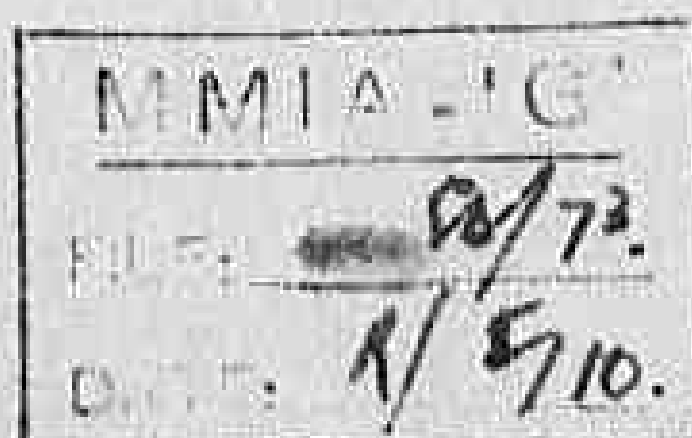
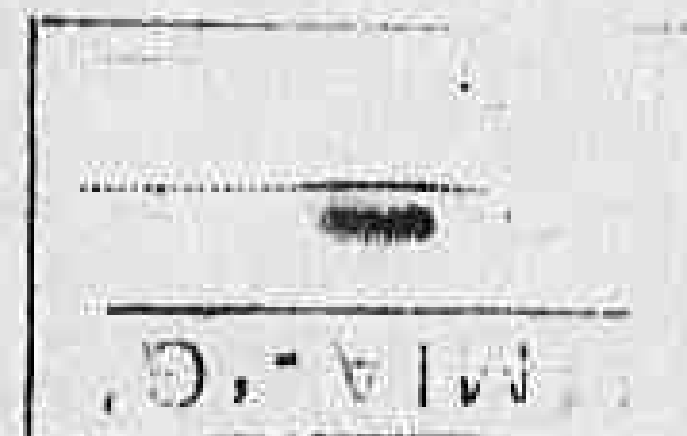

My dear Mr. Prime Minister:

I wish to draw your attention to a matter which has bearing on the points raised in your letter 41304/25372/1.22 dated 27 July 1945.

As is known to you, men of the 1914 - 1924 classes have been called up for military service throughout southern Italy, up to and including the Regions of the Abruzzi and Lazio, with the single exception of the Province of Foggia.

In this Province, the call up was postponed in the first place because of the absence of Italian Administration in the Airforce enclave. Nevertheless, an attempt was made in October 1944 to recall to the colours the estimated 5,000 men in this Province liable for Military Service. The complete failure of this attempt was ascribed by the War Ministry to the local population taking advantage of the presence of the Allies and more particularly:-

- (a) Large numbers of men employed by MAAF and encouraged by the latter not to present themselves;
- (b) the inability of the Italian authorities to enforce the law owing to restrictions imposed by the Allies in the enclave.

On 30th June Allied Force Headquarters instructed all A.A.F. units in that area to give every possible assistance to the Government Authorities to effect the call up. The Italian General Staff had recommended that firm action should be taken, but the Ministry of the Interior having been consulted (in view of the recent disturbances in Apulia), stated that in their opinion it was undesirable to upset the population of the Province by enforcing the call up at this moment.

The fact that the matter has been allowed to lapse is common knowledge; you will appreciate, I know, Mr. Prime Minister, that as well as causing discontent and lowering the discipline among men from the

adjacent provinces, this is likely to have serious repercussions throughout the country. The fact that the future of the Italian Army is being considered at the highest level and that the possibility of a call up in the Northern Regions is under examination, makes it particularly important that the authority of the Army should be maintained at this stage. Moreover, the matter has direct bearing on the question of equality of military service and the demobilization of older classes, mentioned in your letter referred to above.

I should be grateful, Mr. Prime Minister, if this subject could be given serious consideration, and I would urge that your Government should take firm action in the matter. I understand that the Garibaldi Regiment is stationed in the Foggia area and would therefore be in a position to assist in enforcing the call up of at least the 1920 - 1924 classes. The entire 1914 - 1919 classes will in any case be demobilized before long, and their call up is not therefore a matter of such moment.

1. The following is passed to you for information and action, being a further instance of the over-conciliatory and weak-kneed attitude of the present Italian Government.
2. Men of the 1914-24 Classes liable for the Military Service have been called up throughout the whole of Southern Italy and up to LAGIO/ARROZZI Regions inclusive, with the single exception of the BOGOLIA Province.
3. The call-up in BOGOLIA was postponed in the first place, because of the shortcomings and lack of authority of the Italian Administration in the Airforce Enclave. Nevertheless, an attempt was made in Oct 1944 to recall to the colours the estimated 5,000 men in this Province liable for Military Service. The complete failure of this attempt was ascribed by the War Ministry to the local population taking advantage of the presence of the Allies and more particularly :-

- (a) Large numbers of men employed by IAAF and encouraged by the latter not to present themselves ;
- (b) impossibility for the Italian Authorities to enforce the law owing to restrictions imposed by the Allies in the enclave.
4. IAAF were informed, and on 30 June 1945 instructions were issued to give every assistance to the Italian authorities in effecting the call-up (Annex A).

5. The stage was now set for rounding up the recalcitrants and also the recommendation of the Italian General Staff that this should be proceeded with. But because of the recent disturbances in BOGOLIA the War Ministry decided to consult the Minister of the Interior and a report

4. AFHQ were informed, and on 30 June 1945 instructions were issued to give every assistance to the Italian Authorities in effecting the call-up (Annex "A").

5. The stage was now set for rounding up the recalcitrants. *800* was also the recommendation of the Italian General Staff that this should be proceeded with. But because of the recent disturbances in APULIA the War Ministry decided to consult the Minister of the Interior, and a negative reply has now been received from the latter on the grounds that it is undesirable to upset the population of the Province at this moment.

6. (a) If the population of the FOUILLO can float law and order in this way and get away with it, it bodes ill for the authority of the Govt and the Army in the rest of the country.

(b) It is common knowledge that the men from this Province have succeeded in evading their obligations and this breeds discontent and lowers discipline among the men of the adjacent Provinces.

(c) It is particularly important that the authority of the Army be maintained at this stage, when a call-up is being considered for the Northern Regions, hitherto exempt, and the whole question of the future of the Italian Army is being examined on the highest level.

(d) It so happens that the GARIBOLDI is stationed not far from the FOGGIA Province and could conveniently be used for rounding up the men who fail to report, and for maintaining order in the event of disturbances.

7. For all the above reasons it is recommended that pressure be brought to bear on the Italian Government to implement - effectively and energetically - the recall to the colours in the FOGGIA Province of at least the 1920-24 Classes. (1915-1919 Classes will gradually be demobilized in the coming months).

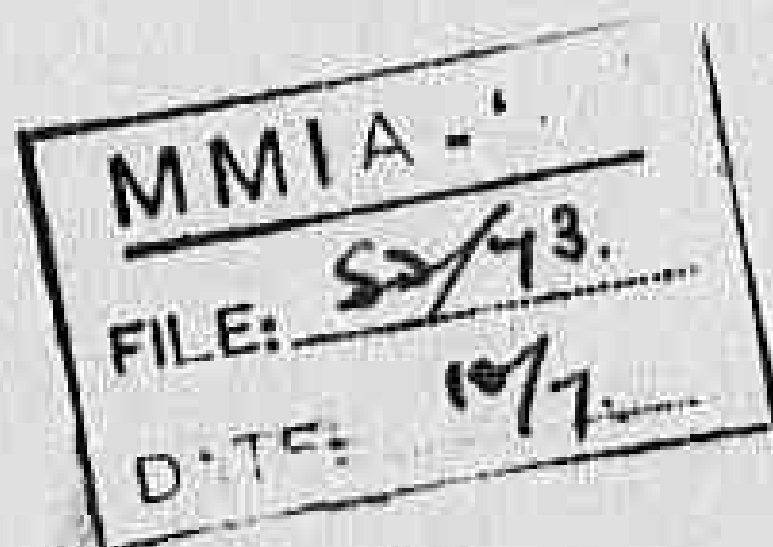

Following conversations with Major Baumann of M.M.I.A. the possibility was re-examined of carrying out the necessary combing out operations on the occasion of the call-up in Foggiano, using 100 carabinieri and the guard companies of the Raviscanina and Trani reinforcement transit camps.

Approached on the matter:-

- G.H.Q. of the CC.RR corps submitted that it had no carabinieri personnel available since, because of the preparation of 19,000 CC.RR for the needs of the North, the legions had no further personnel available and were not even in a position to meet the continual demands made upon them for their ordinary service duties;
- Naples and Bari Military Territorial H.Q.s submitted the necessity of not taking away, even temporarily, the guard companies of their respective BR-ITI transit camps in order that the latter would not be placed in a serious position, in view of the large number of reinforcements in transit.

Taking the above into consideration I would confirm the necessity of postponing the call-up in Foggiano until a more opportune moment.

Prevailing conditions in Foggia province give every reason to expect further lack of success in the call-up operations unless they are backed up with the employment of a force sufficient for combing out and conducted with decision.

Since the call-up has been scheduled ~~xxxxxxxxxx~~ by M.M.I.A. to commence on the 1st. May (letter SD/73 of 15.3.45) it will be necessary to have a mobile battalion of CC.RR available on that date.

The sole force of the Corps at present available is that prepared for the North, but the employment of such has been strictly forbidden by the P.S. Sub-commission.

If ~~xxxxx~~, therefore, it is not possible to permit of the use of the above mentioned CC.RR units for the upholding of the prestige and authority of the state, H.E. the Minister of War would judge it necessary to postpone the call-up until a more opportune moment.

Bearing/mind this state of affairs I earnestly approach M.M.I.A. that it may be so kind as to take the urgent decisions it considered possible in view of the particular delicacy of the question.

Subject: Call up of troops in Foggiano.

As noted by the M.M.I.S. in contrast with results in other regions, the call up of troops in Foggiano, has shown practically a negative result.

From investigations carried out, the above situation, is caused mainly by the employment by the Allied Authorities, in continuous and part time work, of approx 5,000 men who are subject to military service. According to the C.C.R.R. these men have not presented themselves for service because the Allied Authorities have expressed their disapproval to the recall of the said men.

Logically, other troops who are subject to call up, or recall, have shown resistance, thus justifying their absence.

In order to remedy the A/M unpleasant and prejudicial situation that exists particularly in the regions adjoining Foggiano, we ask the M.M.I.S. to request the various Allied Authorities stationed in the A/M areas:

- 1st The nominal roles, or at least a numerical statement of those men in service with various A.R.s, and who are subject to call up.
- 2nd The eventual requirements of Italian military for service with the various Commands.

Furnished with this information this S.M. will be able to propose the most opportune solution regarding the illegal position of the A/M military in question, to the C.M.A.

3. Your co-operation in ensuring the minimum of interference with the arrangements for call-up will be greatly appreciated.

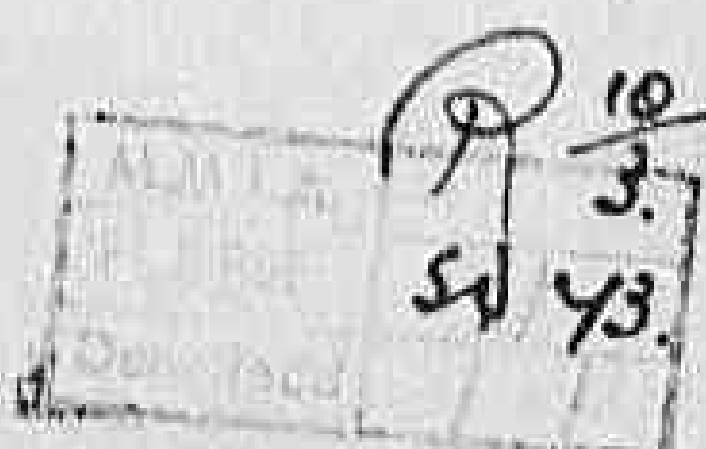

Call up of men belonging to classes 1914-24 began in Foggiano on 20. Jan. 45.

Results obtained up to the present are so little that they could be considered as nil. Of the 16,000 men in the census ^{and} 400 called up, only 400 reported to the centres of whom 200 have been incorporated.

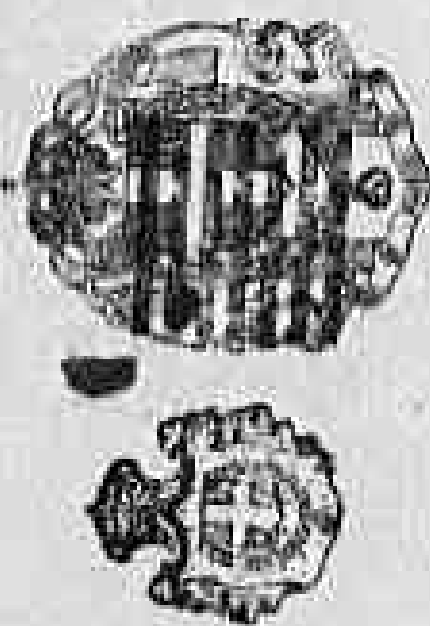

1. Herewith a report on the FOGGIA Call-up and the conditions at MINERVINO Camp.

2. Of the target figure of 5,000 due to be called up between 25 Oct and 2 Nov 44, 12 men had reported by 5 Nov. 5 had reported previous to the proclamation, and were forwarded to MINERVINO from 47 Inf. Regt. LECCE.

3. I am of the opinion that there is one main reason for this. XV Air Force employs a very great number of civilian labourers on the many air fields in the FOGGIA Province. The remoteness of the war and the state of comparative well-being in this area have induced a peace time mentality in the population, who would naturally be most unwilling to throw up their jobs and return to the colours. Nor would it suit XV Air Force to have their existing labour disappear overnight. In fact, I am informed that on 31 Oct., their civil employment office at FOGGIA was advertising for a further 3,000 labourers. The result is that men have not responded to the call-up at all.

4. As for MINERVINO camp, it consists of 15 Nissen huts maintained by Garrison Engineers, BARLETTA, and at the disposal of Town Major, BARLETTA, as a convoy staging-area with covered accommodation. When I arrived, 18 Pioneer Group, who had been using the camp as a Pioneer Formation Centre during the summer, were pulling out, taking with them the G 1098 and accommodation stores which had made a camp out of the staging-area, and the Italian Camp Staff which 18 Group had formed out of their Pioneer allotment. Nothing, therefore, was left but the Nissen Huts and the fields in which they stand.

5. With the collaboration of MAJOR MURCELL, cooking utensils hurricane lamps, spades, etc., were obtained from Mil. HQ. P & L. to

6. The situation at the moment, therefore, is that we are lodging at this camp a staff of 45 and the 12 recruits they administer.

7. It would be appreciated if instructions could be sent as to the disposal of this personnel.
