1. Visit to "M" Delegation S.M.R.E., Viterbo (23 Oct 44).

The question in regard to the administration of 2001 - 2002 - 2003 - 2005 Platoons have been examined. After this examination the Commandant of the Delegation (Lt-Col. Piccinini of S.M.R.E.) has given the order to the 210 It. Division Command to take care of the financial organization of the s/m platoons, so now all the material problems will be easily settled. From now on the officers in charge will not have to go down to Naples anymore just to collect the wages for their men, as it happened before.

2. Inspection of the 2001 Platoon (Leghorn-Ardenna, 25 Oct 44).

The present strength of this platoon stands at 14 men and 1 officer. It also has 7 men attached who belong to the 31 Co. (8 Italian Battalion P.B.S.). The total is 21 men and 1 officer. However, the total should be 30 men and 1 officer, so it would be necessary to complete the platoon by either attaching 15 men and returning the 7 men to the 31 P.B.S. or by attaching only 9 men and keeping the attached 31 Co. men in this platoon.

3. Inspection of the 2002 Platoon, Leghorn. (27 Oct 44).

The present strength of this 2002 Platoon stands at 19 men and 1 officer. It should stand at 30 men and 1 officer. It ought therefore to be completed.

4. Inspection of the 2005 Platoon, Leghorn-Ardenna. (28 Oct 44).

This platoon is complete (1 officer and 31 men). On the 23rd October, according to orders received, it moved from Siena to Leghorn, in order to combine its duties with 2001-2002 Platoons. This platoon has not received part of its wages recently, but the undersigned has already notified the "M" Delegation S.M.R.E., so from now on the men will be regularly paid.

2. Inspection of the 2001 Platoon (Leghorn-Indiana, 26 Oct 44).
The present strength of this platoon stands at 14 men and 1 officer. It also has 7 men attached who belong to the 31 Co. (8 Italian Battalion P.B.S.). The total is 21 men and 1 officer. However, the total should be 30 men and 1 officer, so it would be necessary to complete the platoon by either attaching 15 men and returning the 7 men to the 31 P.B.S. or by attaching only 9 men and keeping the attached 31 Co. men in this platoon.

3. Inspection of the 2002 Platoon, Leghorn. (27 Oct 44).
The present strength of this 2002 Platoon stands at 19 men and 1 officer. It should stand at 30 men and 1 officer. I thought therefore to be completed.

4. Inspection of the 2003 Platoon, Leghorn-Indiana. (28 Oct 44).
This platoon is complete (1 officer and 31 men). On the 25th October, according to orders received, it moved from Siena to Leghorn, in order to combine its duties with 2001-2002 platoons. This platoon has not received part of its wages recently, but the undersigned has already notified the "Int. Delegation S.A.S.S.", so from now on the men will be regularly paid.

5. Inspection of the 2005 Platoon, Valtourina-Salerno (Florence). 26 Oct 44.
This platoon has actually 1 officer and 16 men, 11 attached. According to a request from the AG. of Emilia Region, 6 men (drivers) will be posted to this platoon as soon as possible. The soldiers of this platoon have got everything they need, and the Allied Command has always had many regards for the Italian soldiers.

6. Notes on 2001-2002-2005 Platoons.

Until recently, these platoons collected their food from Allied stores. A few days ago Allied Command ordered the Italian Officers in charge to collect their food from the Italian stores of Coltano (which is about 10 miles outside Leghorn). Many difficulties then arose, as the Italian stores are only allowed to supply the Italian troops directly attached to the Italian Army, and not the Italian Platoons attached to Allied Commands. For several days no food at all was collected, and it would therefore be necessary for the Allied Authorities to continue supplying the food to 2001-2002-2005 platoons. As for the clothing situation, these three platoons are very badly off, especially 2005 is deprived of everything. The Allies seem to have some difficulties supplying the necessary clothing, - it has not been stated what store should supply it.

7. The/

7. The 2001-2002 and 2003 platoons need to have their hygiene condition improved; the medical assistance gives plenty of trouble, as the civilian hospital at Leghorn, in charge of the Italian soldiers, cannot take good care of our men. It would be a great help if Allied Military Hospitals were allowed to take care of these men, as they often need ~~assurances~~ medicines and disinfectants that the Italian hospitals do not possess.

The accommodation for these troops are also very poor; beds are old and there are not enough of them, and the Italian stores of this region have not the necessary material to remedy these needs.

1. The 541st and 543rd Service Companies with a strength of 117 and 123 respectively are Civite Veccechia. These Companies are now carried on our strength return as assigned to ACC. Col Perren of ACC told me this morning that ACC did not want these Companies any longer.

2. I called Major Friedberg at AAI and after a conference with Lt Col MacQueen, Major Friedberg telephoned me that these two Companies are being taken from ACC and assigned to PBS as reinforcements, and when PBS picks them up, 541 and 543 Service Companies will cease to exist. This is being confirmed by signal.

3. I called Colonel Loef at PBS this afternoon and Col. Loef said that they would arrange to pick these men up and incorporate them into the 212th Division. I do not know exactly when this will be done, but Col. Loef said that he would get it done as quickly as possible. These Companies have been drawing rations from the Rome Depot and I understand that they have several days' rations now on hand, which will probably suffice until they are picked up by PBS.
