1. Attached correspondence for SCHEME of this Headquarters is passed for information and action.
2. It is obvious from figures that 80% of demands are not being received by the Italian Divisions.
3. If 80% demands are ^{not} in the ^{real} District then it is felt there must be some mistake in distribution.
4. It is appreciated that probably British Units are given priority, but it is pointed out in view of the Allied Commitment to service the exItalian Combat Force some hastening effort should be made to ensure that they receive adequate spares.
5. From the attached correspondence it is seen that the W/S will cease to function within a very short time for lack of spares.

1. The situation in regards to assemblies has become critical in the FOLGORE and FRIULI ME W/shops.
2. Over a hundred vehicles are in the FOLGORE W/shops awaiting replacements of engine assemblies, and the W/S will shortly be at a standstill if the release of engines does not improve.
3. The stock of engines held to date is 12 of which 5 are of a type not required at the moment. The remaining engines are sufficient to enable the W/S to function for four days.
4. Attached is a list of FOLGORE ME W/S weekly demands for the last six months. Specimen pro-forma enclosed. It can be seen that the supply is out of all proportion to the demand and not in accordance with the information given in D.D.M.E. letter R.E.M.E. 6001/1 dated 31 Oct. 45. Para 2 (b).
5. Further, attached is a list of engines received by the FRIULI W/S of the last six months: it may be seen that the FRIULI W/S has received 362 engines as to 119 by the FOLGORE W/S and yet the total demand of FRIULI W/S is only half of the FOLGORE W/S. This is not understood.
6. The FRIULI W/S is short of engine assemblies (list of stock attached) and will also be at a standstill shortly, but this apparently due to a ~~misunderstanding~~ misunderstanding which resulted in failure to demand new assemblies for over a month, nevertheless the W/S will cease to function unless engines are received in the near future. It is requested that this situation be made known to QRD as the W/S cannot function under the present circumstances.

1. The following outline on the procedure for obtaining replacement engines is given to ensure that all concerned are aware of the correct channels for hastening action when required.
 2. (a) Wksp places demand for engines required on ADOS/DADOS of the Area or Formation.
 - (b) ADOS/DADOS consolidate total requirements for the Area and place a bulk demand on DDOS 2 District.
 - (c) DDOS 2 District consolidates total requirements within the District and places a bulk demand for the District requirements on A.F.H.Q.
 - (d) AFHQ releases engines to DDOS 2 District who then signals 557 BOD the distribution of the engines released. (present releases cover approx 80% of demands)
 - (e) 557 BOD then despatch engines as requested by DDOS- normally to ADOS/DADOS of the Area or Formation but on occasions direct to the Wksp.
 3. (a) The time lag from the date of the Wksp placing the demand until the receipt of the engine by the Wksp is between 5 and 6 weeks, where the full procedure detailed in Para 2 is required. The major part of this time is taken up in the transporting of the engine from the Depot to the Wksp.
 - (b) For most of the common makes however ADOS/DADOS hold a small pool and can satisfy demands in much less than the 5-6 week period.
In the case of the ~~uncommon~~ uncommon types and for types in short supply the full procedure may be required.
 4. It will be seen from the above that hastening action when required should be taken by you in conjunction with ADOS/DADOS of the Area or Formation and that you should maintain close liaison with him in respect of priority of issue between Wksps.
 5. Further it is pointed out that when visiting wksps and units the engine holdings should be reviewed to ensure that engines urgently required by other shops are not being held surplus to immediate requirements.

1. Ref your C/Off letter 2 Nov 45, para 4. Instructions have not yet been received concerning evacuation of "A" and "B" vehicles and equipment, i.e., "War", small arms, instruments, radio etc. Up to time of writing, this branch has instructed MUL Div to retain all MUL equipts at HQs.

2. Ref your C/Off dated 16 Nov 45, which states that Directive 20.2 will not be implemented until "Line" orders receive it.

(a) It is noted in para 6 of the above Directive, that spare parts in the case of Allied vehicles will frequently have to be obtained by cannibalisation. It is considered best to institute cannibalisation amongst Italian units at this juncture would only create a precedent entirely opposed to all allied efforts towards eradicating this wanton practice, leading to an alarming wastage figure of equipts.

(b) -resumably an alternative plan to cannibalisation within the units, would be a Central Vehicle Park, at possible cost. Territorial Command would be responsible for spare parts. Whilst breakin' down would prove to units within Territorial Command. This Vehicle Park would prove a heavy task, as there are no repeat MUL Workshops capable, at the time of writing, of carrying out third line repair to allied vehicles in this Territorial Command. Presumably the procedure and formicous of an Italian MUL Div for allied vehicles will be recommended to HQ. Italian Ministry of War.

3. It is understood from our QM branch that according to DOS letter ref 7000 dated 8 Nov 45, passed to us for action, that a scaling of replacement parts for vehicles and equipts of Italian MUL Divs is to be implemented on a basis of twelve months supply. It is not necessary for this branch to point out that the time lag in organising such a project is 36 months. Italian Stores Depot would require at least three months concerted effort by both Italian and French personnel. For these reasons alone some interim plan of supply for replacement parts and reconditioned assemblies is essential if the MULs are to be maintained in a mobile condition.

would be carried out by untrained personnel, technical storesmen to units within territorial command. This vehicle park would prove a heavy task, & there are no repeat no workshops capable, at the time of writing, of carrying out third line repair to allied vehicles in this territorial command. 4. As this BLU has had no DADOS since 14 Nov 45, invents have ceased to be made on Base Depots, thus cutting the supply line of all replacement spares and reconditioned assemblies.
 (a) At Mala Conference on 19 Nov 45, O&D publicly intimated that supplies would continue to be drawn from allied sources. May some firm arrangement please be made with special regard to authorising signatures by an O&D Officer? Most O&D Officers have already been removed.

5. It will also be essential to keep own disposal instructions for guns at present BLR and awaiting evaluation. Once again it is assumed that there is no third line workshop in the Italian organisation. There is certainly not in No. 3 Territorial Command.




