1. In October 1944 the War Ministry were ordered to conduct a round-up of the Italian army of the 1914-18 clause in the FOGLIA Area. The target was 8,000. Less than 50 in fact reported.
2. The War Ministry were ordered to make a further effort, which in fact started on 20 Feb. They reported that of 18,000 men shown in the population census only 400 reported to the Recruiting Centre. 300 were enlisted.
3. The matter was investigated. The reasons for the failure were explained to you in brief in WMA letter 50/73 of 3 Mar in which I suggested that a round-up take place in the FOGLIA Area commencing 1 May.
4. You agreed to this suggestion in your signal Z 30049 of 3 Mar and you wrote Thomson to MAAF, who control the FOGLIA Area, vide your letter CR/2017/G-1(LR) of 7 March.
5. Letter 50/73 to you on 18 Mar confirmed the intention to effect the round-up w.e.f. 1 May and asked for a nominal roll of personnel working for the Allied Forces due for exemption.
6. This nominal roll was pressed for in my letter to you dated 10 13 Apr. Your letter CR/2017/G-1(LR) of 17 Apr addressed MAAF re: this.
7. As no details were available of personnel due for exemption we authorized the War Ministry to postpone the start of the operation to 9 May. Meanwhile my 50/73 of 24 April, copy to you, asked for the nominal roll to be hastened.
8. In all fairness to the Italian authorities, my formal instructions to the Ministry of War to commence 3 May have not actually been despatched. The estimated intake of 8,000 is based on best figures available to the Italian Government but it will be ascertained from the above correspondence that the Italian Government do not control this fully because of the fact that as the previous conditions the War Ministry, if they have been complied by, for example, the prohibition of the display of posters, prohibition of the arrest of persons who do not report to the recruiting centre as ordered, it is obvious that they are not in a position to

2. The War Ministry were ordered to make a further effort, which in fact started on 20 Jan. They reported that of 16,000 men shown in the population census only 400 reported to the Recruiting Centres. 200 were enlisted.

3. The matter was investigated. The reasons for the failure were explained to you in brief in a letter SD/73 of 2 Mar in which I suggested that a round-up take place in the FOCIA area commencing 1 May.

4. You agreed to this suggestion in your signal 2 N249 of 3 Mar and you wrote thereon to MAIF, who control the FOCIA area, vide your letter CR/8717/3-1(5) of 7 March.

5. Letter SD/73 to you on 13 Mar confirmed the intention to effect the round-up w.e.f. 1 May and asked for a nominal roll of personnel working for the Allied Forces due for exemption.

6. This nominal roll was promised for in my letter to you SD/73 of 13 Apr. Your letter CR/8717/3-1(5) of 17 Apr addressed MAIF refers.

7. As no details were available of personnel due for exemption we authorised the War Ministry to postpone the start of the operation to 9 May. Meanwhile my SD/73 of 24 April, copy to you, asked for the nominal roll to be hastened.

8. In all fairness to the Italian authorities, my formal instructions to the Ministry of War to commence 9 May have not actually been issued. The estimated intake of 1,000 is based on best figures available to the Italian Government but it will be appreciated from the above correspondence that the Italian Government do not control this Air Force group. Owing to the fact that as the previous occasions the War Ministry's operations have been hampered by, for example, the prohibition of the display of posters, prohibition of the arrest of persons who do not report to the recruiting centres as ordered, it is obvious that the operation you have authorised cannot be carried out without the cooperation of the Allied Authorities concerned.

9. In order therefore that the matter may be proceeded with according to plan, will you please:-

- (a) Obtain the list of civilian employees (between the 1st to 20 classes) working for MAIF in order that Ministry of War may take strong measures to round-up the remainder of personnel due to present themselves.

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(b) Obtain from the Allied authorities in the MOGULA area their assurance of whole-hearted support in order that no obstacles may be placed in the way of the Italian authorities in carrying out their duty (as has been experienced in the past), and in maintaining their prestige, which we have been at such pains to build up and which is so essential both now and post war.
