1. The Allied authorities have for some time had under consideration the question of the demobilisation of the older age groups of the Italian Army.

2. It has now been decided that in view of the reductions in the numbers of service troops now taking place and likely to continue, this demobilisation may be gradually effected, under the following conditions which apply to the whole Italian Army.

3. The Ministry of War will be responsible :-

- (a) That all Italian Units for which disbandment instructions have not been issued will be kept up to authorised working strength at all times.
- (b) That replacements for all demobilised personnel are delivered to the unit before such personnel are demobilised.
- (c) That replacements are fully trained to perform the duties called for by War Establishment and to the satisfaction of the employing Allied Commander.
- (d) That personnel in any particular age group will NOT be demobilised until approval for the demobilisation of that age group has been given by MMIA.

4. Under the above conditions you are authorised already to demobilise the 1914 and 1915 and older classes, and are hereby authorised to effect the demobilisation of the 1916 class between 15 Sept and 15 October.

5. The future demobilisation of groups 1917 et. seq., will be considered by MMIA on your advice and in the light of the speed with which units are to be disbanded, and the progress of demobilisation already authorised.

2. It has now been decided that in view of the reductions in the numbers of service troops now taking place and likely to continue, this demobilisation may be gradually effected, under the following conditions which apply to the whole Italian Army.

4. Under the above conditions you are authorised already to demobilise the 1914 and 1915 and older classes, and are hereby authorised to effect the demobilisation of the 1916 class between 15 Sept and 15 October.

5. The future demobilisation of groups 1917 et. seq., will be considered by MIA on your advice and in the light of the speed with which units are to be disbanded, and the progress of demobilisation already authorised.

6. Progress Reports on the demobilisation of each class will be sent to MIA on the 7th and 21st of each month showing the number of men by age groups :-

in each Adm Div, Combat Group, etc as on the preceding 1st and 15th of the month.

7. You may give such publicity to these concessions as you think advisable in the interest of discipline and morale.

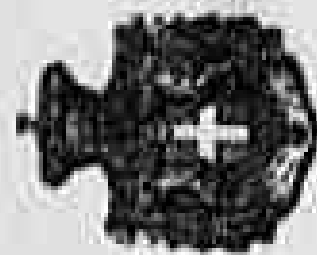

1. W.e.f. today, 1 July 45, the Security Control Line is operative along the Western bdy of VENEZIA GIULIA.
2. The following procedure for Italian military personnel who wish to visit VENEZIA GIULIA will be strictly observed :-
 - (a) Those living in VENEZIA GIULIA WEST of the MORGAN Line may visit their families provided they are unarmed and are in possession of an AMG pass.
 - (b) Those with homes EAST of the MORGAN and/or POJA Lines will equally be unarmed, be in possession of an AMG pass, countersigned by the JUGOSLAV Mission with this HQ, and must wear civilian clothes.
3. Applications for passes will be forwarded to this HQ.
4. You are requested to ensure that these concessions are fully explained by all Italian Commanders to their officers and men: it is stressed that a failure to observe regulations of this nature in the past has led to unfortunate incidents from which the Italians have become the first to suffer.
