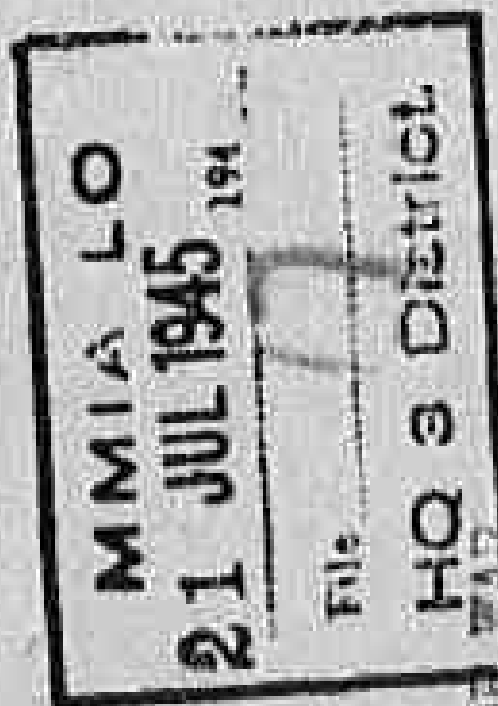

1. I have had under examination the question of the future of both the Italian Co-operator Art Wks Coys and Italian Engr Coys in 3 District and have some definite recommendations to make to you.

2. Without labouring the point too much I should like to repeat the reasons why in the future the ex Co-operator Art Wks Coys are unlikely to be useful engr units. These are :-

- (a) The withdrawal of the British cadres. The men of Co-operator units have been personally selected from the cages with much care by their present OOs. They owe to those OOs and have paid to them a certain allegiance which will quite definitely cease when the British cadres leave.
- (b) The loss of the privilege of obtaining NAATI supplies and the change from British scale of rations and clothing to Italian scales.
- (c) The lack of confidence of BRITIS in Italian Army administration and in the Italian medical service.
- (d) The lack of suitable Italian Engr officers to take over the command of these coys and to take over the appointments of second in command and Pl officers.
- (e) The 1914 and earlier classes are due for release and although these men may in certain circumstances be retained, it is quite evident that they will desert or be of very little use if an effort is made to retain them. These classes form 50% of the units and the bulk of the tradesmen.

3. The handover of the command and administration of Co-operator Art Wks Coys from the British cadre to the Italian cadre is not going smoothly at all. The chief reason for this is that the Italian authorities are unable or unwilling to produce suitable Italian coy commanders and cadres. For instance, 884 Co-operator Coy is at present commanded by a subaltern and he is endeavouring to take over command and administration from a British

5. The handover of the command and administration of Co-operator Art Wks Coys from the British cadre to the Italian cadre is not going smoothly at all. The chief reason for this is that the Italian authorities are unable or unwilling to produce suitable Italian coy commanders and cadres. For instance, 881 Co-operator Coy is at present commanded by a subaltern and he is endeavouring to take over command and administration from a British major.

4. Since the change-over from Co-operator status to the Italian Army has taken place it is significant that the sick, absentee and deserter rate has gone up by 100%.

5. There are at present in 3 District six ex Co-operator Coys and six Italian engr Coys and I am assured that there is no hope of finding the necessary Italian specialist personnel, either officers or men to replace efficiently the British cadres and to make good the loss of tradesmen due to the release of classes. If all these units are retained the result will be 12 understrength, poorly commanded Italian engr units in this District which will be more of a burden than a blessing, and to avoid this I have the following recommendation to make:-

6. Recommendation/

6. Recommendation

That the six ex Co-operator Coys be disbanded and that the six Italian Engr Coys be raised at their expense to the status of Art Hqs Coys.

The G1098 eqpt and tvt of the ex Co-operator Coys could be taken over by the Italian Engr Coys and the best officers and men from the ex Co-operator Coys used to make them up to strength.

7. If this recommendation is adopted an increase in importance will be given to the present Italian Engr Coys and their morale and efficiency should go up accordingly. At the same time the Co-operator Coys will fade out and will not have to accept as Coys terms which are very distasteful to them. With only six Italian units in the District it may be possible to ensure that they are well commanded and administered and kept up to strength.

8. Col. BLAND, Italian Army Engineer Liaison officer to this HQ, is quite capable of effecting this re-organisation of Italian units if the necessary authority is given.

9. When the 5 German Engineer units forecast for 3 District are available, it may be possible to offer up some of these newly constituted Italian Art Hqs Coys.

Company to the R.A.F. Unit or ORLANDO.
3. You are requested to make mutual arrangements with the Italian Air Ministry for pay and general administration of army men in R.A.F. units until they are handed over completely to the Army.
4. Italian Air Force or Italian Naval personnel now employed in R.A.F. Army ex-cooperator units will be transferred by the Adm Div concerned to the nearest Italian Air Force or Naval H.Q., replacements being found, if required, from Army personnel at the Adm Div's disposal. Nominal rolls of men transferred in this way will be forwarded to M.I.A., who will pass them on to the Sub-Commission concerned.
5. The only Army ex-cooperator personnel employed by the Royal Navy are in 1 and 4 Italian Navy Companies at VENICE and GENOA respectively. These are not affected by the above paragraphs. As stated in M.I.A. 52/131/ of 26 June they will be administered by the Adm Div. in the area where they are located, through Italian Naval sailing.

The Territorial H.Q. will arrange for posting to a RR-ITI unit within its territory, or, if there are no vacancies in units, to IMAC, CASANO. Movement will be direct from the R.A.F. Company to the RR-ITI unit or IMAC.

3. You are requested to make mutual arrangements with the Italian Air Ministry for pay and general administration of Army men in R.A.F. units until they are handed over completely to the Army.

4. Italian Air Force or Italian Naval personnel now employed in RR-ITI Army ex-cooperator units will be transferred by the Adm Div concerned to the nearest Italian Air Force or Naval H.Q., replacements being found, if required, from Army personnel at the Adm Div's disposal. Nominal rolls of men transferred in this way will be forwarded to MMIA, who will pass them on to the Sub-Commission concerned.

5. The only Army ex-cooperator personnel employed by the Royal Navy are in 1 and 4 Italian Navy Companies at VENICE and GENOA respectively. These are not affected by the above paragraphs. As stated in MMIA 52/131 of 26 June they will be administered by the Adm Div. in the area where they are located, though held against the Italian Naval ceiling.

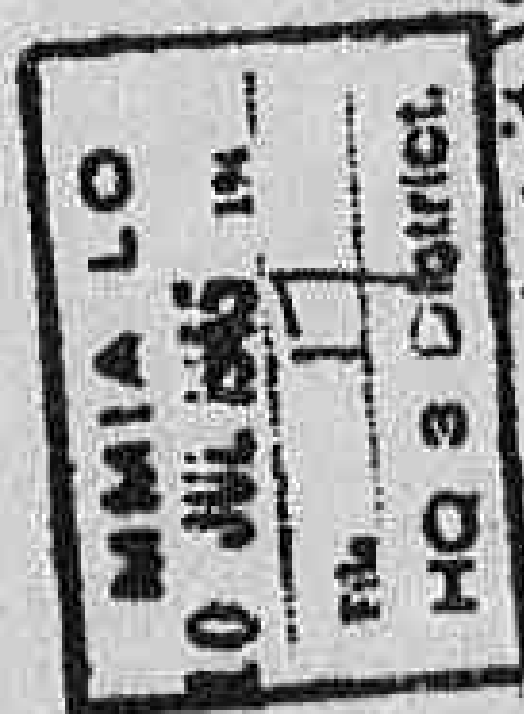

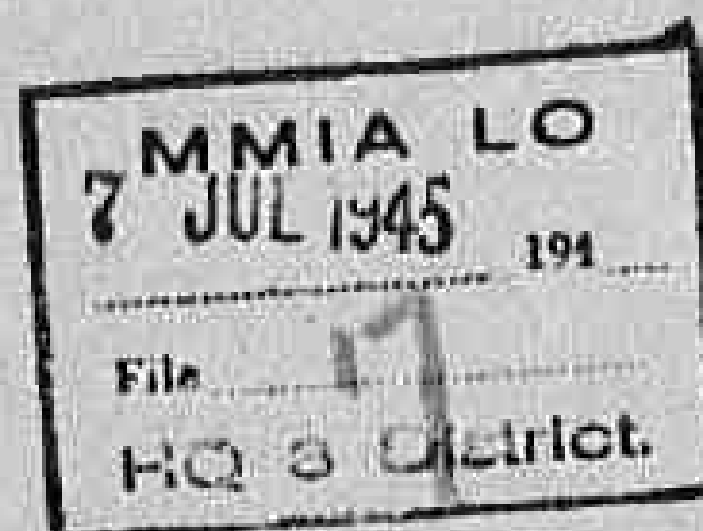

1. Herewith for information a copy of the ~~amending~~ order issued by this HQ to the Italian War Ministry (with the latest amendment) for the transfer of British Cooperator personnel to the Italian Army.
2. Until a Final Order of Battle is decided by AFHQ and suitable war establishments for the new Italian Army units have been approved the War Ministry cannot take final executive action to withdraw cooperators from British units or to complete to ~~the~~ Italian Army units to be composed of ex-cooperators.
3. Interim action is being taken as follows :-

(a) Units in Appendix "A" Part I & II and Appendix "C".

War establishments are being written at this HQ. These will be forwarded to AFHQ as soon as possible for final approval. War Ministry are making arrangements through AFHQ Div HQs for these units to come under full Italian AFHQ at once. Final steps to complete these that are to remain to correct WE strength will be taken when full details are available.

Units in Appendix "B".

It has been decided by AFHQ that where units wish to keep cooperator personnel in a civilian capacity they may offer employment to this personnel and apply for their demobilisation. War Ministry are being instructed to post from units in Appendix "B" to units in Appendix "A" within the appropriate AFHQ Div all cooperators who are no longer required by the OC British unit. Those that are still required, either because replacements are not available or they awaiting demobilisation, will remain with the ~~the~~ units until final instructions are received but will be placed under AFHQ Div HQs for all purposes.

(c) Demobilisation of men in 1914 or over Classes.

- (iii) Personnel of 1914 Class and older who may be released regardless of the quality of the replacement.

Ministry of War will then be requested to arrange for demobilisation of personnel listed in replies to para (iii) above, and of all cooperators of 1914 Class and older not included in replies to para (i) and (ii) above.

W.C.F. 1 July 45 rations which are drawn under arrangements made by 1st Div HQs will be accounted for on SM/S in the normal way.

4. It is anticipated that the transfer should be completed by 31 July and AFHQ are being recommended to issue all formal disbandment and formation orders etc to be effective as at that date.

1. Herewith Location Statement of all units employing cooperator personnel, given in Appendices as follows :-

(a) Appendix "A"

Units whose cooperator personnel it is anticipated will be formed into self administering Italian Army units. As this HQ is responsible for providing the necessary Italian Army WEs this Appendix has been divided into two parts as below :-

Part 1. Units already self-administering or to be made self-administering by the addition of adm personnel, for which WEC action will be taken as below.

(i) Where diluted units (i.e. those units which include British and Italian elements) are predominantly Italian, the British personnel will remain on the existing war establishment. 2. This letter will not be taken as authority for the conversion to the new units of any of the units shown in App A or the transfer of any cooperators from one unit to another, but is intended as a warning order to enable you to make the necessary preparations.

The Location Statement is divided into Appendices as above purely to show that WEC action will be necessary in accordance with SD/131 of 22 June 45. The strengths of units shown in Appendix "A" are provisional and subject to the decision of MACIA WEC and final concurrence of AFHQ.

3. A final Order of Battle will be issued by AFHQ giving a comprehensive statement of all Italian Army units to be formed from cooperator personnel. All other cooperator personnel will then be considered as available for reinforcements in the Italian Army.

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5. Given at Appendix "C" is a list of units composed of Italian operators which are working for Royal Navy.
As this personnel is Italian Army it will be administered through Italian Army channels except in so far as it is operationally controlled by Royal Navy and will count against the Royal Navy Ceiling.
The units shown in Appendix "C" will therefore be treated as BR-ITI units for documentation and adm as detailed in para 4 above.
