue was made and give reference to the Serial Number of the "Release Notice". Any additional information as may be considered desirable may be entered.

b) Care will be exercised to ensure that Debit entries are made for all items received and that no debits are entered until the items are actually received. Further, care will be exercised to ensure that no credits are entered until items have been actually released. (Authorized releases will not be entered until the actual issue has been made).

c) Special attention will be given to correct classifications and description of all items. Different types of Uniforms, underwear, socks, shirts etc., will be listed as separate items and accounted for separately. Under no circumstances will woollen and cotton garments be carried as the same items. Overalls or cotton work clothing will not be included under either cotton or woollen Blouses or Trousers but will be shown as separate items. Items of British uniforms will be shown separately from corresponding items of U.S. uniforms unless they can be issued as one and the same garment without difficulty.

6. REGISTER OF RELEASE NOTICES.

A register or file will be kept by each Depot, Sub Depot, or other supply installation, showing all unfilled authorisations to issue. When issues have been completed against any "Release Notice" it will be checked off the register or removed from the unfilled file. This register or file will be accurately maintained in order to show status of items authorised but not as yet issued, at all times.

7. STOCK REPORTS TO MMIA

a) A report on Pro-Forma MMIA/ORD/3 (for specimen see Appendix "D") giving detailed receipts, issues and stocks on hand, showing the stock position as at 2359 hours on the 10th and 25th of each month will be prepared in quintuplicate by each Depot, Sub Depot or other supply installation. Two copies will be forwarded to Ministry of War and one copy to HQ MMIA in time to arrive by the 15th and 30th of the month respectively. One copy will be retained by local MMIA Officer and one

b) Care will be exercised to ensure that Debit entries are made for all items received and that no debits are entered until the items are actually received. Further, care will be exercised to ensure that no credits are entered until items have been actually released. (Authorized releases will not be entered until the actual issue has been made).

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b) Each copy of the above stock reports will be accompanied by a list of all unfilled "authorisations to issue" as indicated by the Register or file of "RELEASE NOTICES" (See para 6 above).

c) In addition to the bi-monthly stock reports from Depots, Sub Depots, and other supply installations, a monthly summary of all receipts issues and stocks on hand will be prepared by the Ministry of War to show the consolidated position on the 25th of each month. This report will be furnished in triplicate to HQ MMIA by the 10th of the following month as a part of the General Monthly Summary required under para.19 (a) (iii) of MMIA Administrative Inst. No.3 dated 4 June 1944.

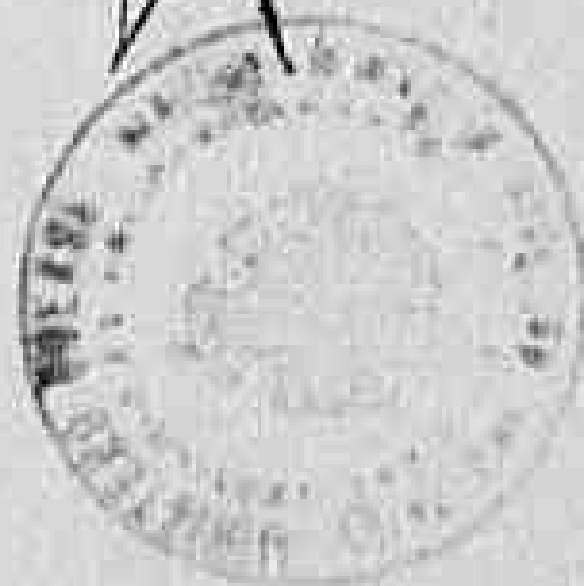

1. SUBJECT : The scope of this instruction is to fix the scheme for:-

- (a) - the equipment of BR-ITI service troops with summer clothing.
- (b) - the withdrawal and repair etc., of the winter clothing.

2. SCALE OF ISSUE OF KHAZI CLOTHING

- (a) - A.F.H.Q. has ordered that K.D. clothing will be issued to BR-ITI service troops on the basis of

2 pairs of trousers, K.D., long.
2 shirts, K.D., summer.

per man.

- (b) - Certain stocks of cotton under-pants and cotton vests will be available and will have to be issued as soon as possible.

3. ISSUE OF K.D. CLOTHING

- (a) - Stocks will be transferred, further to M.M.I.A. instructions, to the administrative divisions by whom the distribution will be carried out in the normal manner.
- (b) - The K.D. clothing will be taken into use at a date to be decided on by the Allied Army of district under whose command the administrative division is placed. The Armies and districts are requested to give advance notice of this date to the M.M.I.A. ICS as soon as possible.

4. IDENTIFICATION OF BR-ITI TROOPS

The K.D. clothing is NOT dyed green. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES will the khaki shirts be worn without the green-white-red ribbon on the left shoulder. The said ribbon will be worn in addition to any divisional or service sign which may be authorised. The ribbon will be made available through War Ministry sources and

distributed with the uniforms through the administrative divisions.

5. WITHDRAWAL OF WINTER CLOTHING AND BLANKETS

- (a) - In order to prepare them for next winter, certain ~~articles~~ winter articles will be withdrawn into depots controlled by M.M.I.A. to be washed, repaired, sorted out afresh and separated into sizes, etc.
- (b) - Overcoats and Jersey-Pullovers will be retained by the troops.
- (c) - All Battle Dress, Woollen-Underpants, Woollen Vests, Woollen Shirts, Cap-Comforters, and gloves, will be withdrawn into the stores of the administrative divisions.
- (d) - Blankets and quilts will be withdrawn on a scale leaving the troops issued with two blankets or one cotton quilt.
- (e) - The date by which the withdrawals referred to in (c) and (d) must be completed will be notified to each division by the I.C.M.M.I.A. after having consulted the Allied formation.
- (f) - Separate instructions will be issued to the M.M.I.A. I.O's in respect of the transferring from the administrative divisions' stores.

6. GUARD BATTALIONS UNDER BRITISH COMMAND

The Guard Battalions under British command will receive the K.D. clothing and hand in the winter articles through the administrative divisions in the same way as the ER-ITI service troops. 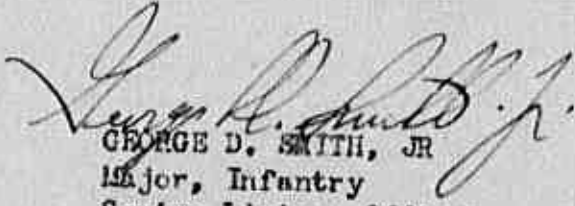
