Dear General, I had a talk with General Infante on the subject matter of our conversation last week. He would not admit to sending any instructions to S.M.R.E. on questions of rations etc., however he did agree that I should know all that was going on so that I could keep you fully in the picture. The result was that to day I had a meeting with General Infante who explained what had been discussed at a luncheon on Saturday with General Alexander, General Mason Macfarlane, Marshal Messe and General Infante. I will pass on most of the information I was given and you can decide if anything is of interest. The question of categories for Italian Military personnel falling into our hands during the edvance was discussed. This you The forming of two small Italian Administrative Sections to go forward, one with 5th Army and one with 8th Army, to help in questions such as - sorting out the man newer and an army to help in have issued instructions on. questions such as - sorting out the man power - and assisting in any military matters concerning the Italian Army. I understand a letter has been written to you on this subject by General Mason Macfarlane. Marshal Reinforcements for Italian Troops in the line. Messe thought the Cremona Division in Sardinia should be used. Division came from Corsica and had no arms and equipment. Marshal asked General Alexander if he could have certain arms and equip ment for this Division to train with, so that they could then be ready for the line when arms were available for issue to them. I understand that General Alexander said he would have his staff study this question. The question of Italian troops entering Rome. Alexander had stated that an official entry into Rome would be made. 1 Battalion and 1 Company of the CIL would represent the Italian Army. I understand that General Infante discussed this with General Harding I 2 and 1 Battalion of 67 Regiment plus 1 Company of the CIL were selected and trucks were being sent to collect them so that they would enter Rome with the 5th Army.

General Alexander had stated that very few troops and little or no Garrison would be stationed in Rome.

General Mason Macfarlane had stated that he hoped the Allied Control Commission and Italian Government would commence to move to Rome in about four weeks and that the move would be completed in two weeks.

General Alexander had said that the 2nd Front would start any day, and that the Russian Army would also attack.

General Alexander also stated that the Italians had fought well and he hoped to go and see them with Marshal Messe in a few days time.

I send this as a D.O. letter as I was given the information by General Infante as "Off the Record".

I think it is at least a start in getting some information of what they are doing.

If you would like reports of any interviews with General Infante set out in a more official form please let me know.




