The attached letter 6/35/1 dated the 6th Dec.45 sets out the history of Lt.Principe in regard to his service with British Units and the use his private car was put to. His own tyres, which became worn, were replaced by British Workshops with salvaged Jeep tyres - see attached.

Mr Principe was released from the Italian Army on the 4th Dec.45. and since then uses his car in a private capacity.

Approximately a week ago he was stopped by American MP's on the road to Naples and his car taken from him with the explanation that it would be returned to him on the production of a Permit from the Transportation Sub Commission. He was able to get a temporary Permit from this Department at Naples which is attached and with which he received his car back.

It is now requested that a Permanent Permit be issued in respect of these tyres.

1. For your information and necessary action the a/n was Italian liaison officer on the staff of Eighth Army Nucleo "I": subsequently with other Allied units and headquarters.

2. He was posted on 11 Nov 43 to 46 Division, then in 10 Corps, and was attached by 138 Bde to 6 Lincoln with whom he served until 7 Jan 44 when he was wounded in action with the battalion in the R. Rapido action.

3. After 3 months in hospital he served with 10 Corps and Eighth Army until he was posted to Land Forces Sub-Commission A.C. (M.M.I.A.) in Jan 45. He was released from the Italian Army on 4 Dec 45.

4. Whilst with 10 Corps his vehicle, Fiat Ballilla 9829 FO, was employed by the British Army. After several months on active service and in action the tyres, which had become worn, were removed by British workshops and replaced by them with salvaged tyres.

The attention of all officers is drawn to RAAC Routine Order No. XIII dated 14 Dec 45 which reads as follows:-

1. The War Office has decided further to amend Release Regulations para 326 to permit voluntary deferment of release for a period of six months instead of for 1 or 2 years or until general demobilization as heretofore for officers WOs S/Sgts and Sgts of all arms except ATs and VADs.
2. Volunteers may be accepted at once.
3. The conditions of deferment for six months are identical with those now operative for DV (1) and DV (2).
4. Eligibility is at present restricted to personnel in A/S Groups up to and including 35.
5. The documentation for deferment for six months is identical with that already notified for DV (1) and DV (2) except that the prefix will be DV (6).
6. The War Office is considering extending this scheme to certain specialist and tradesmen below the rank of Sgt, but no definite instructions have been received as yet.
