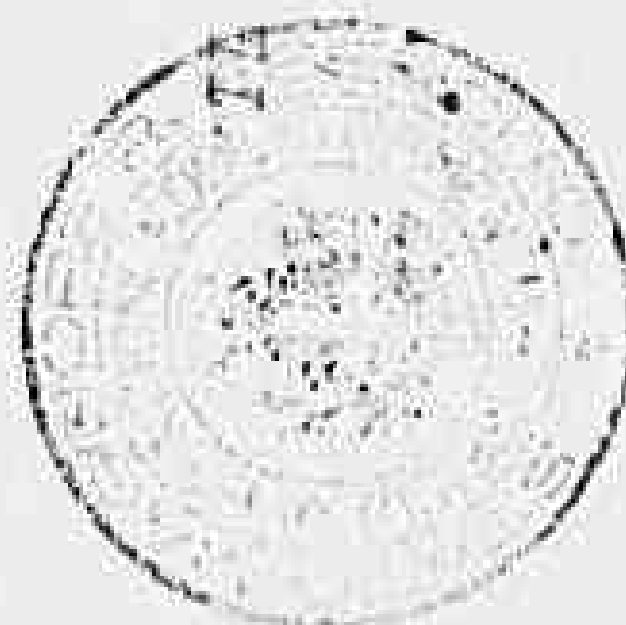

Ref your G/Try/10/6 of 13 Jul 45, please note that I have discussed the matter of filling Ofir vacancies for courses at the R.T.C. with the Generale Comandante.

The point is that 23 Ofir vacancies have been allotted to the Gruppo CRAMONA. The Gruppo is 100 Ofirs under str, and of its remaining Ofirs a number are awaiting release on the arrival of replacements and there are some 23 Ofirs detached on Refugee Camp duties. One of the Inf Regts is deployed on the Swiss Frontier and has a number of detached posts which each require an Ofir. The Generale feels himself totally unable to fill the R.T.C. vacancies. I agree with him.

He suggests that the 23 vacancies be filled from the Ofir replacements which have been promised him for some time. This would appear a reasonable solution should these replacements exist.

I may add that the shortage of Ofirs has caused the Gruppo to close its Div School which was an organisation in which the Generale and myself took great interest and which has done a great deal of good.

The Generale has conveyed through Italian sources his inability to fill these vacancies and I wish to confirm to you the truth of his difficulties.

1. It is considered that unless BLUs are informed direct, by F BLU or by MIA, at least as early as ICG are informed by SMEB, of the number and distribution of vacancies for various courses at CESANO, no action as suggested in para 3 of G/Trg/10/5 dated 27 June 45 can possibly be expected of BLU att ICG.

2. BLU will not in fact know what courses are being run nor what vacancies are allotted to their ICG and cannot therefore "interest themselves personally" in the action or inertia of their Gp.

3. It is pointed out that this BLU has invariably in the past insisted on a nominal roll of students to fill all vacancies on each course allotted being handed by the Gp to the BLU in good time for onward transmission to F BLU.

4. If in fact students from this Gp do not arrive, the prime remedy would appear to lie with F BLU, who can inform me of what students, by name, from FRIULI ICG either failed to arrive or to arrive in time, or were unsuitable.

5. In one instance I requested precisely this information from F BLU (my G/6 dated 18 June 45, copy to you, refers), and up to to-day, 3 July 45, have received no reply: my signal G 95 of today's date refers.

2. BLU will not in fact know what courses are being run nor what vacancies are allotted to their ICG and cannot therefore "interest themselves personally" in the action or inertia of their Gp.

1. The policy regarding allocation of vacancies on courses at HQ ICF has recently been under review by this HQ.

2. In order to give the Ministry of War a larger say in the allocation of courses to Italian firms etc, allocation of courses will v.e.f. 17 June 45 be dealt with entirely through Italian Staff channels.

3. It is emphasized that this decision in no way influences the present position of "F" HQ, who retain all the responsibilities previously held by them.

4. The decisions reached affect the Ministry of War and HQ ICF as follows:-

(a) HQ ICF will inform the Ministry of War of dates and nature of courses and total vacancies available and will forward copies of joining instructions and joining certificates etc.

(b) Ministry of War will allocate the total vacancies amongst eligible firms as they think fit, passing to firms all the necessary information, instructions and certificates. Copies are required by this HQ.

(c) Acceptances or rejections of vacancies offered will be made by firms direct to Ministry of War for collection and transmission to HQ ICF.

(d) Rejections by one firm should be re-allocated to other firms. It will be the Ministry's duty to ensure that all courses start at 100% of their capacity and without unduly taxing the resources of the two Regts at CEMANO. Copies of final acceptances are requested by this HQ.

5. In view of the present role of Italian firms it is considered in this HQ that little or no excuse exists for refusal of vacancies by Combat Groups. It has been suggested that the Command consider that by accepting vacancies

(a) HQ HQD will inform the Ministry of War of dates and nature of courses and total vacancies available and will forward copies of joining instructions and joining certificates etc.

(b) Ministry of War will allocate the total vacancies amongst eligible firms as they think fit, passing to firms all the necessary information, instructions and certificates. Copies are required by this HQ.

(c) Acceptances or rejections of vacancies offered will be made by firms direct to Ministry of War for collection and transmission to HQ HQD.

(d) Rejection by one firm should be re-allocated to other firms. It will be the Ministry's duty to ensure that all courses start at 100% of their capacity and without unduly taxing the resources of the two Regts at Casano. Copies of final acceptances are requested by this HQ.

5. In view of the present role of Italian firms it is considered in this HQ that little or no excuse exists for refusal of vacancies by Combat Groups. It has however been established that should a firm Command consider that by accepting vacancies he is lowering his effective strength below a safe operational figure, he may consult with the commander of the employing Allied firm. With the concurrence of the Allied commander course vacancies may be rejected. Should this practice become too usual you are requested to communicate with this HQ.

6. HQ HQD attached HQD have been instructed in accordance with the **2633** of this letter.

7. You are requested to forward any views you may have against the adoption of this system. This HQ will be pleased to advise or help in any way you may wish.
