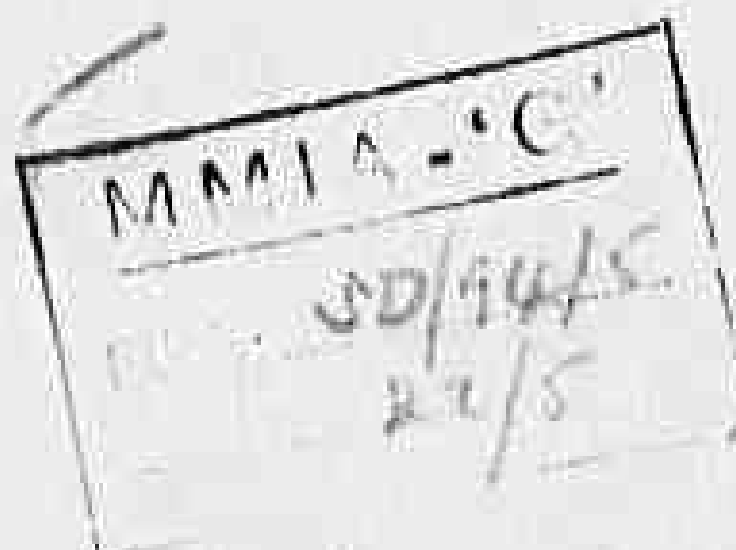

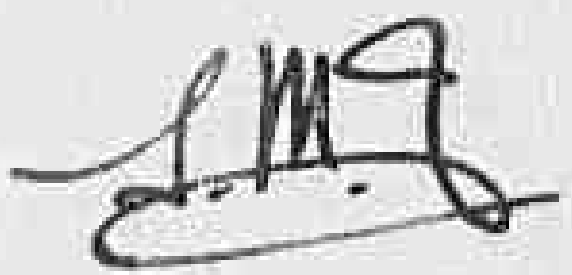

2. 2nd and 3rd Truck Bns are in the process of being formed, but as these will comprise US-ITI personnel they will not come within the ceiling of 3000. The three Bns will be organized into the Motor Transport Group, Allied Commission.

3. The Mine Training Team of 30 Offrs and ORs are dispersed to various training centres up and down the country. Two of the Mine Clearance Coys will eventually be moved into N.W. Italy, but until information as to where mines have been sown is obtained, their future location cannot be given.

4. The formation of a fourth Mine Clearance Coy with a similar W.E. to the other three is considered necessary - this H.Q. letter numbered as above dated 1 Feb 45 refers. 5. In addition, 100 military instructors are urgently required, for the training of civilian squads, particularly for the North.
