SUBJECT: Reinforcement Nembo Division.

Colonel Simmons' Office.

Reference letter dated 14 August 44, same subject, signed by
Major Egerton.

1. On 17 July 1944, 3 officers and 54 soldiers belonging to the
Nembo Paratroop Division, departed from Cagliari on the Royal Cruiser
Pompeo Magno. (as was pre-announced by this Headquarters in letter
No. 9262/1/17/OP dated 14 July).

2. This Headquarters is unable to explain the reason why said
personnel had not arrived at Naples on the morning of 18 July aboard
the above-mentioned cruiser, as was stated by Headquarters MMIA.

3. Since, however, the embarkation list, a true copy of which
is attached, did not include for each name the unit to which the in-
dividual belongs, it may be that the soldiers in question may have been
considered in the MMIA lists at Naples, as isolated soldiers sent from
the Cagliari Staging Center (those which your Commission refers to as
casuals).

4. In any event, it is a fact that the soldiers enumerated on
attached list, all of whom belong to the Nembo Division, were regularly
embarked 17 July on the cruiser "Pompeo Magno", which departed that
same evening.

1. The ITALIAN Combat Troops at present under command HIGHWAY ARMY are:

- 1. CIL (Formerly 10 Reggimento Inseguimento)
- 2. MARIO Group

2. In order to facilitate replacement of casualties, the units which it is considered the Italian Combat Units should be reinforced are shown at Appendix A.

3. Latest figures of actual strength (as of 7 May 44) are shown against these units in the Appendix.

4. It should be noted that:

- (a) Alpini Division is shown as having a total strength of 8,175/13 men incl. The Reggimento Alpini Division has not at present such a high strength.
- (b) La Morte d'Annunzio (3rd Assault Unit) is at present considerably below the strength that the CIL would like it to be. However, this unit could only be made up as and when the proper type of reinforcements become available. These should be the Commando type.
- (c) Engadine (Incl Sign) need reinforcements.
- 5. These figures can only be accepted as a guide until such a time as a proper report of the ITALIAN Combat Troops takes place.
