GENERAL:

1. Italian War Ministry is responsible for supplying reinforcements for all BR-ITI Service units through B.R.D.'s in accordance with MMIA letter SD/L2 dated 14 February 1945 attached at Appx "A".

2. The function of the British Cadre attached to each B.R.D. is three fold.

- a). Liaison.
- b). Supervision and advice.
- c). Control.

3. Liaison

The O.C. Cadre.

- a). Represents the British District Commander. Transmits British orders to the B.R.D. Italian Commander and ensures compliance. Passes to District Hq. with his recommendations, requests of the Italian Commander, though generally the Italian Commander will employ normal staff channels i.e. Hq. appropriate Adm. Div.
- b). Is the link with Hq. MMIA directly, or through local MMIA LO.
- c). Keeps close contact with local Movements: District Hq. and Hq. MMIA, for moves into and out of the camp.

4. Supervision of and advice on:

- a). Camp organization to meet requirements incl selection of personnel according to their qualifications.
- b). Documentation.
- c). Trg. incl liaison with DMT, and advice as to trg of specialists.
- d). Allocation of rfts.

Transmits British orders to the R.R.D. Italian Commander and ensures compliance.

Passes to District Hq. with his recommendations, requests of the Italian Commander, though generally the Italian Commander will employ normal staff channels i.e. Hq. appropriate Adm. Div.

b). Is the link with Hq. MMIA directly, or through local MMIA LO.

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4. Supervision of and advice on:

a). Camp organization to meet requirements incl selection of personnel according to their qualifications.

b). Documentation.

c). Trg. incl liaison with DMT, and advice as to trg of specialists.

d). Allocation of rfts.

e). Discipline.

5. Control.

a). Movements out.

b). Personal equipment and clothing.

c). Rations.

d). Transport.

f). Medical stores.

6. Welfare

Must be supervised closely and assistance given where possible.

7. Hygiene

Includes camp cleanliness from cookhouse to individual soldier.

8. Standing Orders

Ensure these exist, are comprehensive, duly published and complied with.

9. Reports

- a). Check weekly returns made by Italian Commander.
- b). Check fortnightly demands by Adm Diva and obtain priorities where necessary, vide NMIA letter at Appx. "A".
- c). Movement required of personnel, weekly to NMIA.
- d). Camp conditions, monthly, to District & NMIA, on 1st of each month.

10. Command and Administration Italian Army

(a) The relevant para of AFHQ letter AG 091.711/169 OCT-0 of 16 Nov 44 follows:

" PARA 13.

REINFORCEMENTS AND REPLACEMENTS: The system and organization for the provision of replacement personnel will be as follows:

- a. Recruits will be called up by the Ministry of War at the direction of MVLA.
- b. Recruits will report to "Call-up Centers", the status of which will be III-ITI personnel.
- c. Separate base replacement depots will be set up for US-ITI's, BR-ITI's and ITI-ITI's respectively. MVLA will be responsible for arranging delivery of recruits and personnel available from other sources to the depots and for their maintenance prior to arrival. Thereafter, the nationality concerned will be responsible for the maintenance and training of replacement personnel and distribution to units.

d. The responsibility for establishment, and maintenance of staffs of base replacement depots is as follows:

- (1.) For US-ITI - CG MTCUSA.
- (2.) For BR-ITI - AFHQ (British Element).
- (3.) For ITI-ITI - The Italian War Ministry.

e. The replacements held on the rolls of replacement depots will not exceed the authorized number in each instance.

f. On the first of each month MVLA will forecast to this headquarters the output of types of personnel from Call-up Centers and other sources of personnel during the succeeding month and furnish any other information required to enable this headquarters to apportion the required quota between the US-ITI, BR-ITI and ITI-ITI, Replacement Depots. The distribution of specific Replacement Depots of the nationality concerned will be in accordance with the requirements of CG MTCUSA for US-ITI's

d. The responsibility for establishment, and maintenance of staffs of base replacement depots is as follows:

- (2.) For BR-ITI - AFHQ (British Element)
- (3.) For ITI-ITI - The Italian War Ministry.

e. The replacements held on the rolls of replacement depots will not exceed the authorized number in each instance.

f. On the first of each month MIA will forecast to this Headquarters the output of types of personnel from call-up Centers and other sources of personnel during the succeeding month and furnish any other information required to enable this Headquarters to apportion the required quota between the US-ITI, BR-ITI and ITI-ITI, Replacement Depots. The distribution of specific Replacement Depots of the nationality concerned will be in accordance with the requirements of CG MTCUSA for US-ITI's this Headquarters for BR-ITI's, War Ministry for ITI-ITI.

g. MIA will authorize call-up of personnel on the basis of demands at f. above. "

Ref sub para (a). At the moment each B.R.D. is authorized to hold 6,000 personnel.

Ref sub para (f). Distribution within B.R.Ds will be in accordance with MIA letter at Appx 'A'.

(h) MIA Adm Instr No 18 is at Appx 'C' (NOT to all).

1. RESPONSIBILITY.

The provision, training and allocation of reinforcements for BR-ITI Service Units is the responsibility of the Ministry of War (SHE) within the terms of these instructions and with such help from M.M.I.A. as is required.

2. OBJECT

The object is to keep all units up to their approved War Establishment strength with men of the required types and trades without waste of manpower.

3. BASE REINFORCEMENT DEPOTS

Reinforcements for BR-ITI Service Units will be supplied through Base Reinforcement Depots (B.R.Ds) which have been established at AFRAGGLA, TRAMI and ORVIETO and which are administered through local Arm Div HQs and through the Br Cadre attached to same. These are under Dicts.

4. REPLENISHMENT OF B.R.Ds.

Replenishment of B.R.Ds is the responsibility of the Ministry of War after such consultations with M.M.I.A. regarding calling up of men into the Army and other methods of raising manpower as are required to maintain the necessary holding of reinforcements. In planning for this consideration will be given to the anticipated wastage due to all causes, to returns from hospital or other absence, and to the likely yield of calls and recalls in various regions of ITALY so that strength may be maintained in all Arms and units.

- (d) Basic training in accordance with standards agreed between Allied Command and the War Ministry.
- (e) Allocation to Adm Divs and units in accordance with deficiencies reported.

6. UNIT DEMANDS (FORTNIGHTLY)

Unit commanders of BR-III Service Units will demand replacements for all personnel struck off the strength of the Unit and to bring units up to authorised W.E. strength as follows:

6. UNIT DEMANDS (FORTNIGHTLY) (CONTD)

- (a) Personnel who are wounded, sick, missing or absent will not be struck off the strength until, in the case of wounded or sick, 30 days after evacuation from the Unit, or in the case of missing or absent, 30 days after being reported missing or absent.
- (b) Reinforcement demands giving the info indicated at Appx "A" will be submitted fortnightly on Wednesdays by commanders of BA-III Service Units direct to HQ 4th Div concerned on the prescribed speechio. The first demand will be made on 7 March 1945. War Vin will forward copy of "speechio" as soon as possible.

7. CONSOLIDATED DEMANDS (FORTNIGHTLY) BY ADM DIV HQ.

8. ALLOCATION OF REFS.

The B.R.D. Commander will normally arrange drafts of reinforcements according to demands without further authority as far as he is able. If there are not sufficient reinforcements available he will apply through the O.C. Br Cadre to MMIA for a decision on priorities. Priorities within an Army or District will be obtained by application by the O.C. Br Cadre on behalf of the B.R.D. Commander concerned direct to HQ of the British Army or District under command of which the units are serving.

9. MOVEMENT OF DRAFTS

(a) Movement of reinforcements from B.R.D. to comply with demands of HQs, Adm Divs will usually be made in bulk drafts to reinforcement transit camps established by Adm Divs. Movement will be arranged by the Depot Commander through the O.C. Br Cadre.

- (b) O.C. Br Cadre will demand weekly on Wednesdays by telephone confirmed by immediate signal to MMIA for movement of reinforcements required to destinations outside the boundaries of his District. This demand will be in the form shown at Appendix "C" and will be in respect of movements in the week commencing Monday twelve days later.
- (c) Movement of drafts within District area will be arranged by O.C. Br Cadre through District HQ with local movements.
- (d) Receiving formations will arrange MOV from railhead or transit camps to unit.

10. B.R.D. STRENGTH RETURN.

The number of reinforcements by ranks and trades held in each B.R.D. will be reported weekly as at 1800 hrs on Sundays as in Appx "D" att'd on the prescribed speechio.

Hospital Diet Items

These supplies are issued only down to the level of military hospitals. They are not available for unit medical officers or M.I. Rooms. Of Field Hospital attached Orvieto Reinforcement Camp obtains hospital diet items from the bulk release made by HQ I District to HQ 209 Div. 231 Field Hospital will obtain its hospital diet items from the Italian DID from which medical rations are obtained and Territorial HQ Naples is responsible for making available the necessary amounts from the bulk releases drawn for all Italian military hospitals in the Naples command.
