MEMORANDUM:

TO : Commanding General, Land Forces Det Commission, AD (SMIA),
APO 394, U. S. Army.

1. A major project of improving sewage disposal, sanitation and messing facilities at the US-ITI Astroni Staging Camp has been necessitated by the recent establishment of a nearby American Army Camp. The below listed materials are urgently needed for the construction contemplated. It is requested that if any of these items are available from Italian Army Engineer stores recently brought over from Bardonia, that they be released to the 212th Italian Command.
