1. Pursuant to instructions received p.m. on 4th May 1944 from C.C.C., AAL to investigate the alleged disaffection of the NMSO Division, I flew to CAGLISAL on 5th May with General BELMONT, C.C.C. of the A.C.C. and that evening I discussed the position with Brig Gen WILKINSON (Commanding Allied Forces in CAGLISAL) and Col. STUBBS (A.C.C. representative there). Both these officers stated categorically that, except from Admiral MALVERN, they had never heard any rumour of disloyalty or disaffection on the part of the NMSO Division or any of its members. They were sure that any such rumours were complete fabrications and entirely untrue.

2. Brig Gen WILKINSON had just returned from visiting A.C.C. and
H.C. AAL at both of which he had reported as above. As a result, resumption of NMSO Div sailings had been ordered by AAL. 6848

3. The next morning, 6th May, I held a Conference in CAGLISAL attended by Gen BELMONT, Admiral MALVERN and Col. STUBBS at which the whole matter was discussed. A time table of the events is annexed at Appendix 1A, and a statement of the surrounding circumstances and of Admiral MALVERN's explanations is annexed at Appendix 1B.

4. As a result of my discussions and conferences I have arrived at the following conclusions:

(a) I can find no evidence that the NMSO Division is in any way disaffected or disloyal.

(b) Admiral MALVERN in violating his suspicions, based solely on vague rumours of the disaffection of the NMSO Division, was wrong in not following the proper channels of communication which as he should have known, were through Col. STUBBS. This was especially so in the case of his visit on 3rd May to Lt. Comd. APPEL after having come to a definite arrangement with Col. SIMONS on 2nd May. He could not, in my opinion, should have discussed the whole question earlier with Col. STUBBS as he knew that in the interests of security the actual date of sailing of the NMSO Division would be kept secret until the latest possible moment.

(c) I consider that Col. Almon acted perfectly correctly in refusing to alter the sailing program of the USSA Div at Admiral Brown's request. Col. Almon has been in very close touch with this Division and had no reason to doubt its trustworthiness, and he would have been quite wrong to suspect the Admiral's veracity and entirely unsubstantiated rumors as against his own first-hand Gen Almon's first-hand judgment.

(d) Admiral Brown, I understand, is not in control of the Italian cruisers operationally, but only for maintenance, and it does not appear that his actions in connection with this ferry service of troops have not been at the highest pressure. I feel that the periods when the cruisers are in lock are worth consideration to see whether such periods are unduly lengthy. After all the Italian Navy has not been unduly bothered this war, except where it has had the misfortune to meet our Navy. Whilst I cannot express a definite opinion on the matter, it may be that the Admiral's apparent dislike of this ferry-service causes him to pay undue attention to the necessity for repairs.

(e) I consider that Admiral Brown should be told firmly that he must follow the correct channels of communication and that he must also make every effort to keep the cruisers running exclusively on the ferry service for troops, as it is essential to the fulfilment of the Allied military program that as many troops as possible shall be carried to the Malaya at the earliest date (see my letter to H. H. Almon Movement of Troops dated 2nd April 44 ref 88/24.)

(f) It is requested that in future, except on the advice of Maj. Gen. Almon or Col. Almon both of whom are in the closest touch with the military situation in Malaya, no action affecting Italian Army troops in Malaya be taken by the naval authorities in Malaya.

A conference was held between Brig Gen WHESTER, Col. SIMMONS, Col. WHESTER (Chief of Staff to Brig Gen WHESTER), Major GUNNE (Captain Transport officer at CAGLIARI), Lt Comd SPER and Admiral BRIVONESE at which the Admiral made no further useful suggestions and which did not alter the state of affairs.

APPENDIX 'B' (to Army Sub Commission Letter, 88/14/2 dated 9 May 44.)

CIRCUMSTANCES SURROUNDING THE INCIDENT.

1. Admiral BENVENUTI states that he acted as he did as a result of rumors which were being circulated all over SARDINIA, but which he says may well have originated as a joke, that there was a possibility of a few individuals in the MARCO DIV asking trouble on the ships on the way to Italy.

SIMONIS however has received the impression that the Admiral does not like having his ships used on this ferry service, and allows them to go into port to carry out minor repairs which could well be done without interfering with the ferry program and which in any event appear to take an unreasonably long time. Normally three cruisers, the Montecucoli, Garibaldi and the V'asco should be available, but at no time have all three cruisers been serviceable at once.
