1. Reference is made to your request for the issue of eight (8) each, outfit, cooking, 20 man, for use in the preparation of meals for the United States Army personnel attached to the Quartermaster Truck Battalion of the 2675th Regiment, AC, (Ovhd). This issue is approved on temporary shipping ticket for a period not to exceed 120 days.

2. The request for the issue of eight (8) each single unit range, field K-1937 (Quartermaster nomenclature: 8 each, Pack "A" 1/range field, K-1937; 8 each Pack "B" 1/range, field K-1937) is not favorably considered. The operation and first and second echelon maintenance of the fire unit is considered too complicated for the novice, and experience has proven that excessive maintenance and replacements are necessary where such issues are made.

3. The steep position will not warrant the equipping of other Italian Military Units with this equipment, hence a precedent cannot be established in this instance.

4. Fuel for the Army Field Range Number 1 should be furnished by the Allied Commission to the maximum extent possible in conformity with the policy of the Italian Government rendering maximum assistance in the War Effort. If sufficient fuel is not obtainable through the Allied Commission, firewood may be obtained through the Quartermaster at Peninsular Base Section, Forward.

6. At present, all that is requested is the equivalent of our General Orders from the Italian Command permitting this reorganization.

1. Col CATTON of AOC visited this HQ on 23 Sep and presented a requirement for the provision of Italian Army personnel for the following tot units which would operate in the Army area:

Two pen test boys - 344 all ranks
Five all truck cos - 550 all ranks
(15 322-60 of 19 Sep refusers)

He stated that the cadre of US Army personnel for the QM truck ocs had been provided by AFHQ and that formation would be under control of AOC in conjunction with 153.

2. It should be noted that in each tray one Italian grey toy is already working for HQ.

5. With regard to the provision of drivers for the gun tpt coys, the present British Service Unit programme produces one Italian gun tpt coy per month. The limiting factor has been the availability of vehs and consequently the Driving School at POLCEMINO has been geared to train 400 drivers per month.

4. These test units can only be formed for ACC at the expense of the Service Unit programmes (i.e. by reducing the maintenance potential available for operations).

5. The recommendations of AII are:

(a) It is decided that 100 demands are to have a high priority, 1007 and 1008 Coys (Italian Gen Det) now forming at POLIGRANO, or subsequent units scheduled to be organised there, should be allotted to 100. If 1007 and 1008 Coys are assigned there, the 250 vehs allotted to 100 should be available for equipping later units.

(b) In view of the fact that the equipment for two covers is immediately available

3. With regard to the provision of avrs for the gen tpt coys, the present British Service Unit programme produces one Italian gen tpt coy per month. The limiting factor has been the availability of vehs and consequently the Driving School at POLIGNO has been forced to train 400 avrs per month. **3544**

4. These tpt units can only be formed for AOC at the expense of the Service Unit programmes (i.e. by reducing the maintenance potential available for operations).

5. The recommendations of LMI are:

(a) It is decided that AOC demands are to have a high priority, 1007 and 1003 Coys (Italian Gen Tpt) now forming at POLIGNO, or subsequent units scheduled to be organized there, should be allotted to AOC. If 1007 and 1003 Coys are assigned, the 250 vehs allotted to AOC should be available for equipping later units.

(b) In view of the fact that the equipment for two coys is immediately available the output of the POLIGNO Driving School should be raised to a minimum of eight hundred per month. The necessary increases in British Staff can be found from the British cadres which will be formed for the gen tpt coys.

(c) To achieve the most economical use of tpt and adequate technical supervision, coys should not be allotted specifically to AOC. Instead, formations should be directed to provide for AOC a minimum tonnage lift.

6. The whole of the International Coiling of the Italian Army has been taken up.

7. In absence of contrary instructions it is proposed to charge the gen tpt coys and the QM truck cos against their respective national ceilings.
