1. It is desired to know how many Allied personnel are transacting business direct with the Ministry of War. Therefore, for two consecutive days N.W.I.A. will maintain a guard at the two main entrances to the Ministry of War Building and the guards will be instructed as follows:-

(a) Stop all Allied personnel entering the Ministry of War Building and determine:-

(i) Their name, rank and organisation.

(ii) Which branch of the War Ministry they are going to visit.

(b) The guard will then permit the Allied personnel to continue with their business.

2. Guards are to be posted at the two main entrances to the Ministry of War Building (Via XX Settembre and Via Napoli) from 0800 hrs to 1900 hrs on 10 and 11 Jan 45.

3. Camp Comdt(Br) will post the guard 10 Jan with British personnel and HQ Comdt(US) will post the guard 11 Jan with American personnel.

4. Lists of names of Allied personnel entering the Ministry of War Building will be submitted to Major FINKLEY.

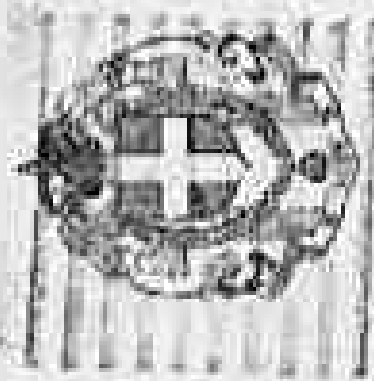

SUBJECT: P.I. and D.A.F. Services in Foggia District.

TO : Army Sub Commission, A.G.C., (AMIA), Lequile Lecce.

1. The Comando del IX Corpo d'Armata in a letter, dated 19 May, reference No. 2236/op, has informed the Commander of Italian troops in this area that his troops are not considered as being employed by the Allied Forces since request has not been regularly forwarded through your Commission. It appears that there is the possibility of these troops being removed from this area. 3474

2. Request is hereby made that the troops be placed under operational control of this Headquarters, which is responsible for administering the area which takes in most of the province of Foggia, and that they therefore be considered as being employed by the Allied Forces.

3. The troops, about 214 infantrymen and 91 carabinieri, with 30 officers, under the command of Lt. Col. Bozza at San Severo, are performing a valuable service for the Allied Forces in the area. Attached hereto is a list showing dispositions and duty assignments for these troops. In guarding lines of communications they not only serve the U.S. Air Force, R.A.F. and British Army units in this area, but also the ground combat units using these lines of communication. Furthermore, they are doing work which can best be done effectively only by Italian troops as their dealings are mainly with Italian nationals or those posing as Italians.

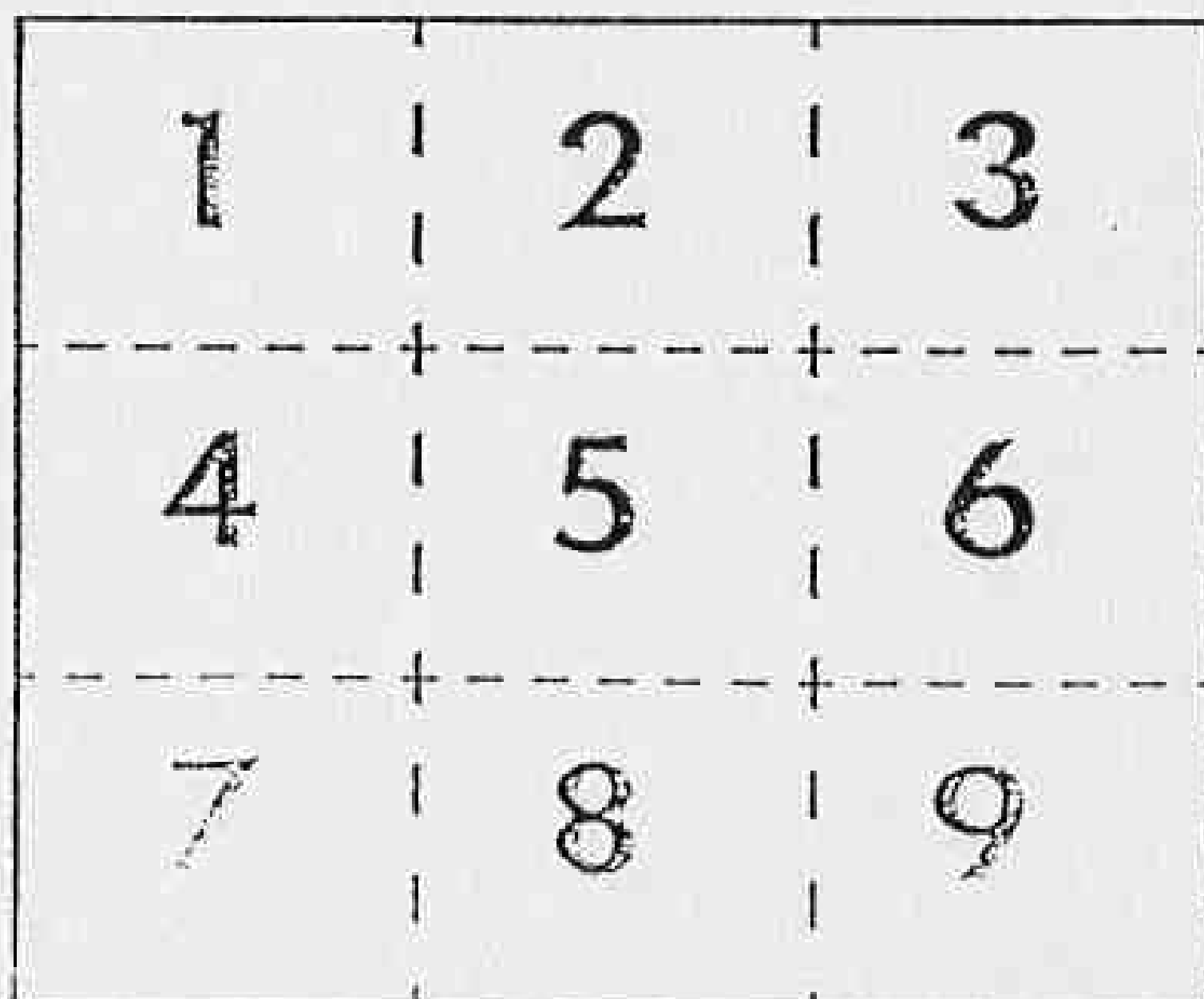
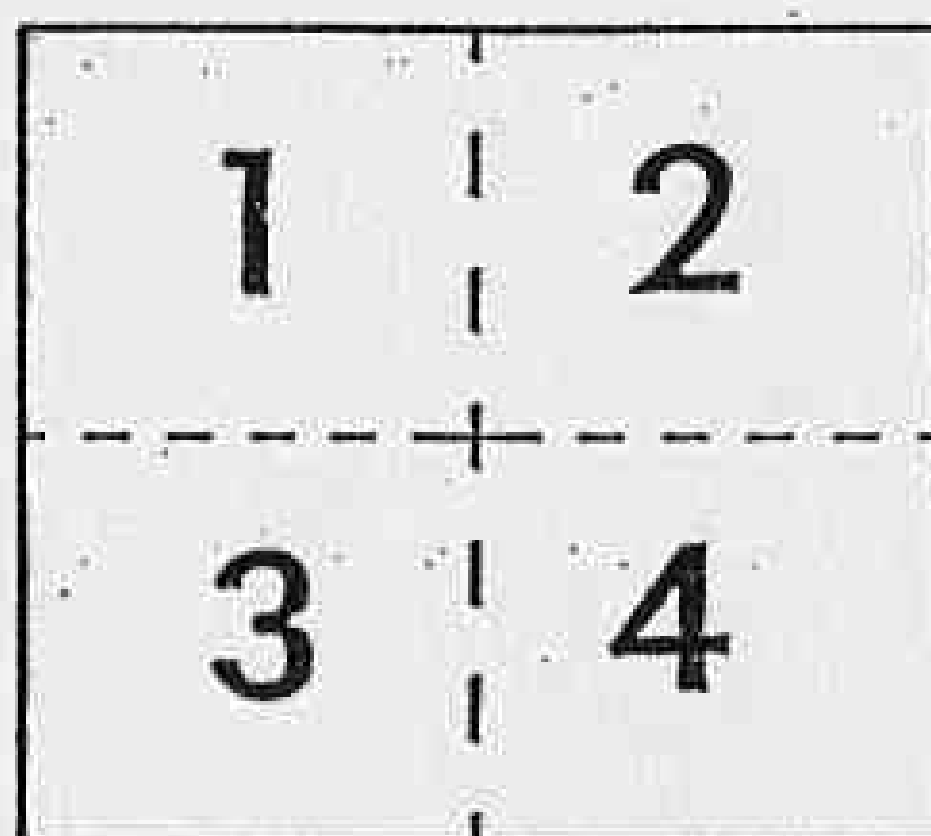

Herewith facts regarding 209 MG Bn, a coy of which was recently sent for gd duties to ABTAMURA (your G/13/42 of 9 MAR refers).

207 Up to the end of 1943, 209 MG Bn, though belonging to 51 CORPS had been supplying personnel to various labour duties in the MODUGHO area. 51 CORPS then issued instructions that the bn was to cease this work.

Col MOCCIA thereupon sent a rep to SMRE (Ispettorato Manovalanza) to request he be allowed to retain this bn. Permission was granted and 51 CORPS were instructed, on about 3 JAN 44, that the bn should remain at Col MOCCIA's disposal for labour though it should remain under 51 CORPS for adm. etc.

1. The following measures are in operation for guarding and defending against possible sabotage activities:-

- (a) Coastal lookouts - provided by coastal units 'in situ' of the Army, Navy, Carabinieri, Customs Guards and Special Militia.
- (b) Anti-parachutist defence (Anti-parachutist detachments strength 40 men plus transport and located in vulnerable areas).
- (c) Protection of V.P.s. (troops provided by the Army and allotted as necessary, also Carabinieri and special militia).

2. Tasks.

Forewarn and suppress with the utmost expedition, possible sabotage against the following :-

- Ry. Stations, railways and rly installations.
- Main road - highways and all roadworks.
- Aqueducts.
- Telegraph Offices.
- Military installations and storehouses.
- Industrial installations.
- Banks and credit establishments.
- Gasometers.
- Buildings of national and artistic importance.
- Drainage works.

The a/s V.P.s., according to their importance (as decided by the "Late Ministerial Commission for protection of V.P.s.") are divided into three categories:-

3416

1st Category. Permanent fixed guards (force varies according to size of V.P. or area).

2nd Category. Specific mobile guards provided by Inf. and Carabinieri patrols.

3rd category

3rd Category. Generic mobile guards provided by Inf. and Carabinieri.

3. The V.P. protection organisation operates on information from higher formation H's and Police H's, and initiates preventative action through its static defence detachments.

In the case of generic information or specific threats against certain objectives, guards are increased, watches redoubled and police take all preventative measures.

In addition to the detachment detailed to guard threatened V's, there are available, (a) other detachments kept in reserve until occasion demands, (b) anti-parachutist detachments, (c) all other available forces near the V.P.

Co-ordination of action of the defense forces is adjusted in the "Alarm and Defense Scheme", which is amended daily.

In addition, for an establishment of primary importance there exists an internal watch system on the personnel employed there, and frequent technical inspections take place.

4. Control of action.

IX Corps. IX Corps area (comprising PUGLIA and the provinces of MATERA and POTENZA) is sub-divided into 5 Sub Areas, each controlled by an officer of field rank. They in turn are controlled by General SPREGA, entrusted with the "V.P. Protection Organisation" and the anti-parachutist Defence of IX Corps.

Each sub area disposes of one or two territorial battalions together with Carabinieri units (with a strength of about 200 men) and 21 Anti-parachutist detachments.

/At present two

At present two battalions and thirty-two Anti-parachutist detachments are in process of re-construction, and forces now available for the protection of V.P. and Anti-parachutist Defence are:-

Six Territorial Battalions.
Fifty three Anti-parachutist Detachments.
Eight hundred and sixty two Carabinieri.

XXXI Corps.

Before the Armistice the V.P. Protection Organisation and Anti-parachutist Defence was entrusted to:-

Coastal battalions - within the coastal belt.
CATANZARO military zone (which disposed of two territorial Battalions) outside the coastal belt.

In XXXI Corps area, there were, in addition, thirty Anti-parachutists detachments.

Following orders issued by this Hq, the V.P. Protection Organisation and Anti-parachutist Defence have been completely re-organised.

The new organisation however is not known at present. As soon as the information becomes available it will be sent to the B.M.M.

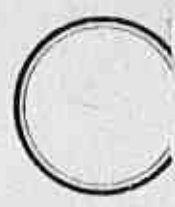
