A. LOCATIONS

(1) THAI Depot is scattered over a number of buildings, as follows:-

(a) 2 Regt Depot Barracks. This building - built as a school but never used as such - houses the 1st and 2nd Cos, each Co having a present approx strength of 800 all ranks.

(b) Dining Hall. This is a dilapidated hall with a maximum capacity - consistent with hygiene, fire-prevention and control of troops - of 600, but it has held 1200 during the worst part of the winter. It is not a satisfactory billet.

(c) Camp site. This is 500 yards from the main barracks. It is not at the moment in use as a considerable amount of S.S. work is being done to make it a satisfactory permanent camp. Work in hand should be finished in 7 days.

(d) Seminary. A dilapidated convent houses the personnel being trained as drivers in the U.S.F. Driving School, THAI.

(2) The future set up, effective from the <sup>(2)</sup> of February or sooner, will be:-

(a) Regt Barracks will hold Depot 1st and 2nd Cos less one or two Cos of driver troops detached in the Seminary by the driving school.

(b) Camp site with P & J in areas partitioning and 4th Cos area ready should the necessity for 2's use arise.

(c) The hall will come to be used except in grave emergency.

B. PERSONNEL

(1) Composition

The nature of the majority of staff in the depot at any given time depends on the general situation, e.g., at first they were surplus personnel from 57 Inf Regt Depot, recently they have been taken repatriated and in the future they may consist largely of call ups. In addition to these, there is an average daily inflow of approx 80 from a variety of sources - "absentees", troops on leave

leave forwarded on by Depots, Distretti and Presidi Militari, personnel at hospitals, prisons etc.

(2) Breakdown

The great majority are non-specialist. About 30 are drivers; about 10 are suitable as sign rfta, though should the need exist in the future of Southern call-ups, this percentage will drop. The disposal of medically unfit personnel - about 10 - presents a problem, as Pioneer units do NOT want them, and as a constant transfer between hospital and Depot and vice versa, through a considerable amount of work on the administrative staff. Most of the remaining troops are suitable mainly as labour rfta, or if suited physically can be civilian background, as militeers. It is pointed out that it has not been the practice to ask for volunteers for such 7th Coy, as troops consider that for anyone who wants to go volunteering, the combat groups offer more safety and better conditions than 7th Coy.

C. SHIRTS

In view of the previous military history of rfta, as indicated in part (1) of the preceding paragraph, the clothing of rfta is far from satisfactory. Repatriates ex Salerno are generally clad in a weird variety of military uniforms and civilian rags, while call-ups and abductees bring with them only the bare minimum necessary to get them from their homes to the depot. In view of the scarcity and cost of boots on the civilian market, their footwear is in shocking condition. As for shirts, the majority have only one - and some not even that - with the result that a constant campaign has to be fought to keep them from freezing - this despite the fact that there are hot showers available. Here, though, the complaint is that the soap ration is received once per month, so that a man may be upwards of 3 weeks without soap. Many, too, have no towels.

D. MORALE

On the average, morale is not more than fair. Factors unfavourably affecting morale are lack of clothing, length of time spent in transit while awaiting movement, inactivity, bad weather, lack of interest in the war, and - in the case of Northerners - the usual preoccupation about the fate of their families in enemy occupied territory. Given at least a uniform and a pair of boots, troops could be given more routine work and made to take an interest in themselves, with the feeling that the authorities too were interested in them.

Coercion and A.D.G.I. is confined almost entirely to Northerners and in particular to Austrians, who hate the idea of being stationed outside Austria.

The recent free distribution of the first edition of the Army paper "Italia", was favourably commented on.

A canteen and post-room are being set up and stores of the Italian supplies provided. It is hoped that a library can be organized if the necessary reading material can be made forthcoming.

11 Com. Sport Ball team was organized until it played a match with the Base team. Each company now has a team and 11 Com Depot has given the use of a football pitch during the mornings.

8. DISCIPLINE.

This is fair, considering that Italian troops have no respect for their S.O.C.'s and little for their officers, except in individual cases.

9. BRITISH CODE.

The British Code - G.I., No. 1, TRANSLATED, E.I. - has one main difficulty, viz., they have no instructions as to their duties, and they are considered an "urban" unit by S. Ita.

10. CONCLUSION.

It is considered that a depot satisfactory from all points of view, can be effectively organized given the following conditions:-

- (1) That a supply of minimum necessary clothing be maintained. (1000 sets of S.O., boots, and caps have been received already from MIL. LG BARI).
- (2) That some form of welfare for the troops be organized.
- (3) That the British Code be recognized as a unit with an authorized S.O. and S. HQ, with authority to draw necessary stores.

Refuge Camps for Auxiliary units

It appears from various reports received here that the living conditions, some due to the winter season, imposed on military held in the refuge Camps of ASTRONI, TRANI and AFRAGOLA for Auxiliary units is very poor.

This especially in the TRANI refuge Camp where lack of barred room material and clothing renders the stay of troops (mostly from the Balkan) in this camp almost unbearable.

These conditions have obvious moral repercussions on those troops who have already suffered much and who are yet asked to participate <sup>in</sup> the country's war effort. ~~It is~~ We deem it opportune to inform M H I A <sup>of this</sup> because, here the situation reported is proved to be a reality. <sup>if we could</sup> They will kindly <sup>ask you</sup> with the <sup>provision</sup> ~~cooperation~~ <sup>of cooperation</sup> that is well known to me, to give the necessary instructions so as to remedy the actual deplorable situation. <sup>Minister</sup>

1. The above transit camp, strength 3 officers (including a Lt Col) and 5 other ranks has been visited recently by an officer from this HQ.
2. He reports that the camp was recently set up to accept military personnel coming from the BALKANS and has accommodation and messing equipment for 400 men, but has never, in fact, been called upon to accommodate a man and due to the decreasing number of men returning from the BALKANS it is apparent that this camp is unnecessary.
3. It is understood by WETA that the Military Barracks at Castellana are earmarked for repatriated personnel as and when needed, (your letters 400350/WGR of 24 Nov 44 and 400425/WGR of 3 Dec refer). No authority has been granted, however, for assigning Nil personnel or stores to any of the barracks or accommodation reserved for this purpose.
4. You are requested to close this camp forthwith returning all messing equipment to the War Depot. Other rank personnel will be despatched to TRAN Camp and officer personnel disposed of under your own arrangements.
5. Advise WETA when the above instructions have been carried out.

1. On 12 Jan 45, I visited TRANI Camp, firstly on the urgent question of the breakdown of their lavatory arrangements, secondly, in consultation with Capt. O'CONNOR, to examine what was required to make the camp suitable for use as a BR 171 Base Rts Depot.

2. Immediate action has been taken with 230 Div on the question of the lavatories (LO/2/1/SD dated 14 Jan 45 refers).

Before however detailing recommendations for the improvement of TRANI Camp, it is necessary to give the present lay-out.

3. TRANI Camp is in four parts as follows :-

(a) The barracks of 9 Regt Genie, less the central block of offices, which has been retained by 9 Regt Genie for records etc., and is not required for extension of camp accommodation. Accommodation, kitchens and hot showers are sufficient for 2000 men. Also two wooden huts for about 50 men each are being erected in the barrack square.

(b) A tented camp, within 100 yards, not at present suitable for winter quarters. Accommodation, kitchens and latrines for 500 men, but capable of extension to hold from 1500 - 2000 men, if tentage is provided.

(c) An old mill, between quarter to half a mile away. This provides covered accommodation for 1600 men, but it is not good accommodation, and with the advent of spring, an open lavatory system within twenty yards of the kitchens will be a source of danger. There is no place to dig latrines, and the present lavatories cannot be made fly-proof.

(d) An old Convent, about half a mile away, which is being converted for use, but is not yet ready. Accommodation figures etc are not yet available.

4. From the point of view of discipline, administration and the numbers of personnel available on the camp staff, this dispersion of the camp is not considered satisfactory. Moreover much of the accommodation is unsuitable for permanent use.

5. The following recommendations are therefore made:-

2. Immediate action has been taken with 230 Div on the question of the lavatories (LO/2/1/SE dated 14 Jan 45 refers).  
Before however detailing recommendations for the improvement of TRANI Camp, it is necessary to give the present lay-out.

3. TRANI Camp is in four parts as follows:-

(a) The barracks of 9 Regt Genie, less the central block of offices, which has been retained by 9 Regt Genie for records etc., and is not required for extension of camp accommodation. Accommodation, kitchens and hot showers are sufficient for 2000 men. Also two wooden huts for about 50 men each are being erected in the barrack square.

(b) A tented camp, within 100 yards, not at present suitable for winter quarters. Accommodation, kitchens and latrines for 500 men, but capable of extension to hold from 1500 - 2000 men, if tentage is provided.

(c) An old mill, between quarter to half a mile away. This provides covered accommodation for 1000 men, but it is not good accommodation, and with the advent of spring, an open lavatory system within twenty yards of the kitchens will be a source of danger. There is no place to dig latrines, and the present lavatories cannot be made fly-proof.

(d) An old Convent, about half a mile away, which is being converted for use, but is not yet ready. Accommodation figures etc are not yet available.

4. From the point of view of discipline, administration and the numbers of personnel available on the camp staff, this dispersion of the camp is not considered satisfactory. Moreover such of the accommodation is unsuitable for permanent use.

5. The following recommendations are therefore made:-

(a) The old mill and the convent should be closed down as soon as alternative accommodation is available.

(b) The tented camp site should be properly constructed; drained, with its own latrines, kitchens etc. and tentage be provided to increase accommodation up to 2000. A report of the tentage required will be forwarded later. Further the two wooden huts should be moved here from the barracks, as part of the standing accommodation. The labour could be provided by personnel awaiting movement orders, and the technical advice by the engineer branch of Territorial HQ RAFI.

(c) The present accommodation in the barracks of 9 Regt Genie should be retained. *yes*

6. If the above proposals are adopted, the BRITII Base Rfts Depot, TRANI will then be composed of barracks to hold the permanent staff and 2000 rfts, and a tented camp in close proximity to hold a further 2000 rfts and both adjacent to the Ry Station. Administration and control would be simplified. This would not however cater for 6,000 as ordered in WIA letter SD/56 *5/1/45*, 9 Jan 45.

7. Please say whether the above recommendations are to be implemented, or whether it is desired that a search be made for an alternative site in another locality.
