 - (1) Replacing attritional losses in existing units.
 - (2) Filling newly organized units.
- b. As a basis for the requisition, the aggregate troop basis strength of US - ITI units authorized the using agency and the aggregate assigned strength of the units will be stated. NO MOS or grades and ratings will be specified.
