With reference to ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ of transforming Orvieto XX
Transit Camp into a Training Centre for the Transition Army, we
point out the following.

As known, this is the only transit Camp for Reinforcements
from disbanded Units and from the Absent Strength, because Cesano
Training Centre (as ordered by MMIA with letter A/OI4 dated 9yn
inst.) should deal ~~only~~ only with the training of military personnel.

Moreover we cannot forecast the duration of the reporting and
posting of Reinforcements, and it is not possible for the time
being to entrust the Terr.HQs with this duty in view of their
organisation which has not yet been completed.

The transformation of Orvieto Camp into a training Centre will
be possible when suggested by the organisation and experience and
anyhow not before the disbandments and reductions of Units to reach
the ceiling allotted for the Transition Army.

Therefore we suggest that a/m transformation should be postponed
to a future date to be fixed.

1. The drafts from SARDINIA numbering approximately 1,000 will continue at about four day intervals until the beginning of June, after which time, there should be no further traffic of personnel. Arrangements have already been made for trains to meet the ship and except in emergency there should be no need for transit facilities. (x This has always been the case in the past but very often the trains have not met the ships.

2. No drafts are to be anticipated from CALABRIA, future call-ups being in the North. Sicilians will be moved direct to destinations and will not stage at Naples.

3. It is agreed that transit camp facilities for maximum 500 are required for casualties and it is considered adequate accommodation can be found in NAPLES which would be preferable to AFRAGOLA.

The matter should be raised with the senior M.M.I.A.L.O. at NAPLES who is already acquainted with the problem. The available barracks accommodation should be adequate if necessary R.E. work can be approved.

4. It is to be anticipated that 803 BRD at RAVASCANINA will progressively diminish in importance and the necessary staff for transit should be available from this source and render unnecessary the provision of a new transit camp staff.

With reference to M.M.I.A.s observations, I notify:

1 - Frosinone Camp

a) of the 1700 A.W.O.L.s noted at the beginning of April, at the time of the Easter holiday, 653 had already returned by the 7th.inst., and it is expected that many others will return. The matter has already been submitted to M.M.I.A. with S.M.R.E. letter 15225/Mob. dated 10th.inst.

b) on the 7th.inst., Col. CROSA, Camp Commandant, was replaced by Col. CAFFARO Ettore;

c) the number of officers for the two guard battalions has now been completed.

The ~~gaining~~ ^{dispatch} of the N.C.O.'s ought to have been arranged by M.M.I.A., according to agreements, with personnel drawn from Afragola and Trani.

The staffing of the two battalions has been completed, however, with personnel available in the camp;

d) the unit equipment for the two battalions was assigned by the Commissariat Directorate of Bari Mil. Terr. H.Q. on the 3rd.inst. Arrangements have been made ~~that~~ these materials ~~shall~~ be dispatched on the 4th.inst from Bari to Frosinone;

e) according to the instructions issued, all troops drafted to the districts must receive, among other things, a mess tin. It is for this reason that such articles have not been included in the assignments of materials to the Frosinone Centre. Enquiries will be made regarding the issue of bowls in place of mess tins.

In order to remedy the inconvenience telephonic orders have been given, following M.M.I.A.s consent, for the transport of 1000 mess tins from Bari to Frosinone with the transport already loaded at Bari.

There is no fresh water installation.

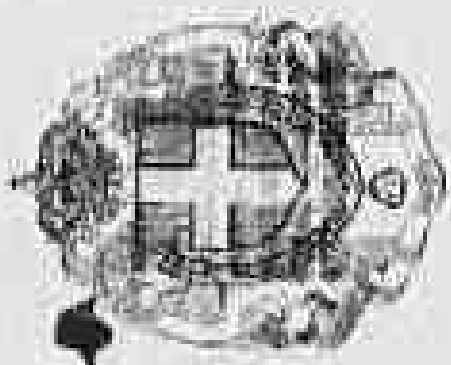

1. It is not easy to comment on the US under reference as no copies are held and publications have not been supplied them. Recommendations cannot therefore be made in the form of increases and decreases.
2. The existing British Staff at the Italian Base Reinforcement Depot at ORVISTO is insufficient. At the moment the officers are a CO, AdjT, and Military Interpreter. 1. COMMANDANT.

In a unit of three bns, designed to cater for up to 6,000 recruits it is essential that the commandant should be an officer with very considerable military experience, both in training and in administration. It is considered that the appointment merits the rank of Colonels, and recommendation is made accordingly.

2. Officers' Mess Staff.

One cook and two waiters only are allotted for a mess containing 91 officers. This is considered to be entirely inadequate. An increase of at least one, in each case, should be made.

3. Clerks

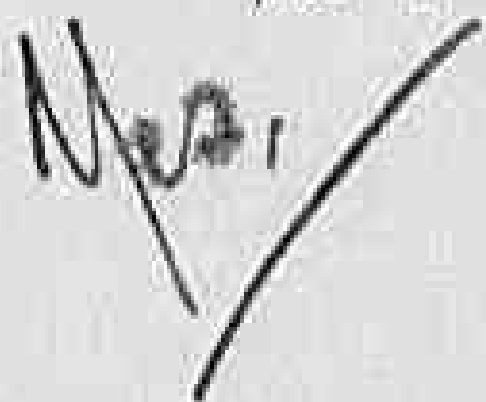

1. It has been represented that the scale of transport authorized on the present WZ of a Brit-Ital B.R.D. is insufficient. In particular application has been made for an increase in load carriers at AFRAGOLA and at ORVIETO. It was understood that 3 District proposed to submit a recommendation for the WZ to be *revised*.

2. In theory, *an* basic scale of transport should suffice for each B.R.D. but it is realized that local conditions vary between Trani, Ravennanone (Afragola), and Orvieto. 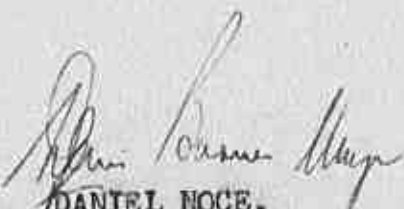
