In accordance with your letter Q/31 of 1. September 45, herewith "Q" points for monthly liaison letter to LO's.

Q.I have submitted their points direct to C III (I).

1. Supplies

Re-organisation of Supply units:- Proposal are being submitted for revision of Bulk Depots by a reduction in personnel by 1 Officer and 20 OR's each.

Military Bakeries are to be kept at the minimum number and request has been made for new type of units, consisting of 1 Officer and 4 OR's who will act as a nucleus of personnel for the inspection and controlling of Civilian Bakeries making bread for the Army on contract.

It is proposed to increase principal food distribution depots by 1 Officer, and decrease the N.Z. of secondary distribution depots by 6 OR's each.

Other new units under consideration are refrigerator units, special storage unit and can factory supervisory personnel unit.

The question of moving No. 75 distribution depot from Alessandria to Placentia Area is only being held up until accommodation becomes available in Placentia.

The proposed move of the bulk food depot from Genoa to Milan is temporarily suspended.

2. Clothing

- a. On October 1st control of clothing, equipment, arms and ammunition passed to the Ministry of War. This only affects issues to PII-III, and the proceeds for the issue of clothing etc to N-UTS and

It is proposed to increase principal food distribution depots by 1 Officer, and decrease the N.Z. of secondary distribution depots by 6 OR's each.

Other new units under consideration are refrigerator units, special storage unit and can factory supervisory personnel unit.

The question of moving No. 75 distribution depot from Alessandria to Piacenza Area is only being held up until accommodation becomes available in Piacenza.

The proposed move of the bulk food depot from Cesena to Milan is temporarily suspended.

2. Clothing

- a. On October 1st control of clothing, equipment, arms and ammunition passed to the Ministry of War. This only affects issues to TRI-TRI, and the procedure for the issue of clothing etc. to BR-BRIS and US-ITIS remain unchanged.
- b. Greater consideration is being given now to the clothing and equipment of CO.RR. To this end the Florence Brigade has been taken on the BR-TRI calling.
- c. A letter has been written to AFHQ for authority to issue undyed D.D. to Italian troops, provided a flushed bearing the word ITALIA is carried on the upper arm of the uniforms so issued.
- d. Efforts are being made to distribute special winter clothing and equipment equitably among the troops who need it.

3. Accommodation

- a. The accommodation situation is still far from being solved, but every endeavour is being made to return to an ministry every building which belongs to them.

- b. Roma Area, on instruction from MIOUSA, have issued an order that all real estate holdings are to be consolidated immediately with a view to justify continued use of each requisitioned accommodation to an Allied Force HQ Board. Units will be required to double up and share accommodation.
- c. It is presumed that this order may have also been given to the other commands, in which case the problem of accommodation should be greatly reduced.

4. Transportation

- a. Organization of Tpt. Cosys. Proposals are being submitted for a revision of the W/7 Cos or BR-III Tpt. cosys, so that they may be composed of standard platoon blocks. The proposals, if agreed, will increase the amount of Tpt. in respect of the Admin. Tpt. Cos within Nos 1 to 7 Terr. Commands, and will also result in an all round increase of personnel. Consideration is also being given to the formation of 3 further Ambulances Car Sections, on a reduced establishment, for Nos 1, 2 and 5 Terr. Commands. If the new proposals for Admin Tpt. Cosys are agreed to, it is proposed to disband P.Q.L. reserve posts as separate units, and make the Tpt. Cosys responsible for staffing and operating such posts.

- b. P.Q.L. W.e.f. 1 October all Combat Groups are required to obtain their P.Q.L. from C.I.P. depots and NOT from Allied Sources. It was finally agreed that BR-III and US-III Services Troops should continue to draw from Allied Sources. As it is thought likely that AFHQ put Sec will 'cut' the demands submitted in respect of Combat Groups, it will no doubt be necessary for WLS to institute some sort of weekly rationing system within the groups in order to effect the maximum possible economy and to ensure that the quantities authorised will not be consumed before the end of the month.

- c. Tpt. Liaison Cosys (Italian) The following officers have been nominated by the Ministry of War as their Tpt. representatives in the areas shown. These officers work directly under the S.M.R.S. Light Workshops to operate with BR-ITI Transport Companies. For the details of the operation of these Light Workshops was given in STY/15 dated 7 Sept. 45.

It is hoped that these Light Workshops will make their presence felt at an early date, and will result in a high standard of maintenance.

The shortage of specialist personnel is serious and it is hoped that all concerned will cooperate to ensure that all such personnel are utilised in their own trades and within the Repairs organisation to the best advantage.
