1. For your information the Italian War Ministry has forwarded the following particulars, from investigations obtained from the Italian Navy.
2. They state that 1,767,222 rations "A" and 1,817,480 rations "B" were issued, while 985,613 rations "A" and 1,663,790 rations "B" were really distributed giving an excess of 781,609 rations "A" and 154,690 rations "B" issued.
3. The reason for these errors are as follows:-
  - (a) Returns for three consecutive 10 day periods erroneously included crews of vessels abroad.
  - (b) Returns during January and February, erroneously included crews of vessels on the high seas or docked in SICILY and SARDINIA.
  - (c) The fact that 10 day period issues have to be based on strength returns made a fortnight before the beginning of the period. Bearing in mind the fluctuating nature of Navy strength returns, those made a fortnight before hand are liable to considerable changes by when the period actually starts.

1. Your investigations in paras 1.2 and 3 are noted and have been forwarded to POTALI TARANTO for their information.
2. With regard to the issue of one month's ration to the Italian Navy as a reserve stock it is regretted that authority cannot be granted.
3. AFHQ have ruled that all issues from your Main or Bulk Supply Depots should be by 10 day periods only.
4. It is proposed in the near future to build up a 20 days reserve ration for the three arms of the Italian service, Army, Navy and Air Force, and this stock to be warehoused and distributed in accordance with feeding strengths between your five Main Supply Depots, TARANTO, NAPLES, BARI, LECCE and CATANZARO.

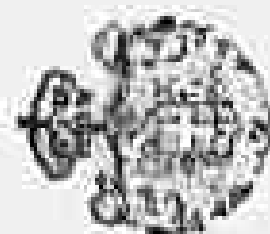

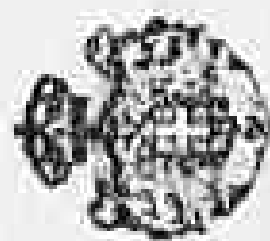

1. RATIONS

The total rations issued to Italian Naval Forces are set out at Appx A to this letter. The actual decision as to any reduction in future drawings to offset the past overdrawings is still under consideration by ACMF.

Would you in the meanwhile confirm that no rations will be issued to the Italian Navy from RN Sources direct. This arrangement has been already made by the Flag Officer Western Italy and will remove one of the main causes of over-drawing and difficulty.

2. SCALE FOR HOSPITALS

Military as well as Italian Naval Hospitals are at present on Scale B rations and supplemented by such local arrangements as the Italian wish to make. The whole question of the rations supplied to Hospitals is being taken up in AFHQ both from the Scale aspect and also the provision of certain Hospitals Comforts from RASC sources.

We will let you know immediately it is clear which way the policy is likely to go.
