1. Major S.P. JACKSON M.O. (52654) ECHENNE L.I. Spoke Col. DUGUAS concerning the posting of v/h from 52 LIAP to 53 LIAP. Col. DUGUAS would like to explain fully to AAG. Col. DUGUAS would appreciate signal on this subject.
 2. Capt. FURRER's LIAP cancelled.
 3. Capt. CLARK reported MILAN and proceeded MILAN shortly. Col. BURTON will visit
 4. Major CHAMBERS requested to UK on Release 16/10/45. Original release book returned to USA by Capt CHAM.
 5. Col. WINTER expects to visit N.Y. about 10 Nov.
 6. Major DUGUAS wishes to take his LIAP to N.Y. if possible if not reasonable wishes to take it in Italy. I will speak Camp Credit. He had received X/T signal directing him to contact Major MILES at USA. We expected to meet him 23 Oct.
 7. Col. WINTER would like a ruling as to whether BORGOMA comes under him, or Major VAN RIKK.
 8. Capt. FURRER may be coming back (Sp 24).
