ITALIAN ARMY - SUPS

1. OBJECT.

The object of this instruction is to amend and clarify the procedure of issue of and accounting for the FRESH FRUIT, FRESH VEGETABLES - MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS to PR-ITI Tps or other tps such as Gd Sns maintained from Pr DIDs in FIFTH ARMY, EIGHT ARMY and ONE DISTRICT. *and 2 District*

2. FRESH FRUIT AND VEGETABLES.

(a) Ref 1 Apr 45 all ITALIAN units drawing the Allied portion of the ration from DIDs in FIFTH ARMY, EIGHT ARMY and ONE DISTRICT will draw the

FRESH VLG 8 oss

from the DID under MMIA FORM ST8 arrangements.

(b) Demands will be submitted and the accounting procedure will be adjusted on the normal ST8 system.

(c) MMIA Adm Instruction No. 22 para 5 (c) (i) is amended accordingly in respect of Fresh Fruit and Vegetables.

3. MISCELLANEOUS AND DISINFECTANT ITEMS.

(a) Wef 1 April 45 all Miscellaneous and Disinfectant Items which are a ST supply will be drawn in FIFTH ARMY, EIGHT ARMY and ONE DISTRICT, *and 2 District* from DIDs on the first drawing each month.

(b) Demands will be made on ST8 (a SEPARATE copy from rations) and handled in the normal manner.

(b) Demands will be submitted and the accounting procedure will be adjusted on the normal STB system.

(c) MMIA Adm Instruction No. 22 para 5 (c) (i) is amended accordingly in respect of Fresh Fruit and Vegetables.

3. MISCELLANEOUS AND DISINFECTANT ITEMS.

(a) Ref 1 April 45 all Miscellaneous and Disinfectant Items which are a ST supply will be drawn in FIFTH ARMY, EIGHT ARMY and ONE DISTRICT, *and two Districts* from DIDs on the first drawing each month.

(b) Demands will be made on STB (a SEPARATE copy from rations) and handled in the normal manner. *M1.*

(c) In view of distribution already made Neperin will continue to be issued through Italian Medical channels.

4. The system in force now in areas other than FIFTH ARMY, EIGHT ARMY and ONE DISTRICT will remain unchanged. *M1.*

5. The ITALIAN Ministry of War has issued corresponding orders under reference 5034/S.1 of 3 Mar. AFHQ authority is *780.7* P36452 of 2 Mar 45.

2. MMIA IO's, where applicable, are requested to liaise with local Italian Army representatives, and with the Allied issuing agency concerned, regarding collection and transportation. All withdrawals will be recorded on MMIA forms 3TB.

3. For IO's 5 Army (Br.Incr.) and 8 Army: it is understood that owing to the scattered location of units, 5 (Br.Incr.) and 8 Armies prefer to make individual releases direct to units from D.I.D's, rather than give a bulk release to the Medical Depot in the area. This is quite in order, and IO's should ensure that Italian commands inform their units of the procedure arranged by S & T branches concerned. IO 5 Army (Br.Incr.) is requested to note that requirements for ITI-ITI units are included in the 5 Army (Br.Incr.) bulk release authority.

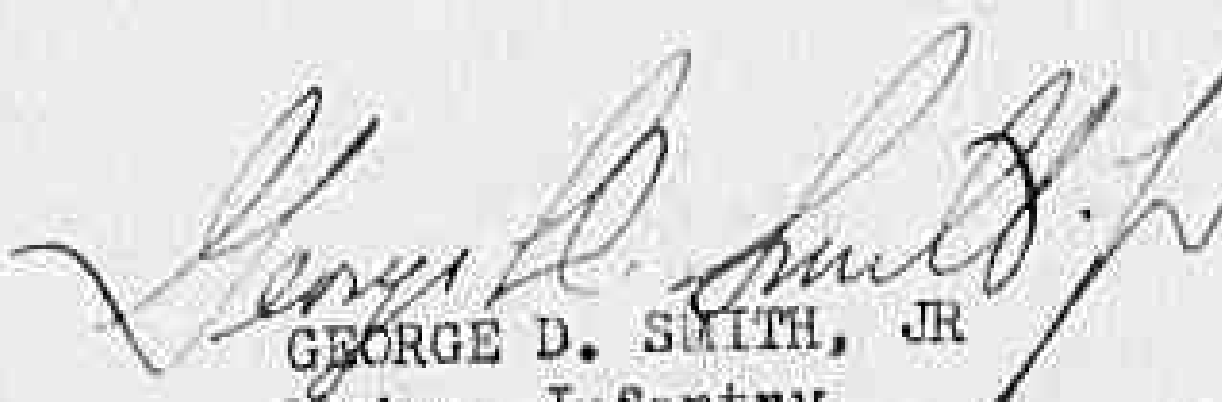

2. There is no Italian Military hospital w/o British Increment at this time therefore milk, semolina, meat extract, margarine and rice, issuable only to authorized Italian Military hospitals, have been deleted from your demand.

In this connection it is understood that 521 Italian Military hospital will shortly be moving to Arezzo. Arrangements have already been completed to enable this unit to receive medical diet items, and future requirements should be demanded through Italian Medical channels vide para 3 below.

3. The items of disinfectants, with the exception of Izal which is NOT an authorized issue, are obtainable on demand through Italian Medical channels against bulk releases from Allied stocks at the Base.

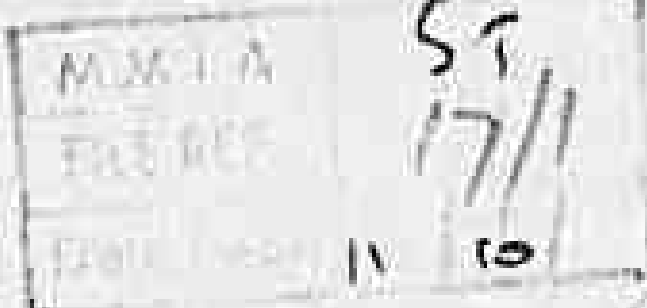

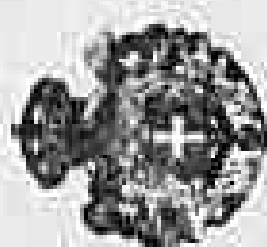
