1. The Italian Military Headquarters on CORSICA will not be moved to FRANCE with Italian Troops of SLAV origin.
2. The Italian Military HQ on CORSICA is at present performing the function of signing for supplies issued by the United States for use of Italian (Slav origin) service troops. After all the Service Troops are moved from CORSICA to FRANCE, the Military HQ will return to the mainland and report to ASTORI Camp as rfts for US-ITI Service Units.
3. There is at present a Lt. AMBROSI (Slav origin) of the Italian Army on duty with the 2696th Technical Supervisory Regiment (U.S. Army). It is desired that you empower Lt. AMBROSI to sign for, upon your behalf, all supplies issued in FRANCE for use of Italian Troops of SLAV origin.

TO : HQ NORBASE

1. The Italian Ministry of War has asked MMIA for a statement of policy as to what will be the position of the Italian tps on CORSICA who will be moved to FRANCE as regards their still being dependent upon Italian Military Headquarters for administrative matters.
2. These tps, although of YUGOSLAV origin, are actually Italian subjects and, therefore, the Ministry of War must retain control of them.
3. Will you please inform this HQ:-
 - (a) If you recommend that the Italian Military HQ CORSICA is to be transferred to FRANCE and when you consider it should be phased in with other moves of Italian tps.
 - (b) Whether you consider the present Italian HQ is capable of operating in both places for a short period.

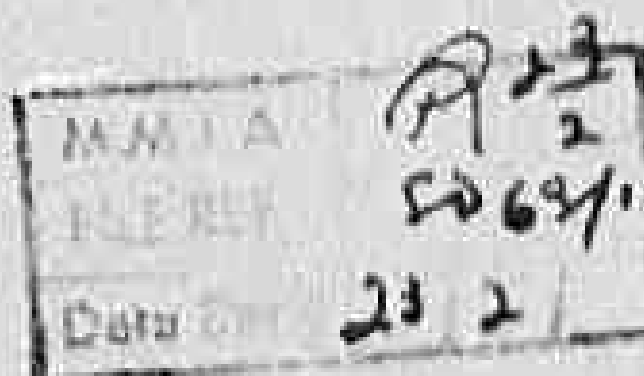

- 6 - Mental (2 violent)

2. Additional Italian troops of Yugoslav origin will be classified as incurables as medical examinations are completed and so determine. It is estimated that approximately forty (40), not requiring hospitalization, will be recommended for evacuation in the near future.
