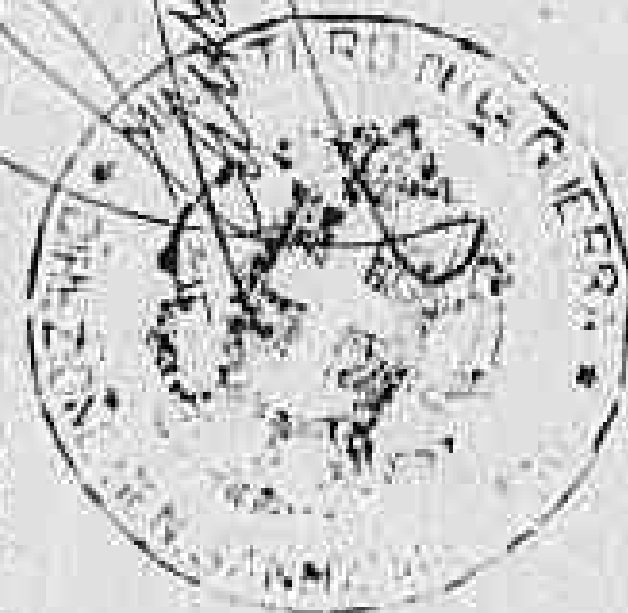

SUBJECT: Passing of the management of civilian rationed medical establishments to the Italian Red Cross and Excellent Military Order of MALTA (S.R.C.M.) - possibility of re-covering military personnel necessity of further reinforcement.

With reference to letters, SD/12 of 15.1.1945 and SD/12/1 of 24.1.1945 of M.M.I.A. and letter 1/159/San of 16.1.45 of this Directorate-General.

The Ministry of the Treasury in letter 102598 - Division XIII of 2.2.1945 has given the necessary approval to the plans of arrangement proposed by this Ministry for the passing of the management of rationed medical establishments to the Italian Red Cross and the Excellent Military Order of MALTA.

Further to this it has been possible to issue, in circular letter, 1/565/San of 7.2. 1945 signed by H.E. The Minister, provisional executive orders for the putting into effect of the passing of the management, in expectation of the agreements of the convention and of the advance of the Lieutenant of the Realm's legislative decrees, approved in advance by the Council of Ministers.

At the same time, this Directorate General has notified the Medical Directorate under command in order that they carry out in as short a time as possible the planned passing of management, cooperating in the latter with the regional directive depts., of the I.R.C. and E.M.O.M.

The passing of management will be gradual; the I.R.C. and E.M.O.M. will gradually assume the management of the establishments as the personnel required are held available, for which is expected either a recall or the assumption of duty in a "transitorial role."

The recovery of medical personnel will only be partially possible, it is expected, in fact that a part of the medical personnel attached to the establishments (within fixed age-limits) will be asked for to be placed in the above-mentioned "transitorial roles." This arrangement has been found indispensable because of the insufficient availability of I.R.C. and E.M.O.M. personnel, who are at present employed on other duties (welfare of exiled civilians etc.)

The Ministry of the Treasury in letter 102598 - Division XIII of 3.2.1945 has given the necessary approval to the plans of arrangement proposed by this Ministry for the passing of the management of civilian rationed medical establishments to the Italian Red Cross and the Excellent Military Order of MILTA.

Further to this it has been possible to issue, in circular letter, 1/565/San of 7.2. 1945 signed by H. E. The Minister, provisional executive orders for the putting into effect of the passing of the management, in expectation of the agreements of the convention and of the issuing of the Lieutenant of the Realm's legislative decree, approved in advance by the Council of Ministers.

At the same time, this Directorate General has notified the Medical Directorate under command in order that they carry out in a short time as possible the planned passing of management, cooperating in the matter with the regional directive depts., of the I.R.C. and E.M.O.M.

The passing of management will be gradual; the I.R.C. and E.M.O.M. will gradually assume the management of the establishments as the personnel required are held available, for which is expected either a recall or the assumption of duty in a "territorial role."

The recovery of medical personnel will only be partially possible; it is expected, in fact that a part of the medical personnel attached to the establishments (within fixed age-limits) will be asked for to be placed in the above-mentioned "territorial roles." This arrangement has been found indispensable because of the insufficient availability of I.R.C. and E.M.O.M. personnel, who are at present employed on other duties (welfare of exiled civilians etc.)

In conclusion it is to be borne in mind that the maximum number of medical troops which can be recovered from medical establishments is 600-800

It has been ordered that the recovered personnel will be drafted to the reserve group of the respective military H.Q. under the orders of this Directorate General. The largest draft will be to SMI (civilian rationed hospitals of PUGLIA.)

The expected recovery of medical troops from civilian rationed medical establishments will only partly replenish the serious and known deficiencies of medical personnel in Italian Territorial military medical establishments.

The position as to medical personnel in territorial service can, in fact, be summed up as follows: -

The writer, in agreement with S.M.R.L. and M.M.I.A., has issued to the surrounding medical units the provisional WE expected for territorial medical units: it is evident that no practice value can be attached to this WE if the medical personnel required are not assigned to the establishments, which requirements were planned within the narrow indispensable limits.

The signalled requirements have to be considered as a minimum one, also on account of the fact that the necessity of further medical personnel reinforcements for the sanitary field units as well as for the territorial service has to be taken in view.

To meet the present deficit position, it has been necessary to resort, provisionally, to the employment of civilian personnel on hand, in the territorial military hospitals. It is held that this solution may not be satisfactory, since as a general rule the presence of civilian personnel is contrary to the smooth running and discipline of the establishments.

Sheet 3.

It is desirable that the reinforcements requested be assigned without delay, in order that it will be possible to replace the above-mentioned civilian personnel as soon as possible with trained military personnel. Ensuring the welfare of the patients in a satisfactory manner and making arrangements at the same time for the necessities of the medical organization in the Northern ITALY regions, as the territorial liberation proceeds by degrees to the North.

1. During a discussion on the 29 Jan between Capt. YEARDLEY and Major MAJOCCHI regarding MMIA Letter C/11 dated 26 Jan concerning the above Units, it transpired that these are actually Medical personnel part of 9 Sezione Sanita (or Sez disinfezione).
2. Detachments of personnel from the above Medical units were authorised by MMIA as an emergency measure, to guard against the spread of infectious disease from personnel arriving from overseas, no authorisation for the formation of separate units such as have been formed has been given by MMIA.
3. An explanation is required as to why these units were not shown in your strength state under Medical Section of Part 1 Administration in which their parent formation is contained, and as to why they were formed and designated without MMIA authority.
4. On reviewing the duties being carried out by these centres it is decided that it is not an Army responsibility to handle repatriated personnel who are actually civilians, and this should be carried out by the Italian Civil Government in connection with the Displaced Persons and Repatriation Sub Commission, A.C.
5. The military personnel will be returned to their parent Medical formation and shown as such in future strength returns.

1. Your letter on this subject has been read with interest and the difficulties in changing over a part of the medical services from military to civilian control are appreciated.

Nevertheless, the Ministry of Interior have had over 6 months warning and it is felt that they should have produced more concrete results in that time.

2. In insisting on a thorough "camb-out" of medical personnel from the back areas reference is made to our SD/12/1 of 23 Jan 45, where 23 officers, 2 Sisters and 117 other ranks - a total of 142 medical personnel were employed in nursing 76 patients in Catanzaro "El Raso" hospital. At the same time there are totally inadequate staffs in Florence attempting to care for several hundred military, none of whom are battle casualties.

3. Ministry of War, Medical Directorate Letter 2/423/R of 21 Jan 45 has just been received implementing the orders in para 3 of HMLA letter SD/12 of 15 Jan 45.

4. 2000 personnel are being allotted to the III-III category of reinforcements during the period 1 - 28th February 1945.

Any personnel allotted to medical services from this group will count against the second 500 medical reinforcements required as per para 4 of HMLA letter SD/12 of 15 Jan 45.

5. Please keep HMLA informed of further progress in this matter.
