1. Properly enlisted personnel of the recognised Italian Army while in hospital up to thirty days are issued Scale 'B' ration which is the same as issued to all non-combatant troops. This ration is to be supplemented by local purchase by the Italian Army. After spending more than thirty days in a hospital, the military personnel then revert to a civilian status and, as such, are a civil commitment.
2. The personnel to which you refer in your letter have never been enrolled as effective members of the recognised Italian Army and therefore cannot be issued any military rations at all.
3. Being as this is, a matter for the civilian authorities, may I suggest the matter be referred to ROME Allied Area Command.

The attached correspondence regarding the diet of patients in an Italian Military hospital has been sent to me by the RPHO, Rome Region.

While I fully realize that this is a matter for the Italian Military authorities, I think the inadequacy of the ration should be brought to their notice as it falls far below that given to patients in civil hospitals.

I believe that sometime ago an agreement was reached with AAI whereby Italian troops in their own military hospitals were to receive the same rations as the Italian Army, with the addition of the usual extras for hospital patients.

In my opinion a meagre ration for hospital patients is a bad policy as it prolongs convalescence and lengthens the time a man is detained in hospital.

I feel certain that if the agreement reached with AAI is brought to the notice of the Italian authorities, they will at once take action.

MEMORANDUM

I deem it my duty to advise that the Italian Military Authorities for the City of Rome have verbally communicated that in agreement with the Army Subcommittee presided over on the Allied side by Colonel Pidsley, the R.Navy has been assigned:

-150 military rations for the personnel of the R.Navy who render service at the Commissariat, formerly belonging to the secret Resistance Front;

-1300 rations for civilians for the personnel who are helped at the officers' circle of the Ministry and for the personnel of the C.R.E.M. with the Detachment.

Withdrawal of rations will be effected starting tomorrow the 26th.

The Italian Military Authority in ROME, General BE-CIVERCA, has informed this Sub-Commission of the numbers of pre-armistice soldiers, sailors and airmen who were in ROME on the Allied occupation.

2. The approximate figures given were:

Regio Esercito	-	15,000
Regia Marina	-	1,000
Regia Aeronautica	-	1,000

3. Your attention is called to the fact that after naval and air force personnel have been examined to establish their loyalty to the Allied cause, they can only be incorporated in the "effective strength" of the Italian Armed Forces provided the established ration ceiling for the Italian Navy and Air Force is not exceeded. Alternatively, they may be taken on provided an adjustment is made by demobilizing other personnel already included in the "effective strength".

4. Orders have been issued that Italian Army personnel will only receive civilian rations until the position is regularized and they can be considered in part or in whole as "effective", and it would be appreciated if the appropriate Italian Naval and Air Force Command could be similarly informed.
