'H' British Training Increment (All Officers).

1. The present arrangement for Physical Training Instruction to all parts of this Centre has been a series of Physical Training Cadres for Junior Officers and Senior NCOs arranged at CESANO under the instruction of the two British WOs. In addition to running these cadres the British Instructors supervise all Physical Training being carried out in the two Infantry Regiments and at TREVIGNANO (the Intake Regiment).

2. With the end of the War in Europe and with the new Training Policy in view, it is felt that the time is now ripe to start a properly organised School of Physical Training at this Centre with the object of teaching not only PT but sports generally, and in fact based very much on the lines of our own Physical Training Schools.

3. This project has been discussed with Lt-Col H. GOK GSO I Physical Training at DMT, and arrangements can readily be made for the necessary British Instructors to be available with the object of running a course of say 50 students from here and the Gruppi, all carefully selected, and then training the best of these students as Instructors to take over the course completely. We should no doubt retain our own British staff to continue supervising at this Centre.

4. Although Lt-Col GOK assures us that equipment such as ropes, poles etc, can be supplied from British sources, the main items of sports gear, i.e. footballs etc, will not be available and it will be necessary for these items to be found from Italian sources. Will you please let us know what are the possibilities of obtaining these items?
