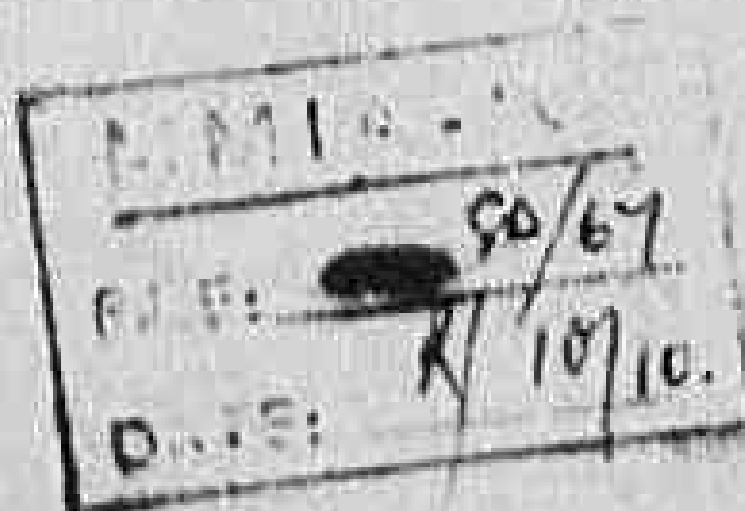

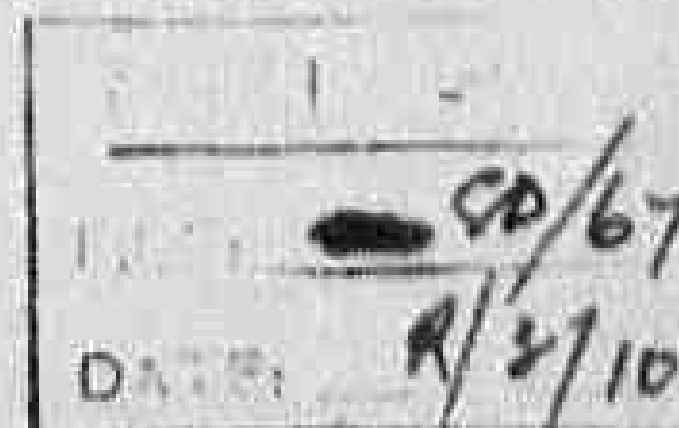

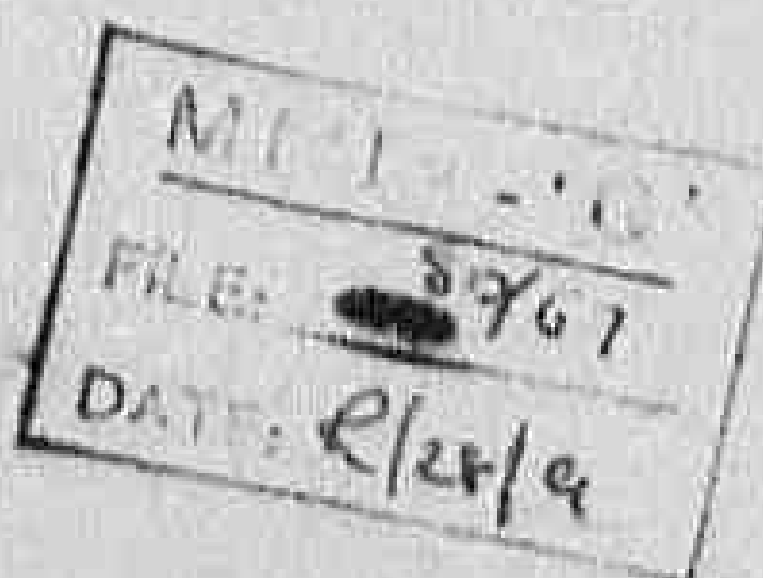

For Information of M. of W.

Further to and in completion of War Ministry (Cabinet) signal M.215000/II dated 5/7/48 dealing with travel regulations for Italian military personnel from and to Sardinia. Assignments and distribution of places on ships doing the service between the mainland and the island, as mentioned in the fore said dispatch, remain unchanged and in full effect. To facilitate the departure of military personnel going to Sardinia on leave of any type or for discharge or on duty (excluding repatriated p.o.w.'s discharged) special journeys will be carried out from Naples by light naval war units. Territorial H.Q.'s and S.Q.'s to whom this letter is addressed will send to Naples military personnel under command in the quantity and on the date as mentioned hereafter : 28th August Naples Ter.H.Q.'s : 100; 29th August Rome Ter.H.Q.'s : 100; 4th September Palermo Ter.H.Q.'s : 100; 10th September Milano Ter.H.Q.'s : 100; 15th September Bologna Ter.H.Q.'s : 100; 22nd September Florence and Bari Ter.H.Q.'s : 50 each; 28th September Genoa and Bolzano Ter.H.Q.'s : 50 each; 4th October Torino and Udine Ter.H.Q.'s : 50 each; 10th October C.G.H.A. and Finances J.H.Q.'s : 50 each. As allot to Sardinia H.Q.'s for each return journey 20 places for military personnel travelling from the island to the mainland. Further instructions concerning time of journeys for the month of October and following months both by civil steamers and war ships will be notified. Military personnel to whom authorisation mentioned in this letter has been granted must have on travel order or leave pass or on discharge certificate the regular stamp of the Ter.H.Q.'s concerned and the following : "Authorized to travel on ships of the war navy leaving from Naples..." dating it a day after the time fixed for reporting to a/s team. It is strictly forbidden to send to Naples military personnel exceeding the established number or on dates different from those fixed with letter M.215000/II of this M. of W. and with this letter. Ter. H.Q.'s to whom this letter is addressed will arrange accordingly and take severe disciplinary action against units not complying with instructions. Naples Ter.H.Q.'s will report by signal any inconvenience eventually occurring and will at the same time order return to the parent units of those military who do not comply with a/s orders.

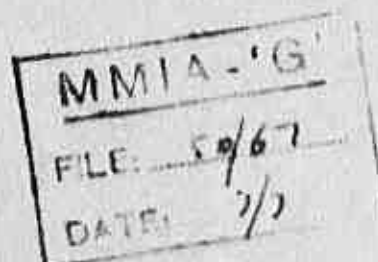
