SUBJECT : Non Italian speaking Italian troops formerly in Corsica

Lt Col Toselli, formerly officer commanding the non Italian speaking troops in Corsica, has notified that all the Italian troops who were on the island have been transferred to France and that his HQ has been disbanded and repatriated.

This Ministry, in memo 105753/1/2 dated 2 March, to which we have recieved no reply, took the liberty of expressing its opinion opposing the proposed disbandment of the Italian HQ of the non Italian speaking Italian troops following the transfer of the units to France, stressing the necessity for formal representation of the Italian Authority to which the said units, regular units of the Italian Army are subject.

I beg M.M.I.A. to kindly inform me of the status now assumed by these units which have been transferred abroad, in respect of:

- (a) their control by the Italian Military Authorities;
- (b) their position from the judicial, documentary and administrative point of view.

I should be very pleased of your kind reply at your earliest convenience.

SUBJECT: Non-Italian-speaking-Italian troops in Corsica.

1) - As is known the number of non-Italian-speaking-Italian troops in Corsica before December 1944 amounted to about 5000 men and formed, with 27 companies, a detachment of the 2698 Technical Supervisory Regiment.

2) - In December 1944 the transfer of the companies to France was commenced and on the 14th. May last there were only 5 companies in Corsica whose departure was expected to occur by the end of May.

3) - Since the Italian H.Q. of non-Italian-speaking-Italian troops has been disbanded by order of the Allied Command on the spot, and the personnel returned to the mainland, we submit the advisability of no longer counting the 5000 men against the authorised strength of the Italian Army.
