SUBJECT: Relaxation of Security of Information.

TO: All Concerned.

Pending revisions of War Department Circular Number 236, dated 3 August 1945, Release of Military Information, and Army Regulations 380-5, Safeguarding Military Information; and in accord with the Joint Chiefs of Staff action, relaxations of the security of information on the following are authorized:

a. Information for publication may be released concerning:

GSO 1

GSO 2 (Ops)

GSO 2 (SD)

GSO 2 (WA)

GSO 2 (L)

GSO 3 (SD)

GSO 3 (Ordn)

GSO 3 (H)

- (1) Movements of troops anywhere including the arrivals and departures of named individuals and units, Army aircraft and vessels.
- (2) Location, composition, strength, organization, armament and equipment of units within the theater. Except upon specific approval of the Theater Commander no information will be disclosed concerning classified or highly specialized units of equipment.
- (3) War material production, processes and rates of manufacture, except information relating to classified products, methods and processes.
- (4) Assembly, storage and location of war materials except classified items.
- (5) Facilities for communication and transportation in Theaters and Zones of the Interior.

b. Exceptions to the above are as follows:

- (1) Information pertaining to occupation operations relating to Japan and occupational unit or units taking part in such operations will remain as classified information and will not be released until unit or units are in the territory that they are to occupy, unless an announcement is made earlier by the Supreme Allied Commander for the Allied Powers.

- (2) Military information regarding past operations, tactics, intelligence, methods and equipment which is classified will remain classified and will not be released until it is declassified by proper authority under Joint Chiefs of Staff Directives and War and Navy Department Regulations.
- (3) Information relating to classified Signal equipment, cryptography or cryptanalysis will not be disclosed.

SUBJECT: Security After Defeat of Japan.

TO: All Concerned.

1. Attention is called to the fact that, although the war has been won with the final surrender of Japan and therefore security regulations can be generally relaxed, it is imperative that it be kept in mind that there are matters which will still require application of security measures.
2. Such matters are those on which information has not been already relaxed or is not in the future released.
 - a. Details of special methods of deceiving the enemy and enemy wireless traffic interception.
 - b. (1) Methods of and organization of intelligence and counter intelligence including sabotage, political warfare, escape organizations and the work of agents with resistance groups and on intelligence duties.
 - (2) Premises, locations, formations, personnel, training and equipment and communication system used in such activities.
 - (3) Resulting achievements of such activities.
 - c. Cipher information (those of foreign governments included).
 - d. Other than in the normal course of overseas drafts and reliefs, troop movements to airport or seaport of embarkation and thence overseas.
 - e. Location of vital military material stocks other than those open to public view.
 - f. Experimental establishments and scientific research and the problems which are being investigated for service use (trials included).
 - g. New equipment and weapons.
 - h. Technical details and performance of army aircraft weapons and equipment (operational employment included), manufacturing processes and production methods.
 - i. Extent of information of ex-enemy equipment, weapons or tactics. (Also any research or development relating thereto.)

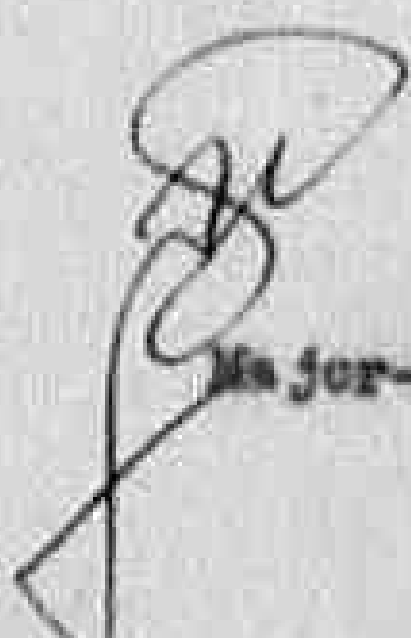

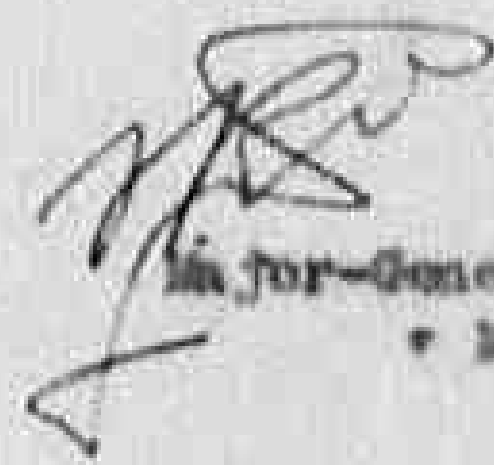

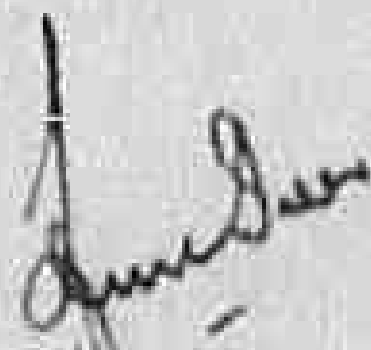

SUBJECT: Classes of Germans and Italians Who Should be Detained in the Event of Surrender of German Armed Forces

TO: Supreme Allied Commander
Allied Forces
APO 512

1. It is recommended that the following classes of Germans and Italians should be detained for security reasons in the event of surrender of the German Armed Forces in Italy:

a. Germans

(1) All SS Police Units. These include some 10 SS Police Regiments, estimated strength 12 - 15,000, all Kasernierte Polizei units, estimated strength 1000. The Divisional or Army Military Police units should not come in this category, as they will be needed to assist in maintaining order. All German officers and NCO's of 1 Italian Waffen SS Division and the German cadre personnel of 24 SS Mountain Division at present in North East Italy should be put into Camps. Estimated total, 1,000 to 1,500.

(2) Any troops of the Brandenburg Regiment (sabotage troops and trained in subversive activities) and Spreng Kommandos (demolition troops). Estimated total, 1,000.

(3) All members of German secret intelligence and secret police organizations; viz, ABWEHR, Sicherheitsdienst, GESTAPO, (including Grenz Polizei) and Geheime Feld Polizei, and any other office, branch, or department of the Reichssicherheitshauptamt not already specified, and any special units or organizations under its command, many intelligence personnel at Division Headquarters level and above will probably have to be detained at a later stage. Approximately 600.

(4) All NSFO's (Nazi Commissars). Estimated 100.

(5) Members of Propaganda Companies including the Propaganda Staff ROTZ and 699 Pz Propaganda Company. Approximately 100.

(6) A certain number of senior officers and General Staff Officers known to be ardent Nazis. The placing of these in detention could probably wait until disarmament has been completed. Approximately 250.

(7) All Germans who are known to be War Criminals or who may be classed as such after the surrender. Estimated 100.

(8) Marine Einsatz Kommando 80 and Meeres-Kampfer Group of the K.d.K (Kommando der Everbände) (estimated total 100).

(9) Certain personnel, as indicated, of the following organizations should be taken into custody provided that they can be spared or as soon as they can be replaced:

MSKK (Nazi Kraftfahrkorps): Officers of the rank of Staffelfuhrer and above.
TEHO (Technische Nothilfe): Officers of the rank of Landesfuhrer and above.
RAD (Reichsarbeitsdienst): Officers of the rank of Arbeitsfuhrer and above.
TODT Organization: All German personnel.
(Estimated total, 1000).

The above does not include parachute troops of which it is estimated there are 40,000, or German officers and NCO's from Armed Forces between the ages of 18 and 25, the latter amounting to approximately 60-70,000 of which 10,000 are officers. Both of these classes of Germans form a possible source, in the first place, for potential guerillas for activities in the establishment of a National Redoubt and in the latter class, they form the most likely source of any underground revival of National Socialism. Since there is no positive evidence that the groups as a whole intend to operate along the lines indicated, it is suggested that in view of the numbers involved, that these two classes be treated at least initially as the ordinary German formation unless evidence comes to light which indicates their intention to continue or revive resistance. In this case they must be detained pending disposition. In any case we must be prepared to take the necessary action to implement this.

b. Italians. A large number of Italians, especially those most incriminated in the eyes of their compatriots, will either attempt to fade into obscurity or else be liquidated by local partisans. Any Italians of the following classes who surrender should be detained for security reasons:

(1) All Italian SS Officers, NCO's and troops, in particular members of 1 Italian Waffen SS Division. Approximately 20,000.

(2) Members of Black Brigades and local anti-partisan units, including TAGLIAMENTO Regiment.

(3) Members of "M" Battalions, especially members of the affiliated ARDITI Battalions which are found in most of the large cities.

(4) Troops of the "Republican" FOLGORE Regiment (FOLGORE Battalion and NEMBO Battalion), and of the VEGI Battalion, the MP Battalion and GAMA Group of 10 FLOTAS. Approximately 4,000.

(5) All personnel of Fascist Training Schools and Anti-Partisan Schools. Approximately 3,000.

(6) Tokon senior officers of Italian Republican Divisions.

Total number of Italians, up to 90,000. However, it is considered that a large proportion will be liquidated or go into hiding.

- c. Neither German G/F or Naval personnel have been considered.
- 2. Estimated total of personnel to be detained initially:
 - a. Germans 15,000 - 18,000
 - b. Italians up to 90,000
105,000 - 108,000
 - c. Total does not include parachute troops or 18 to 25 year age group included in paragraph above.
- 3. Although initially none of the above classes will be classified as prisoners of war, it is recommended that normal prisoner of war channels be used for evacuation, administration, interrogation, etc. This would greatly aid in arriving at final disposition of the above classes of Germans and Italians, and of selecting those who may be declared as prisoners of war by Supreme Allied Commander.
- 4. The above recommendations should not be included in the instructions issued by Commanding General, 15th Army Group, to Commander-in-Chief, South West, but should be issued as a part of secret instructions to the Armies implementing.
- 5. Copies of this letter have been sent to Fifth and Eighth Armies in order to facilitate their planning.

Although it is agreed that the categories of German and Italian surrendered personnel mentioned in paragraph 1a and b, of the basic communication, with the exception of parachute troops, may need to be segregated and placed in confinement, it is not possible to pass all disarmed surrendered troops through normal prisoner of war channels as appears to be indicated in paragraph 3 of your letter for the following reasons:

- a. the cage space in ITALY is totally inadequate to deal with the numbers
 - b. the large amount of movement involved in sending them back to base cages (LEGHORN for United States captures and T.RANTO for British captures), and then returning them to the North of ITALY after screening, is unjustified and undesirable;
 - c. the difficulties created by having in the same cage, prisoners of war on one scale of rations and system of documentation, and disbanded troops on a different scale, would lead to endless confusion and disension.
2. Consequently, on receipt by you of the order of battle of the enemy surrendered forces, troops of the categories mentioned in paragraph 1a and b of your letter, may be segregated in your discretion as far as your resources allow, having regard to the policy that surrendered enemy forces should be left with sufficient key personnel to enable them to be self-administering. Notice should then be given of the desire to evacuate to PW cages as outlined in paragraph 16c of AMHQ letter, file IS 323/061 GDS-O, dated 3 April 1945, subject: "Occupation of North East Italy", relating to recalcitrant enemy personnel.
3. From information received from the German emissaries, it is likely that the numbers who require segregation will be somewhat in excess of the estimate in paragraph 2a of your letter. The estimate given by the German emissaries for German SS and Police is 57,454. On the other hand, your estimate of Italian troops that require segregation appears to be in excess of the actual numbers, as the German emissaries gave a total figure of 90,000 for all Italian troops, and it is considered that not more than 20 per cent of these will be classified as recalcitrant.
4. Personnel not in the categories mentioned but who are considered dangerous to security should be treated in the same way as indicated in paragraph 2, above.
5. Detailed instructions on the treatment of surrendered personnel are in the course of preparation and will be issued shortly.

SUBJECT: CI/Security Instruction (JUSTRIA) No. 2
Vetting/Screening of Allied Employees in JUSTRIA.

TO: All Concerned.

1. All holders of Public Office and all persons, except serving members of the Allied Armed Forces, who are employed directly or indirectly by units, staffs or branches of formations of the Allied Forces, the Military Government, the Allied Control Commission, or associated units or agencies, and whether or not they are paid from public funds, will be subjected to Security/CI enquiry prior to employment. Examples of some of the types of persons included in this instruction are:

a. Persons the nature of whose work may give them access to information or premises occupied by the Allied Forces, Military Government or Allied Control administration, eg, contractors, interpreters, mess waiters, clerks, etc.

b. Officials who held positions in the following grades of the German Civil Service:

The Political Civil Service	(Der Politische Dienst)
The Upper Service	(Der Gehobene Dienst)
The Higher Service	(Der Hohe Dienst)

and whose services it is desired to retain. Also officials who are later engaged in corresponding positions.

c. The only permitted exceptions to the above examples are casual or unskilled labourers whose work does not give them access to information or premises occupied by the Allied Forces, the Military Government or the Allied Control administration. In such cases, the foreman or ganger only will be subjected to Security/CI enquiry and will be held responsible for the bona fides and conduct of the workers under his control.

d. The types mentioned above are neither exhaustive nor mutually exclusive. They are intended to indicate only the type of person who will be submitted to a Security/CI check. Doubtful cases will be referred to the nearest Field Security/CIC Headquarters.

e. When, for urgent reasons, it is desired to employ individuals in essential services, before completion of CI screening, authority must first be obtained from the local FS/CIC who may, in such exceptional cases, authorize employment provisionally pending CI clearance.

2. Procedure.

a. All Allied units or agencies desiring to employ, or to retain in employment, any individual falling into the category outlined in paragraph 1 will make use of the FLDSOGEN (PERSONAL QUESTIONNAIRE) FORM (Specimen at Appendix 'A') and the EMPLOYMENT CERTIFICATE FORM (Specimen at Appendix 'B'), which are obtainable at HQ Public Safety and PS/CIC offices. These will be dealt with as follows:

- (1) Part I of the Questionnaire will be completed by the proposed employee under supervision of the Allied unit or agency concerned.
- (2) Part II, stating clearly the specific nature of the proposed employment, will be completed by an Allied Officer of the unit or agency.
- (3) The name, address and identity card number of the individual and the designation of the unit or agency will be entered on the Employment Certificate.
- (4) The Questionnaire, with the Employment Certificate attached, will then be forwarded to the nearest Public Safety Officer.

b. If no objection is raised by local Security/CI and HQ Public Safety authorities, the unit or agency will in due course receive from the local HQ Public Safety Officer a completed Employment Certificate countersigned and stamped by the local Field Security Section or CIC Detachment. This will be handed to the employee and be retained by him for the duration of his employment. Should his employment be terminated at any time, it is the responsibility of the unit or agency employing him to withdraw the Employment Certificate and return it to the nearest HQ Public Safety Officer without delay, with the notification that the individual's services have been dispensed with. Should a change be proposed in the nature of the employment, the Employment Certificate will similarly first be forwarded to the nearest HQ PSO together with details of the proposed new employment. It will be endorsed and returned.

c. Should there be OBJECTION to the employment of an individual, the unit or agency will be notified to this effect by the HQ PSO. In such cases the individual will in no circumstances be employed. The reason for rejection of the application will NOT be communicated to the person concerned.

3. All units and agencies will bear in mind that the issue of an Employment Certificate countersigned by PS/CIC does not guarantee the security reliability of the holder. It is an indication that there is no present known objection to his employment in the capacity shown. All employees are subject to immediate dismissal should adverse information concerning them come to light at any time.

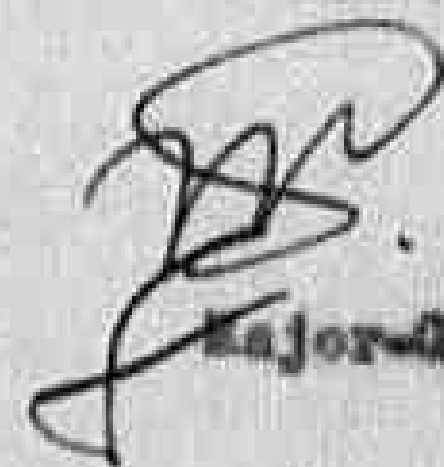

It is felt that the Ministry of War may be interested in the following extracts from a report by an officer of MIA after a recent tour of the forward areas.

(a) Friuli Combat Group

The performance of the Intelligence Section was very satisfactory; comparable with that of a British Division.

The chief trouble is communications in getting the information back in time to be of use, but the 'I' personnel are fully aware of the urgency of getting fresh information back and to the flanks.

The enemy Order of Battle was kept very well indeed, quite as good as a British Div and such useful identification was passed back to Corps. For example, the 'I' Section on being informed that there were 2 dead Germans in a minefield on their own initiative retrieved the bodies and obtained a very interesting identification.

The Group from the Commander downwards is becoming quite alive to the usefulness of Intelligence work. For example, in spite of rumours, unconfirmed, of atrocities committed on captured Group 1 soldiers by the enemy they continued to take prisoners and hand them over for interrogation.

The Italian Intelligence L.O.'s of the Nucleo 'I' have been extremely useful. They already have experience of British Intelligence methods.

Friuli carried out a most gallant action against prepared positions across the SENIO.

(b) FLORENCE Combat Group

The performance of the Intelligence Section was very satisfactory; comparable with that of a British Division.

The chief trouble is communications in getting the information back in time to be of use, but the 'I' personnel are fully aware of the urgency of getting fresh information back and to the flanks.

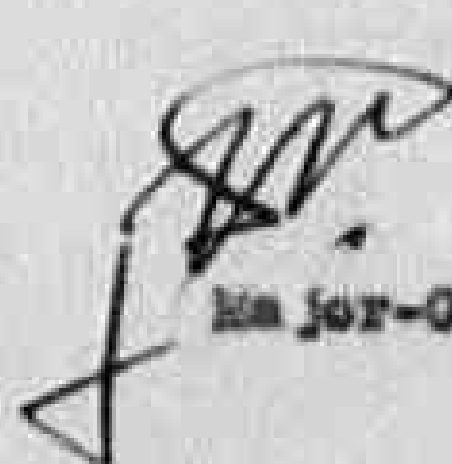

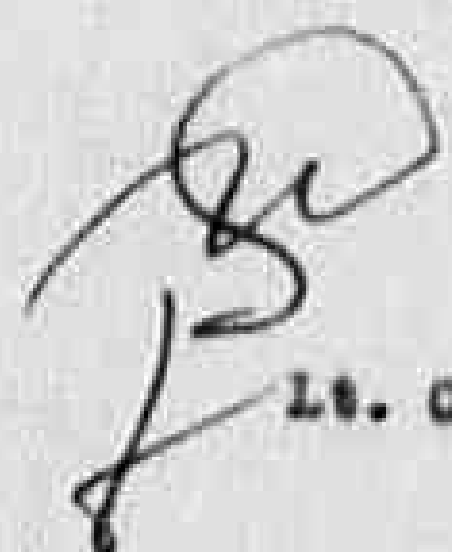

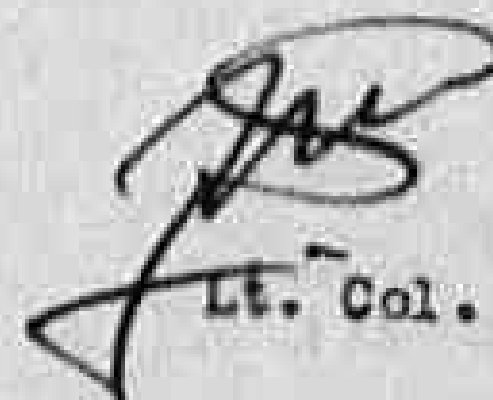

1. The British Training Area of Vigna di Valle - Brasciano - is a strictly prohibited military area. The enclosure is well sign-posted and instructions have been issued to all concerned prohibiting entry to all unauthorized persons.
2. Reports have been received at this HQ which indicate that Italian military personnel are not observing Security Regulations affecting this area and considerable strain has been imposed on F.S. personnel and Security Guards responsible for its safeguarding.
3. Orders have been issued to all guards that any unauthorized persons of any nationality attempting to enter this area will be fired on and any persons suspected of loitering with the intent to gain information are liable to be arrested or detained.

No. 4849023 Pte SIBLEY Walter of the CHESHIRE REGT att. RAC was attacked in BRACCIANO at about 2030 hrs on the 20 Mar 46 while walking on the main road from BRACCIANO to VIGNA DI VALLE, about 50 yds after crossing the bridge.

He was tackled from behind by an Italian Cpl and 2 other Italian soldiers hit over the head whilst facing his attackers, gagged and left lying on the ground. He was robbed of his money, watch, one left boot and two passes one of which is a special admittance pass to this area.

PS was informed in the morning of 21 Mar 45 and considered it necessary to investigate this case immediately.

Feeling was running very high in this camp and PS had reason to fear serious trouble in BRACCIANO with grave consequences to the relations between British and Italian troops.

PS proceeded to BRACCIANO and contacted the Adjutant of the 152 Italian Artillery Regt. PS pointed out that the British Officers and Other Ranks are most annoyed about the occurrence and that the culprits should be looked for and severely punished. PS added that the matter would be reported to higher authority if NO satisfaction could be given.

PS was accompanied by the victim Pte SISLEY, Sgt HORNER A. who is in charge of the CHESHIRE guards and Sgt IGGULDEN S.F. These NCOs knew the culprit whose name was given as ANGELO or ANGELO who was found in the Military Prohibited Area on or about 17 Feb 45 and escorted to his camp in BRACCIANO. He was also known of trying to mix with members of the CHESHIRE Regt in BRACCIANO.

PS accompanied by the Adjutant the victim and above mentioned NCOs proceeded to the camp concerned. 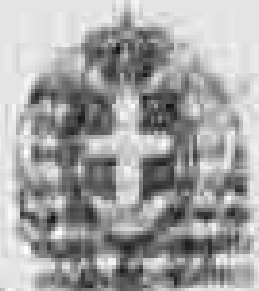

HANDLING OF JAPANESE INTELLIGENCE

I. Object.

1. To provide general guidance for units or agencies in the Mediterranean Theatre who may secure intelligence on Japan or Japanese activities which is of operational importance to the Allied Military Authorities responsible for the conduct of the war in the Pacific.
2. It must be borne in mind that there is no special Japanese Section, as such, in this Theatre. Units and agencies will therefore adhere strictly to existing channels and methods for handling enemy intelligence in dealing with Japanese personalities, documents or other relevant data.

II. Targets.

3. Japanese Intelligence targets may include individuals, mater-
documents or document locations. The preparation of folders for such targets either in ITALY or in AUSTRIA will continue as at present to be prepared by G-2 (Intelligence Objectives Sub-Section).
4. Agencies which are interested in specific Japanese targets will submit them to G-2 (IOSS). Similarly, intelligence agencies now functioning in this Theatre will ensure that relevant information on possible targets is passed to G-2 (IOSS).

III. Interrogation.

5. To obtain the fullest value from the exploitation of Japanese targets, it will be necessary to interrogate individuals including Japanese subjects. It is likely that such personnel will speak either German or Italian and that present interrogation facilities such as CSBIC will be adequate.
6. Japanese nationals who speak only their native language and are considered likely subjects for interrogation will be evacuated to CSBIC and the 1st of 8.

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6. Japanese nationals who speak only their native language and are considered likely subjects for interrogation will be evacuated to CSBIC and the A. C. of S., G-2, AMIC notified. If Japanese Naval Personnel are captured, Chief of Intelligence Staff, Mediterranean will also be notified.

IV. Documents.

7. It is the responsibility of all Intelligence Staffs to seek out and safeguard all documents dealing with Japan whether these are encountered by chance or as a result of planned target exploitation.

8. Documents or other information relating to Japan and Japanese activities in Europe will be sent back through central Intelligence channels direct to G-2 Documents Section, Allied Force Headquarters. In the event of this proving impracticable, either to their bulk, conditions, etc., A. C. of S., G-2, Allied Force Headquarters will be notified in order that appropriate action may be taken.

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9. Japanese documents deemed to be of technical, tactical or strategic importance will be forwarded by G-2 Documents Section to Washington or London depending on which is the prime research authority on the subject concerned.

10. These instructions do not supersede or modify the general directive regarding the handling of enemy documents contained in Allied Force Headquarters Intelligence Instruction Number 38 dated 1 June 1944 which is intended to serve as a guide for the disposition of German documents captured under normal battle conditions.

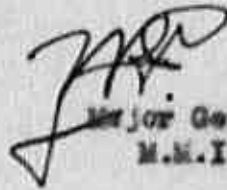

1. A report received from SER Sigs 53 B.L.U. indicates that a serious lack of telephone security exists in the Folgore Combat Gr. Many breaches of security are committed on main speech circuits and officers fail to avail themselves of Fullerphone or W/T links when dealing with subjects of a secret nature.

An extract from the report reads as follows :-

"The standard of telephone security is very bad. An Italian 'G' officer has said he preferred to telephone his orders and sitreps rather than have them sent on the Fullerphone. In forward areas the telephone is used with an alarming lack of security. Much of this is due to indigenous vulnerability but efforts are being made to check this tendency. There is also a tendency to resort to 'phonograms' wherever possible even where Fullerphone or W/T links exist. This is bad security apart from the resultant congestion on main speech circuits."

2. In view of the above immediate steps must be taken to rectify the position and bring to the notice of all officers handling information of a secret and operational nature the grave risk involved in failing to make use of secure means of communication and the correct security procedure.
