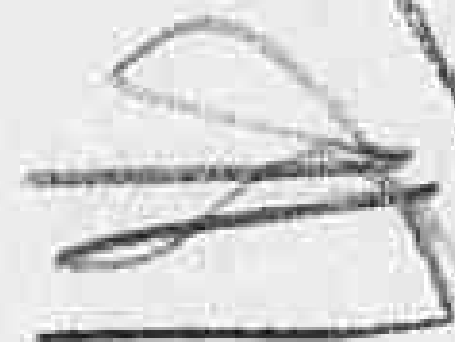

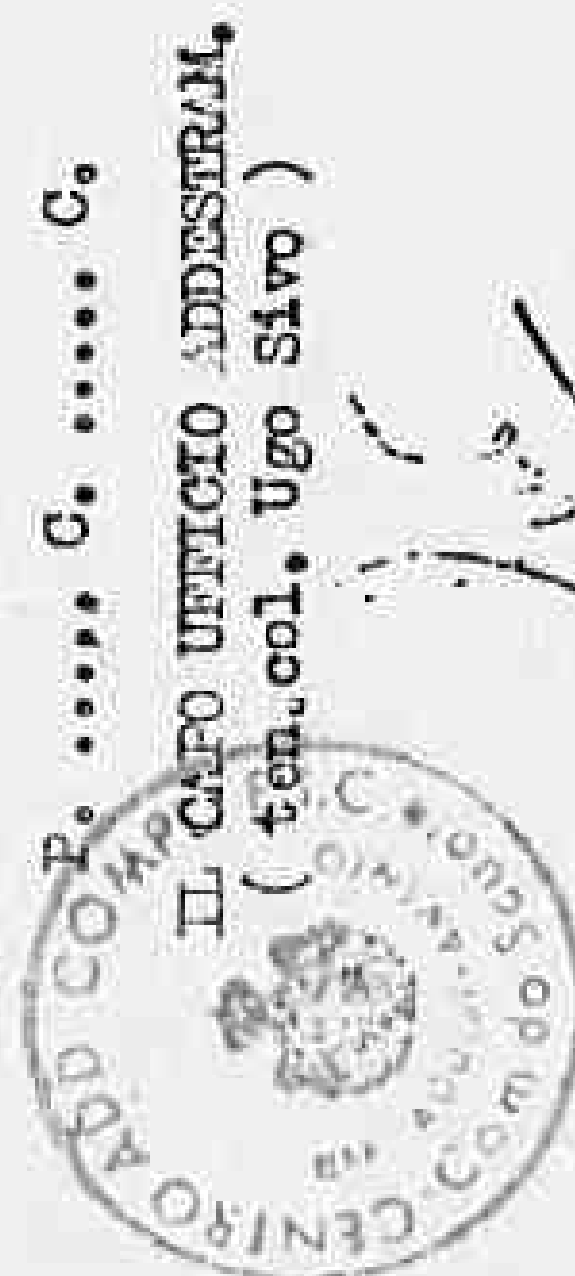

1. I am in receipt of your Memorandum dated 22 June 45, for which I thank you. I would like to express the opinion that when dealing with the Italian Army this subject, with all its entails, is probably the most vital important factor in the future development of the Italian Army. I would emphasize that the approach must be on a very broad basis, as the ignorance of the average Italian Officer of the very rudiments of this subject is almost unbelievable.

2. I am in entire agreement that a specific Man Management Course should be included in the curriculum of the S.I.V.A. Schools at MANZIANA. In accordance with the clear policy of the SIVA Schools, this Course will endeavour to train Unit and Formation Instructors. It should be noted that Man Management is already introduced in the existing Administration Course, but I feel the importance of the subject calls for a special Course. GREAT CARE, HOWEVER, MUST BE TAKEN TO ENSURE THAT THE DOCTRINE TAUGHT IN BOTH COURSES DOES IN NO WAY CONFLICT.

3. In addition to the SIVA Course I most strongly recommend that a small touring team of really first-class Italians, under the personal supervision of Major Newton, should tour all Italian Units and Formations with a view to lecturing to Sub-units in their place of employment.

4. I suggest, however, that the establishment of a Man Manage-

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3. In addition to the SIVA Course I most strongly recommend that a small touring team of really first-class Italians, under the personal supervision of Major Newton, should tour all Italian Units and Formations with a view to lecturing to Sub-units in their place of employment.

4. I suggest, however, that the establishment of a Man Management Course at SIVA Schools should have priority, and that the Touring Team should not be formed until Major Newton is entirely satisfied that the Instructors Course is working satisfactorily, and fully interprets every possible phase included in the subject. There can be no doubt whatever, that Major Newton's assistance would be of the utmost value to the staff of this B.L. and T.U.

5. It is noted that an Italian Officer has been nominated by S.M.R.E. To obtain the best results this Officer must be superlatively good, and I shall have no hesitation in condemning him if he falls short in any way, of the high standard which I require.

6. With reference to your seventh paragraph I submit that the correct procedure is for Major Newton, after having studied the work at present being done on this subject at MANZIANA, should prepare a Syllabus for the Course and should personally select the Instructors. It need hardly be added that every facility which can be offered by the staff of this Headquarters will be placed at Major Newton's disposal.

7. Finally, as this matter has always been of first interest in my mind, I should appreciate it if all lectures and matter to be published could be submitted to me for scrutiny before being put into use.

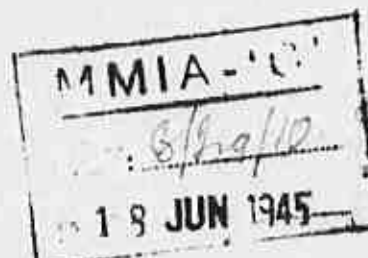
