- 1; Since ex Italian cooperators are now members of the Italian Army they are subject to Italian military law, administered by Italian authorities. They therefore cannot be tried by Allied officers.
2. If Allied equipment on charge to Allied Units, is lost or damaged by Italian soldiers, then the correct procedure is to apply for a write-off through British channels with a request that such loss or damage be charged to the Italian Government.
3. Where Allied or ex-Allied clothing and personal equipment on charge to Italian Units is lost or damaged by Italian soldiers, this is a matter for Italian administration, since the equipment has already been charged to the Italian Government.
4. Certain equipment especially technical equipment is on loan to Italian Units ("to perform an allotted task or mission") although on charge to BLU, Cadre, or other Allied Units. A D.O.S. Circular No 222 is shortly to be published giving instructions to cover this.

Soldiers and N.C.C. pay.

A decree now in course of being passed, grants a temporary daily emolument equal to double the pay, to soldiers and N.C.C.'s who have served for a period of 40 months continual service and equal to the pay for other troops with less than 40 months service.

As a result the pay will be increased as follows:-

Soldiers with more than 40 months continual service.

PTES from 5	Lire per diem to 15	Lire per diem.
L/cpl. " 5.70	" " " to 17.10	" " "
Cpl. " 6.70	" " " to 20.10	" " "

Soldiers with less than 40 months service.

PTES from 5	Lire per diem to 10	Lire per diem.
L/cpl. " 5.70	" " " to 11.40	" " "
Cpl. " 6.70	" " " to 13.40	" " "

This increase is in addition to the 4 lire per diem operational allowance for all troops and the 20.32 and 45 lire allowance for those entitled to such.
