1. CALL (Barloy, Cats, Carobs, etc)

a. There are sufficient stocks of grain now held by you to maintain all Italian Army animals on the mainland behind combat zone for the next two ten day periods (24 June to 3 July, and 4 July to 13 July), and H.A.A.L. have been informed accordingly.

b. Memo submitted to this office, at the commencement of the first ten day period (24 Jun to 3 July) your stocks of grain held as at midnight 3 Jun 44, showing estimated issues to be made during this period, together with the animal strength.

c. The animals of the Remount Depot at Pergano will continue to be fed by P.H.S.

d. CALL (Hay & Straw)

d. Demand for 169 tons, for period 4 Jun to 3 July, in respect of the 1558 animals in Apulia, Sardinia and Campania, has been submitted to H.A.A.L.

e. With effect from 14 Jan 44 inclusive, Hay & Straw requirements for the animals in Calabria, are to be met by local purchase of those commodities in Calabria. Full details are given in our letter 82/83 dated 15th June, 1944.

f. See para 1.g. above in regard to the animals of the Remount Depot at Pergano.

- b. Please submit to this office, at the commencement of the first ten day period (14 Jun to 1 July) your stocks of grain held as at midnight 13 Jun 44, showing estimated issues to be made during this period, together with the animal strength.
- c. The animals of the Remount Depot at Fernando will continue to be fed by F.S.S.
- d. 21 June (Hay & Straw)
- e. Demand for 163 tons, for period 4 Jun to 3 July. In respect of the 155 animals in Apulia, Lucania and Campania, has been submitted to H. A. L. I.
- f. With effect from 14 Jun 44 inclusive, Hay & Straw requirements for the animals in Calabria, are to be met by local purchase of those commodities in Calabria. Full details are given in our letter ST/63 dated 15th June, 1944.
- g. See para 1.c. above in regard to the animals of the Remount Depot at Fernando.

4. It is pointed out that when requested by H. A. K. K., you may have to issue from stocks held in Calabria to other Provinces, if the occasion arises.
5. Please acknowledge receipt of this letter.
