(a) Agreed with Rome Area Command :-

- (1) All property of Italian Service Ministries is primarily reserved for the Italians.
- (11) If R.A.C. want any of these premises for Allied Troops they apply to Col MACGURIE.
- (111) If Col MACGURIE or his HQ consider the premises essential to the Italians the matter is referred to Army Sub Commission.
- (b) A.S.C. will enquire again regarding space taken up by Canadian nurses at the VIRALLO School.
- (c) A.S.C. will see if workshop of 3 Centro Automobilistico can be given back to the Centro, instead of being used for civilian purposes; also what stores should be given to C.I.L.
- (d) A.S.C. will inquire into situation at Mount Depot. PASSO GOMONE.

2. Rations

- (a) The 5,000 rations sent by Comando Supremo for patriots are not to be issued to non-effective members of the Italian Army, but are to count against military rations now being drawn from Allied sources.
- (b) A.S.C. will take up with Air Forces Sub Commission the question of continuing issue of civilian rations as before to members of the Italian Air Force awaiting screening.

Arrangements will be made between Gen. PIRELLI, AFHQ and a representative of I.M.A.R. for the Allies to take over temporarily 40 out of 60 power driven machines in the Italian Military, Rome, for installation in M.I.M.B.

2. Rations

- (a) Since the military ration cannot be issued to Italian military in hospital who are not on the effective strength of the Italian Army, Army Sub Commission will investigate if an improvement in the civilian rations issued to such personnel can be effected on the basis of local purchase.
- (b) A.S.C. will examine the question of rations for Red Cross workers in Italian hospitals.

3. Identity Cards

Receipt form issued after screening will suffice as identity card for Italian officers not in service with I.M.A.R. or accepted into effective strength of Italian Army.

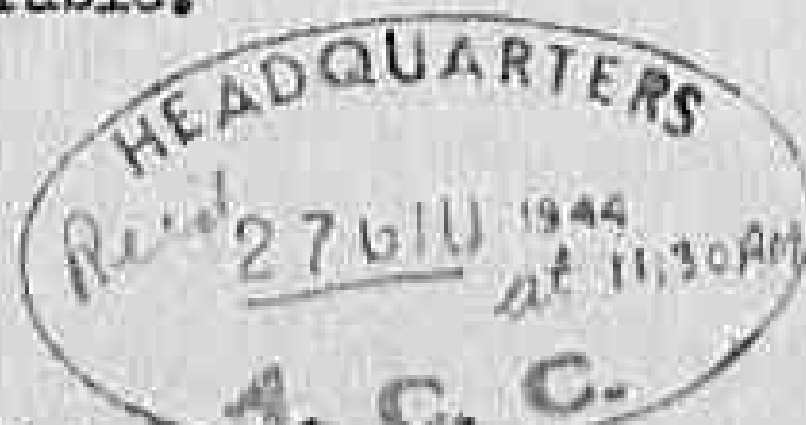
SUBJECT: Replacements for Italian Army units assigned to PBS.

TO : General Officer Commanding, Army Sub Commission, ACC (MMIA),
APO 394, U. S. Army..

1. Due to operational necessity it has been necessary to move forward to the Rome and Civitavecchia areas a number of Italian Army units attached to this command for operational control. These units are in turn all attached to U. S. Army units with which they are working. We are advised by the commanders of these units that large numbers of capable and qualified Italian soldiers -- possibly having filtered through combat lines of recent date -- are endeavoring to attach themselves to these units and seem quite willing to perform duty and work with the units if they may be fed and housed with the units.

2. You are of course familiar with the present situation and the urgent need for filler replacements in nearly all of our Italian units. The present rate of filler replacements to PBS control has dwindled almost to zero. The present hiatus in the flow of expected new units has served to greatly handicap us in the performance of our current missions. Some solution must be found to get us these men more promptly. It would seem to be completely logical that our local Italian command (either FF AA Campania or C.G. 212th Division) be allowed to recruit and assign these former soldiers in the forward areas to our units already in those areas up to the limit of their authorized strength, and that they be further authorized to send additional groups if possible to our Staging Area at Astroni where they can be distributed as fillers to our other local units which need them so badly. With authority on your part it appears that the local commander can effect these arrangements.

3. It is therefore requested that the local Italian command be authorized to select and reinstate selected soldiers found in that area, assign them to PBS units as filler replacements, and accomplish the necessary records so that they may be picked up on Italian Army rolls for pay and other purposes. It is requested that this matter be expedited and this headquarters advised by wire as to the action taken. If possible this requirement should start by 21 June 44 as operational conditions make such desirable.

5. Accommodation. (a) Italian Military Hospital at GELLO will move at once to AGNOLLO VIRGILIO. Canadian nurses may remain there for the present but will be asked to concentrate in one part of the building.
(b) A.S.C. will examine with R.A.C. the question of accommodation for
(i) Ministry of War and S.M.A.R. units (about 1000 men).
(ii) Partisans who cannot be accommodated in Bianchi Barracks Caserma Fernando di Savoia noted as suitable.
(c) Italian Air Force H.Q. is moving to Palazzo Caprera. If there is not room there it may spread to 1st and 2nd floors of Palazzo Ruffini.

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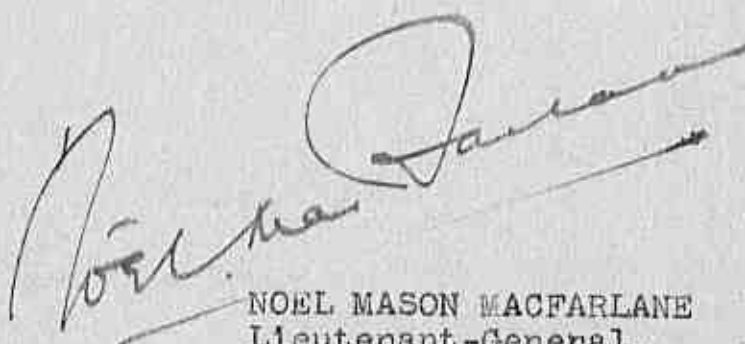
