1. The Italian Ministry of War employs a considerable number of civilian personnel, some of whom are ex army officers. The majority of these civilians are employed in the "A" and "Q" branches of the Ministry and are called upon from time to time to make journeys into Army Areas on duty on instructions from Heads of Branches in accordance with orders emanating from MMIA.
2. In the past these officials, known as "Personale Militarizzato", have applied to this H.Q. for permits to enter Army areas. These permits - specimen copy attached - have been issued for all authorized journeys.
3. It is confirmed that, in future, the standard yellow pass will be issued to all civilian employees of the Ministry of War in accordance with the provisions of Executive Memorandum 77.
4. May a Booklet of the standard pass forms please be supplied to this H.Q.

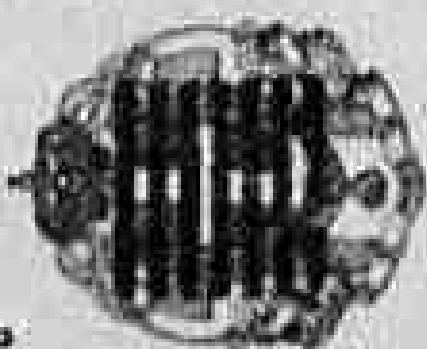
1. H.E. Palermo left Rome on Jan. 16th to go to Cesena, on request of 8th Army and provided with a regular MIA pass.
2. Near PONTASSIEVE he suffered a serious motor car accident which prevented him from continuing the trip. Since he could not, evidently, remain in the open country to wait for help which would have never arrived nor could he walk to Cesena merely because his pass was made out to that point, he adopted the only possible solution, i.e. he had his car towed to Florence where he was forced to remain for one day and a half waiting for the car to be repaired.
3. During his forced sojourn in Florence I consider it natural that H.E. Palermo should have visited Italian HQs and units, contacting 210 Div who control, among other units, the officers' transit camp.
4. There was, therefore, no case of voluntary violation of regulations but merely one of those cases of circumstances beyond control which cannot be foreseen in programmes.

1. Information has been received by H.Q. A.C. that on or about Jan 17th: Signor PALEOLOG, Undersecretary for War, was in FLORENCE without any authority from A.M.C. Fifth Army or any other authority. While there he paid an unauthorised visit to the A.M.C. refugee centre and dined at least twice with 210 Italian Division.
2. The Chief Commissioner's wishes as regards such visits were made known to the President of the Council in the Chief Commissioner's letter 800/11/008 of 23 Oct 44.
3. The disregard of travel regulations on the part of the Undersecretary for War is regarded by H.Q. A.C. in a very serious light and I am instructed to ask for an explanation from the Italian Government.

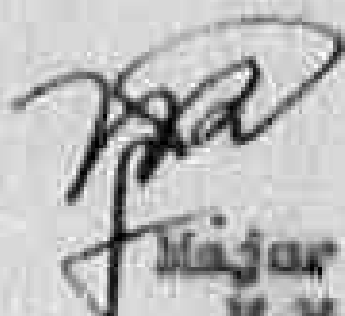

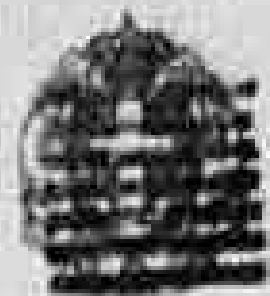

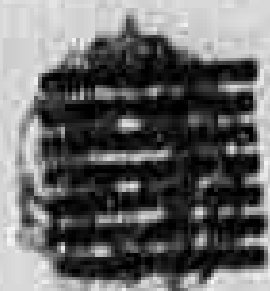

1. Your attention is drawn to 800/17/COS of 4 Nov 44. SCAO 5 Army has informed me that :

" On or about January seventeenth information was received by this office that Signor Palermo, Undersecretary for War, was in Florence without any authority from AMG Fifth Army or any other authority, as far as can be ascertained. While here he made an unauthorized visit to the AMG Refugee Center and also dined at least twice with the 210th Italian Division, where he made political addresses communistic in character and, according to reports, hostile to the Government in power. "

2. This disregard for travel regulations on the part of the Under Secretary of War is regarded in a very serious light and the Italian Government should be asked for an explanation.

(For Civil Affairs Section)

1. For security reasons it is essential that civilian movement into Army Area be kept down to the minimum. The number of applications for permission for civilians to enter Army area is however rapidly increasing and reaching undesirable proportions.
2. The number of enemy agents known to be at large is considerable and at the present time security agencies are fully extended in suppressing illegal entry into the area. There is also a large amount of civilian mail being brought in by illicit means and there is good reason to believe that a great deal of this is carried by civilians who have received permission to enter.
3. It is therefore requested that Sub-Commissions desiring to send representatives into this area should, as far as possible, confine their requests to Allied Officers and Allied civilians. Only in exceptional circumstances should application be made for Italian employees, or for representatives of Italian Ministries.

Disposal of I.A.F. Personnel in Forward Areas.-

With further reference to your 1/101/1 of December 24th and confirming our AFSC/INT/2 of January 3rd in connection with the above matter.

The Italian Air Ministry is most anxious to know whether you agree to the proposal put forward in this Sub Commission's letter of Jan.3rd to the effect that Lt/Col. Santini and Lt. Rodolfo Venturini of the Chief of Staff's department of the R.Aeronautica be authorised to proceed to 8th Army H.Q. in order to discuss the possibility of establishing proper I.A.F. Centres within the 8th Army forward area, where stray I.A.F. personnel can be collected, given the necessary assistance and dealt with according to circumstances.

The position at present is that all the I.A.F. personnel in forward areas is in no way controlled by the I.A.F., receives no financial or other assistance, which situation apart from not being conducive to good discipline is also affecting their morale; as stated in our letter of Jan.3rd the matter is urgent and it would be appreciated if an early decision were taken.

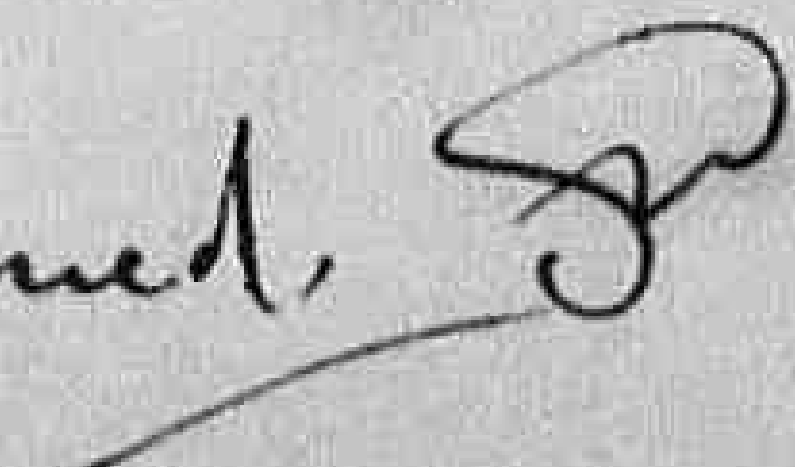

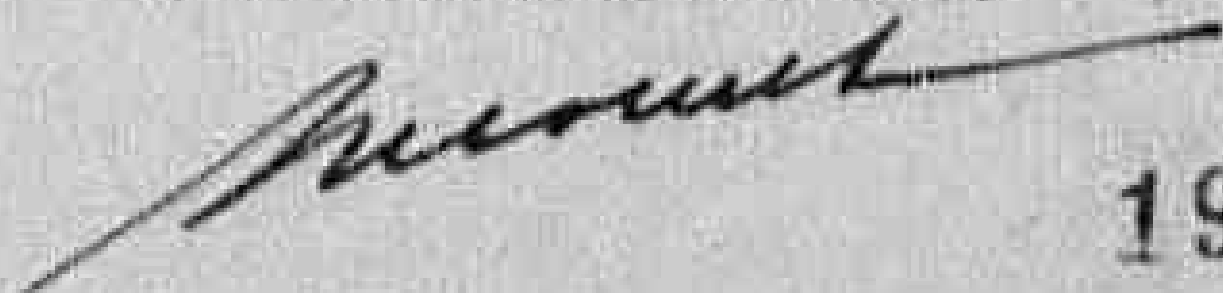

SUBJECT : Issue of Irregular Movement Passes.

TO : Ministry of Interior
(Direzione Generale della Pubblica Sicurezza).

1. Transmitted herewith are three passes issued by the Mayor of Nettuno which purport to authorize CHIARELLI Pietro, PORCARELLI Aurelio and LO FAZIO Tancredi, described as workers, to travel to Livorno which is north of the Rear Army Control Line. It is reported that the three persons named travelled to Livorno with the object of avoiding being called up for military service in their age groups. 9/2

2. The issue of the passes referred to in paragraph 1 is absolutely unauthorized, and since the issue of such passes constitute a threat to security, it is requested that immediate steps be taken to prevent the issue of such passes in the future.

3. It is also requested that this Headquarters be advised of the steps taken by you in this matter.

SUBJECT : Issue of Passes to Army Zone

TO : Regional Commissioner, Abruzzi-Marche
Region (Attn: R.P.S.O.)

1. Transmitted herewith is a Biglietto di Licenza issued by the Regia Marina to a FORTI Antonio together with Movement of Civilian Pass N°396359 issued at Pesaro on 10 December 1944, by Lt.J.W. Clark. The Movement pass purports to authorize Forti to travel from Pesaro to Cesena.

2. It will be noticed that:-

- (a) Forti's address is given as Naples.
- (b) Authority to cross the Army Control Line has been deleted although the Cesena is located north of the line.
- (c) The purpose of the journey is to enable the holder to travel on leave.
- (d) the pass is not signed by the holder
- (e) the issue of the pass is not approved by S.C.A.O., AMG Eight Army. Security clearance at the point of departure is not in itself sufficient approval.

3. It is requested that a report be submitted as to the reasons why the movement pass was issued contrary to the provisions of Executive Memorandum N°77. Return of the Biglietto and pass is also requested.

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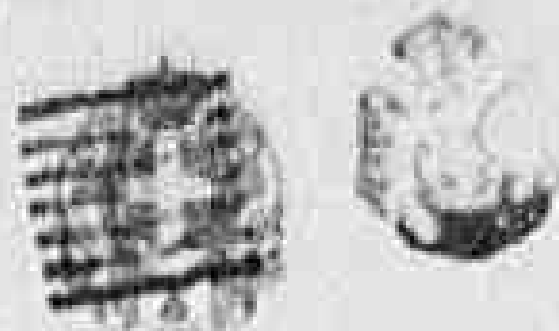

Subject: Unauthorized movement in forward areas.

In reply to your 1/101/I dated 1 Dec 44.

The investigation carried out as a result of your report has yielded the following results :-

1. Lt Col GIACCONI Leandro was found to have had no part in the incident since he left 184th "Folgore" Arty Regt on Sept 26th 1944.
2. D.R. Cpl ZANOTTI, Giuseppe was sent by Capt SALVATI, Ugo acting CO of the 1st "Folgore" Bty.
3. The D.R. should not have passed the security line. He was told to get in touch with the Allied Authorities.
4. The object of the trip was to give news to families of the men of the unit as they found themselves in liberated territory and bring back news of said families.

Capt Salvati has been awarded 10 days close arrest for dis-regarding censorship and movement regulations in force.

Enclosed for further information, copy of the statement signed by Capt Salvati and of the report made by the CO of the "Folgore" Arty Regt.

Trasmetto in originale dichiarazione del capitano SALVATI Ugo, comandante del 1° gruppo, in risposta alle contestazioni mossegli, circa l'invio di un motociclista nella "zona delle armate".

1°) - E' certo che il capitano Salvati nell'ottobre scorso, nell'inviare di sua iniziativa il motociclista nel territorio delle Armate, è stato mosso da sollecitudine per un vitale interesse morale dei suoi soldati, che nutrivano ben comprensibile ansia sulla sorte delle loro famiglie, duramente provate dalla guerra e delle quali da oltre un anno non avevano notizie.

Condizione questa resa più penosa dal confronto con altri compagni che, per aver combattuto nelle vicinanze delle loro case, erano riusciti a prendere subito contatto con i propri congiunti.

E' indubitabile che il divieto fatto ai militari italiani combattenti di corrispondere con le famiglie appena liberate, quantunque imposto da superiori esigenze, aveva le più gravi ripercussioni sullo spirito della truppa: credo del resto di poter ravvisare un provvido riconoscimento della gravità di questo problema nella circolare del Comando Armate Alleate in Italia in data 8 dicembre u.s., che ora consente ai combattenti italiani la possibilità di andare in licenza anche nella zona di sicurezza delle armate.

2°) - Il capitano Salvati esclude nella maniera più assoluta che il motociclista fosse autorizzato o, peggio, mandato ad attraversare le linee per raggiungere il territorio occupato dai tedeschi. Egli aveva tracciato un itinerario, ignorando che talune località non fossero ancora liberate, ma aveva impartito formali istruzioni al cap. magg. ZANOTTI perché, durante il viaggio, assumesse informazioni presso i comandi italiani o alleati, onde evitare lo sconfinamento.

Questa circostanza è confermata dal cap. magg. ZANOTTI, aggiunto che, dal tenore del lasciapassare di cui era stato munito il militare (redatto in lingua italiana ed inglese e contenente un invito alle unità italiane ed alleate di prestare assistenza) dal fatto che nessuna preoccupazione era stata presa per lo sconfinamento, oltre che della personale conoscenza che ho del capitano, escludo che allo ZANOTTI sia stato suggerito di attraversare le linee.

3°) - Resta peraltro la mancanza commessa dal capitano Salvati nell'inviare di iniziativa un motociclista nel territorio delle Armate, con lettere da recapitare alle famiglie dei militari, in violazione di disposizioni che avrebbe dovuto osservare, a costo di far tacere ogni altro pur nobile sentimento.

Pertanto propongo che al capitano Salvati vengano inflitti giorni 10 di A.R. con la seguente motivazione.

ben comprensibile ansia sulla sorte delle loro famiglie, duramente provate dalla guerra e delle quali da oltre un anno non avevano notizie. Condizione questa resa più penosa dal confronto con altri compagni che, per aver combattuto nelle vicinanze delle loro case, erano riusciti a prendere subito contatto con i propri congiunti.

Rispondo alla richiesta di spiegazioni di codesto Comando in merito al viaggio del motociclista cap.magg.Zanotti Giuseppe, cl.1920-distr.Modena:

1°)- Nell'ottobre scorso diversi militari di questo gruppo avevano le loro famiglie nel territorio allora appena liberato e che io già ritenevo libero. Lo stato d'animo di questi valorosi soldati che avevano generosamente combattuto e che nel settembre, quando già si avvicinava l'ora della liberazione delle loro case, erano stati arretrati in Campania, era particolarmente depresso: tanto più che le notizie di devastazioni nelle zone di combattimento li poneva in ansia sulla sorte del loro congiunti di cui nulla sapevano da oltre un anno. Ho ritenuto che fosse cosa della più grande importanza, per sostenere il morale dei soldati(e non solo di quelli direttamente interessati, ma anche di tutti coloro che avevano la famiglia in territorio occupato, ossia della assoluta maggioranza dei miei dipendenti), dimostrare un fattivo interessamento, per assumere dirette informazioni sulle famiglie e recare a queste la notizie dei militari.

2°)- Per questo ho ritenuto di poter inviare un motociclista con l'incarico di raggiungere diverse località, recapitare alle famiglie le lettere dei militari ed ottenere le risposte. Ho munito il motociclista di una autorizzazione da me firmata nella quale era tracciato un itinerario di massima (Cesena-Pianoro di Bologna- Firenze-Vado di Setta) ed in cui pregavo i reparti alleati e italiani di fornire ogni assistenza al militare; il permesso era redatto in lingua italiana ed inglese, sicchè era ben lontana da me ogni intenzione di fare un sotterfugio o di sfuggire al controllo delle autorità alleate.

3°)- Il motociclista era stato formalmente avvertito che, prima di raggiungere le varie località, doveva assumere prudenti informazioni presso i comandi alleati e italiani, per evitare, non solo lo sconfinamento, ma anche di cacciarsi troppo alla linea di combattimento; infatti, nell'interesse stesso della sua missione, oltre che per troppo ovvie ragioni, doveva evitarsi il pericolo di una sua cattura da parte del nemico. Ciò, se fosse necessario, sarebbe confermato dal fatto che lo Zanotti non aveva altro documento che il lasciapassare che ho detto sopra, in lingua italiana ed inglese e che, a quanto lo stesso Zanotti riferisce, egli si presentò più volte ai comandi inglesi, ricevendo sempre (perrino da quello che precedette il suo fermo) la migliore accoglienza, viveri e piena simpatia comprensione.

4°)- Il permesso - ripeto - era firmato da me: escludo che della cosa fosse al corrente il sig. ten.col. Giaccone Lesandro, il quale come noto a codesto comando nell'ottobre scorso, era stato designato al primo gruppo, ma in effetto non aveva mai assunto tale comando, prima perchè in licenza, poi per malattia. La firma del sig. colonnello Giaccone non può apparire, nei documenti esibiti dal Zanotti, se non forse nel tesserino di riconoscimento.

La firma del sig. colonnello viaccone non può apparire, nei documenti esibiti dal Zanotti, se non forse nel telex di riconoscimento, in ogni caso anteriore all'ottobre e rilasciato dal detto colonnello viaccone 1944 nella qualità di comandante il reggimento, qualità che rivestì fino al 20 settembre: il nome dello stesso ufficiale può apparire (sebbene non lo ricordi con certezza) nel timbro in calce al lasciapassare da me rilasciato perché in ottobre io firmavo per il colonnello viaccone, comandante titolare del gruppo.

Attention of Lieut. Col. Morse

I have received a memorandum from SIM, General Staff, Rome, in which my attention is drawn to following facts:

- Some of our officers who were travelling in V Army area on duty have been stopped by Military Police and detained although travelling with documents bearing the approval and seal of proper authorities, such as G-2, AFHQ.
- Altho in possession of these documents, their vehicles have been searched and rations of travelling personnel have been confiscated; even their luggage has been opened and contents indiscriminately put on the ground.
- Their vehicles have not been refueled.

The memorandum goes on to say that nothing of the sort happens in area controlled by R Army, where every assistance is extended to our personnel, and a letter is attached indicating what kind of document is used by our officers in compliance with Allied request.

I believe that above lamented episodes could be prevented by informing M.P.'s at traffic control points that our personnel travelling on duty is entitled to assistance when furnished with proper documents; I attach translation of letter concerning these.

I would be grateful if you could do something to ensure smoothing the path for our personnel.

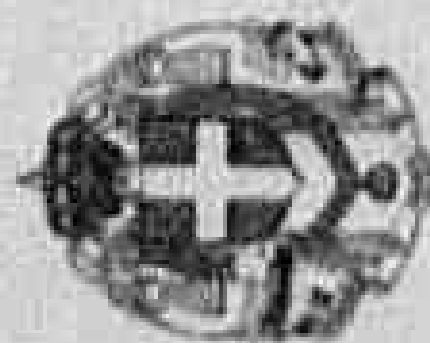

SUBJECT: Passes

It is pointed out that the Tailor Shop of the "TIGLI ITALIANI ALL'ESTERO of TOR DE QUINTO" is a civilian enterprise that is now working for the Italian Military administration. This firm, therefore, does not employ military personnel but exclusively civilians.

The personnel mentioned in our request for passes 3664/1/RI dated 21 Dec 44 were to withdraw from FLORENCE 3 quintals of glue, 3 quintals of leather and various quantities of nails for boot repairs. This material was ordered during the previous visit to FLORENCE by the same personnel who were in possession of passes from MMIA dated 4 Dec 44.

Said personnel would take advantage of the return journey from FLORENCE to endeavour to locate weaving mills and cloth manufacturers in the ROMAGNA MARCHE and UMBRIA Districts (especially at BORGO S. LORENZO and CATTOLICA) to whom the wool, allotted by this Ministry to make cloth to be delivered to the a/n shop to replace cloth used in the making of uniforms, is to be delivered.

It is for the above reasons that we now renew our request for passes contained in letter 3664/1/RI dated 21 12 44.

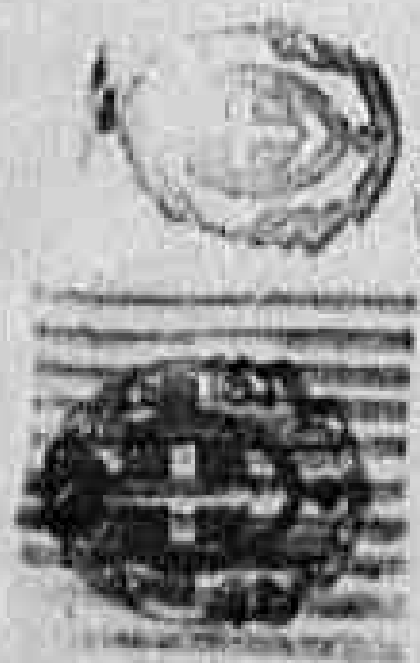

2. The present position is that whereas 5 Army agreed to Italian Air Force agencies being established in forward areas to deal with and dispose of Italian Air Force personnel, it has not so far been possible to reach such an agreement with 8 Army.

3. This Sub Commission considers that it is essential and urgent that proper agencies be established in 8 Army forward areas in order to deal with Italian Air Force Personnel.

4. It therefore suggests that Lt/Col. Felice SANTINI and Lt. Rodolfo VENTURINI, both of the Stato Maggiore Regia Aeronautica - Ufficio "I" (Personnel Intelligence), be authorised to proceed to 8 Army H.Q. in order to discuss the matter and decide on the organisation to be established within the area in question.

5. For your information Lt/Col. SANTINI, A.O.C. Ufficio "I", is well known to this Sub Commission and was recently awarded the bronze star medal for meritorious services in support of combat operations by Gen. M.W. CLARK. Lt. VENTURINI, English speaking, has been closely connected with the Air Intelligence Section of this Sub Commission since October 1943. Both are known to CSIDC and SIM.

6. As the matter is urgent it is suggested that authority for the above to proceed be sent by signal.
